Kid, lamb, calf, or foal	Born to vaccinated dam	Administer a tetanus toxoid product at 6, 9, and 12 weeks of age unless directed otherwise by your veterinarian. Booster at 6 months, then twice annually.
Kid, lamb, calf, or foal	Vaccination status of dam negative or unknown	Give tetanus ANTI-TOXIN at birth and every 2 weeks until 6 weeks old, then start with tetanus toxoid schedule as above.
Animal to be tail docked or castrated	Vaccination status negative or unknown	1.BEST: Give tetanus toxoid 2-3 weeks before castration/docking and booster at castration/ docking OR wait until 1 week after booster to castrate/dock. OR 2. Give tetanus toxoid AND tetanus antitoxin in separate locations in neck at castration/ docking; repeat toxoid 2 weeks later.
Any mammal	Vaccination status unknown	If a wound occurs or dead tissue is present, give tetanus toxoid AND tetanus anti-toxin in separate locations in neck; repeat toxoid 2 weeks later.
	Tetanus vaccination status current	If a wound occurs or dead tissue is present, give tetanus toxoid booster.
