

What is a microbial crop inoculant?



Similar in definition to a probiotic

“Live microorganisms, which when administered in adequate amounts, confer a benefit on the host.”
(FAO/WHO). Also known as biostimulant.



For registration purposes

Labeled as either a “soil amendment” or “crop inoculant” – depending on the state.



In practice

Tools used to support proper function of the root/soil interface, ensuring that nutrients and water remain available for uptake to drive energy production and growth.
