What you need to know about the Lobos: UNM is one of only three Division I teams (of 365) that doesn't have a single player back from last season. Eric Olen's system is a 3-point heavy style that ranked in the 98th percentile in Division I last season in 3-point field goal attempt rate. On defense, where the team has been far more successful in two exhibition games with their aggressive zone, the Lobos forced 17.5 turnovers per game in exhibitions vs. Washington State and Northern Arizona.
