

WISCONSIN CRANBERRY COUNTIES

BY THE ACRE

Cranberries are grown throughout Central and Northern Wisconsin, with roughly 25,000 acres across 19 counties managed by more than 250 licensed growers. For every acre of cranberries harvested, growers maintain an average of eight acres of support land—usually left undeveloped—to help protect water resources, provide wildlife habitat, and support long-term sustainability. This map highlights the distribution of planted cranberry acreage by county.
