Joy Pinckard has a plan, and at 18 she's almost through with it

JACKSONVILLE — Joy Pinckard felt the spark at 14.

It started with a book, she said recently, one her mother bought her new for Christmas that explained about engineering and how to build tiny machines from paper.

She took what she learned and used it, building a two-legged, walking robot powered by an electric motor taken from a toy car. Pinckard used aluminum foil to wire batteries up to the engine.

"When I got that motor working," Pinckard said, "I knew at that point what I wanted to do."

Now 18, Pinckard will graduate from her homeschooling program this month. She'll do so already a sophomore at Jacksonville State University. For the last two years, Pinckard has been a full-time student at the university, participating in an accelerated high school program that saw her taking college courses for dual enrollment credit.

"The opportunity to do this, in addition to my own drive to learn things," she said recently on the college's campus, "has put me in a very good position."

Pinckard, a computer programmer, is studying applied manufacturing engineering with a focus on automation and design — a mouthful, she admits.

"I normally shorten it and say, I'm going to be working in robotics," the teenager said.

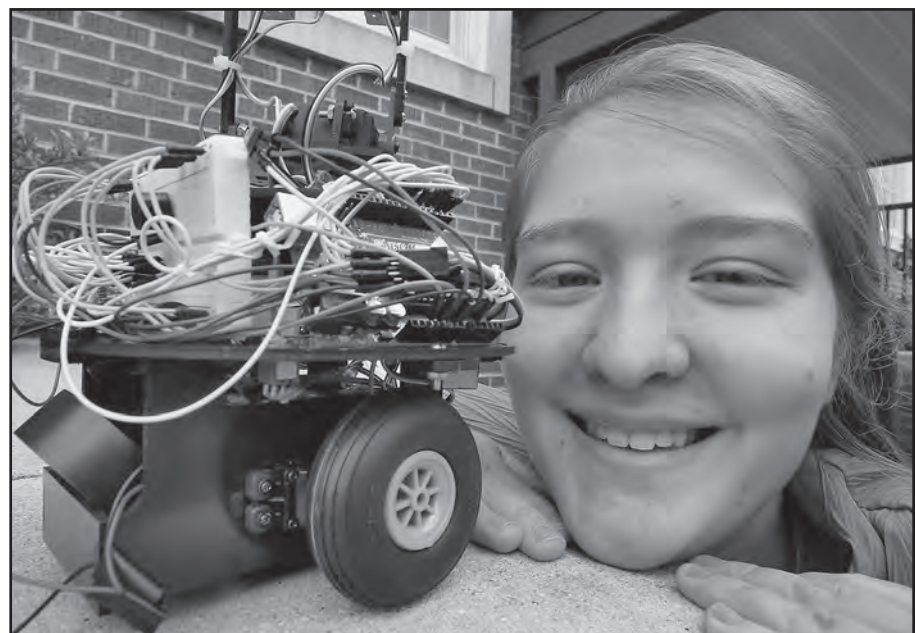
Ayers Hall, the home of the university's computer science, mathematics, and engineering courses — that's where Pinckard spends much of her time.

"I practically live here," she said.

It's where she takes her favorite classes, like the one associate professor of computer science David Thornton teaches on video game design.

"Joy is one of the best students I've had in my 12 years of teaching," said Thornton, who plans to show at JSU's spring Preview Day a game Pinckard worked on as a way to attract prospective students. "Her teammates would characterize her as aptly named."

A member of JSU's robotics club, Pinckard especially enjoys programming robots. Take "TJ," short for Talrik Junior, a decades-old wheeled robot she's repurposed.

"I gutted it out and rebuilt it," Pinckard explained outside Ayers Hall, pointing to the more powerful microchip she used to replace the robot's outdated brain.

Pinckard attributes much of her success now to her family's move to Jacksonville, where her mother, Donna Perygin, got a job at JSU as an assistant professor of chemistry. The teen never felt much at home in Tennessee.

"You know what I wanted to do in Oakland? Paint nails," Pinckard said. "Nails and hair — I thought that's what people did."

Her mother's oldest daughter, the second-youngest of four children, all home-schoolers, Pinckard says she gets a rush from solving tough problems.

That attitude — at least some of it, Pinckard said — came from her mother.

"We never said, 'Girls don't play with hammers,'" Perygin said recently from her office at JSU's Martin Hall, where she's studying ways to reduce pharmaceutical drug testing on animals.

"I'm a single mom, so if anything needed to be fixed, I was right there doing it," Perygin said. "She was handing me the hammer."

Pinckard's designed and written or helped to design and write eight video

games, with titles like Extreme Lawn Mower and Spook Maze. She's self-published a children's book.

Pinckard likely has two more years of college left, she says, "but that's still very much ahead of other students coming out of high school."

There will be a celebration May 13, a kind of graduation ceremony, at Webster's Chapel Baptist Church, where Pinckard leads the Wednesday night children's worship group.

She'll don a cap and gown to get the feeling, then she'll play video games with her friends.

After college, Pinckard plans to go straight to work.

"I actually want to be a toy designer," she said, especially of electronic toys. "Toy design is everything that I love doing."

It'd be a perfect combination, she thinks, of the fields she most enjoys: game design, programming, and working with kids.

And it started with that book her mother bought for Christmas, which Pinckard keeps on her bookshelf at home.
