



Volunteers Needed

City of Alvin Civil Service Commission

The City of Alvin is seeking three (3) citizens to serve as volunteers on the Civil Service Commission for the City of Alvin. The Commission will adopt rules, conduct investigations and inspections, and hear appeals for police personnel in accordance with the Municipal Civil Service Act covered under Chapter 143 of the Texas Local Government Code. Members of the initial Committee appointed will serve a one (1) to three (3) year term, as appointed. Subsequent members will be appointed to serve three (3) year terms. The commission will meet at least once a year and then as needed for approximately one (1) to two (2) hours. In accordance with Chapter 143, members will be appointed by the City Manager and confirmed by the City Council.

Minimum Required Qualifications

- Must be of good moral character
- Must be a United States citizen.
- Must be a resident of the City of Alvin for more than three (3) years.
- Must be over twenty-five (25) years of age.
- Must not have held a public office within the preceding three (3) years.
