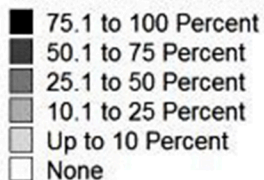

Percent of dairy farms per civil town in Wisconsin operated by the Amish in 2016. Civil towns are Wisconsin's equivalent to a township and typically include 36 one-square-mile sections, although some towns may include more than one Public Land Survey township, or only parts of a survey township. Amish dairy farms were identified by cross-referencing the Amish directory information (Miller 2014) with dairy producer license listings from the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection, supplemented by use of Amish surnames and Raber's Ministers List for settlements excluded from the directories.
