TSA REAL ID REQUIREMENT

The Nantucket Airport Commission hereby advises the public and all travelers to and from Nantucket Memorial Airport that Federally acceptable identification, such as REAL ID, Passport or other TSA acceptable document is required for all travelers over 18. Beginning February 1, 2026, travelers arriving for commercial domestic flights without a federally acceptable form of ID will be required to pay \$45 for the **TSA's Confirm ID Program**. For additional information, please visit www.tsa.gov/tsaconfirm-id. The fee covers 10 days of travel and requires additional screening. Before making a **TSA Confirm ID** payment, check TSA's list of **acceptable ID documents**; visit www.tsa.gov/travel/security-screening/identification. The list is subject to change and does allow for certain expired documents. Massachusetts residents ready to upgrade their driver's license or identification card to a REAL ID may apply at their local RMV Service Center, for complete details on documentation requirements and making an appointment, visit www.mass.gov/real-id
