THREE-PEAT

Triplets earn high honors in Oxford graduating class

OXFORD — The Patel brothers aren't looking forward to college.

The 18-year-old identical triplets — Dev, Jay and Shiv — are graduating from Oxford High School as valedictorian, salutatorian and a top-five academic performer, respectively. But they're not pumped about leaving home for college, jumping into new academic challenges or taking on adult life for the first time.

Jay, who is the oldest by about a minute, often spoke for the others during a half-hour talk at Oxford High School, just a few minutes after the last day of school ended. His parents say he's the ringleader of the triplets, he said. Even so, he was quiet and hesitant to elaborate on answers to questions about school and family life, as were his brothers.

Asked if they're excited to attend college this fall, Jay muttered, "Not really," and the moment passed after his brothers agreed.

The boys are interested in tennis and

studying, they said. Their family isn't especially academic but they seem to have a built-in drive for learning. Their parents, Aarti and Dhansukhlal Patel, immigrated to the United States 23 years ago; the Patel sons have lived in Oxford their whole lives, they said.

Jay and Dev will attend Jacksonville State University this fall, though they seemed unsure what their majors will be. Shiv will go to University of Alabama. Jay and Dev would eventually like to work with money, maybe investing, but they said they don't really want to get rich.

Despite their shyness in person, their teachers seemed thrilled with the trio's classwork.

"They have a competitive drive, though not necessarily with each other, but with their friends," said Jennifer Singleton, who teaches precalculus and AP calculus.

Singleton said the three have a work ethic that's unusual for most students. The Patels will take advanced math tests and finish them quickly, with enough time left over to rework the equations two or three times to be sure they've gotten the right answers. Singleton has found the evidence of those self-assessments on their scratch paper worksheets.

"They had redone the test like three times in the time it takes most students to do once," she said. "And they doubleand triple-checked themselves to make sure they'd done it correctly every time."

Yevette Word, who teaches English and AP literature and language courses, said the Patels seem to see a bigger picture than their immediate surroundings.

"Their sphere of influence is a little larger than the average student: how things affect them, affect the community, and how they get bigger and bigger and affect the world," Word said. "I think they can grasp that worldly concept."

Jay said he and his brothers hope to one day act as role models for others, maybe even taking to the stage for motivational speaking.

Their advice to those following in their footsteps is simple, and blunt. "Keep working hard," said Shiv. "Just stop being lazy," said Jay.
