

Editor's Note

Looking for a good book to read?

With spring still several weeks away, indoor activities remain the primary order of the day around the lake. I spend a good portion of my indoor time reading, and I just became aware of some really neat reading material that I'll be adding to my already lengthy reading list.

A six-book graphic novel series written by friend Bobby Nash has just been released. *Crimes in Time* features the art of Lelo Alves illustrating Bobby's words as they spin historical mystery stories related to significant events of the 19th, 20th, and 21st centuries.

"These six books combine my love of action-packed crime fiction and history," Bobby said. "It was fun to mix the two together. I enjoyed diving into the research on each and then working the characters into that history. I hope you'll enjoy the results."

Here's a summary of each volume.

Great Chicago Fire: In 1871, petty thief Timothy Shannon is released from jail near Chicago, Illinois. He dodges a police officer who is tailing him, then joins a poker game in Mrs. O'Leary's barn to get the money he needs for his next caper. Somehow, a fire starts and quickly spreads across Chicago. Can Shannon evade the police and escape the burning city?

Sinking of the Titanic: In 1912, Casey Scanlan, Sean O'Helan, and Seamus Holt rob a bank of cash and gold. Scanlan has secretly booked passage on the RMS Titanic. He ditches his partners, then boards the ship. O'Helan shows up and confronts Scanlan. When the ship hits the iceberg, O'Helan grabs

the cash and runs. Scanlan can't carry the heavy gold. Can Scanlan leave the gold behind, or will greed seal his fate?

Bombing of Pearl Harbor: In 1941, U.S. Navy sailor Jack Colvin is stationed at Pearl Harbor in Hawaii. While holiday shopping, he has his pocket picked and is then abducted by a gang. While he's



attempting to escape the gang's wrath, the naval base is attacked. Can Colvin escape his captors and get back to his ship?

Mount St. Helens Eruption: Former US Army pilot Major Thomas Deeks worked to end smuggling in South America. Fast forward to 1980 and he has changed sides and flies for a smuggling operation. Deeks is flying near Mount St. Helens in Washington State when the volcano erupts. He crashes the plane, losing the smuggler's plane and his product. Can Deeks escape the devastation and the smuggler's revenge?

Hurricane Katrina: In 2005, U.S. Marshal Bill Reece is in New Orleans to transfer a convict to a new prison. When Hurricane Katrina hits the city, a

wall of water slams into their car, rolling it over. Reece is knocked out and the convict escapes. Can Reece navigate through the flooded, storm wrecked city and catch the escaped prisoner?

NYC Blackout of 1977: Four friends had moved to New York City from Atlanta, hoping to make it big. But things hadn't worked out and they are moving home. As they are leaving the city on a hot July night in 1977, the lights go out suddenly. Can they avoid the crime and violence and get to safety?

The series is published by ABDO Books under their Magic Wagon imprint. Box sets and individual copies are available from such retailers as Amazon, Barnes and Noble, and Books-A-Million, as well as Bobby's website, www.bobbynash.com. He encourages local libraries to consider adding the series to their shelves. "I'm proud of these books and want them to get out there in as many places as possible."

I especially look forward to reading NYC Blackout of 1977. Not long ago, I read a fascinating nonfiction account of those chaotic 48 hours, and I'm interested in Bobby's historical fiction take the event.

And I hope you're looking forward to reading this issue of Lakeside Living. We have practical, entertaining, and informative features for you this month, including a tribute to one of my colleagues whose work you've been enjoying for years in these pages. As always, thank you for joining us.

HOOK LINE & SINKER

REEL IN FEBRUARY BASS WITH BIG SPINNERBAITS

February is arguably the best “big fish” month for many game species, including largemouth and spotted bass. As spring approaches (typically in March), these large pregnant bass will start to feed actively on warmer trending days.

Warming trends during and after the harsh winter months can host great opportunities for trophy bass. These large pre-spawning fish are triggered to feed during these times in order to stock up for the spawn. Using the sun in February can lead to a monster catch if you are in the right place at the right time. February is my favorite month to target these monster fish. This is because largemouth and spotted bass are at their peak weights and aggressively feeding on warming trends.

February tends to bring major rain events and lots of current to the Coosa River. Throwing big spinnerbaits in current spots can often yield huge bass. Both largemouth and spotted bass will congregate in the current breaks, and they are looking to feed aggressively. Standard bait cast equipment with heavy line will be needed. I like a heavy rod setup, paired with a 6:1 gear ratio reel. The trick is to slowly creep the spinnerbait in the current break, barely turning the reel handle.

My favorite spinner bait is the Davis Bait Company's

5/8-ounce or 1-ounce Colorado or willow blade, paired with a big grub or swimbait-styled trailer. This combo will catch some monster bass from the cold, murky waters of Logan Martin. The best targets this

time of year will be current breaks on the upriver sections of the Coosa River. Giant boulders, channel bends, and fallen trees can all create swirling pools of bass gold. The swirling water will churn and cause slack water. The slight slack in the water is where bass will congregate and feed.

These particular places aren't always the easiest to find, but once you locate a current break with some fish, it can often be nonstop action. I suggest moving around a lot, targeting different current breaks until you find an active one. Don't be afraid to move and find the aggressive fish. Try a big spinnerbait in high current and muddy conditions for a chance at catch the bass of a lifetime.

As always, I hope you have a good net!

Just a short drive from Logan Martin Lake, Lala's is the ideal place to unwind from life's trouble while having a quality dining experience. The newly opened business in St. Clair County operates as both a restaurant and bookstore.

"We want Lala's to be perfect place to grab some lunch, caffeinate midday, relax after work, or come pick up the latest book recommendation," co-owner Holli Smith said.

Opening Lala's has been a dream come true for both her and her sister, Heather Warren.

"It's something we have both always wanted to do," Smith said. "My sister and I enjoy cooking and traveling, and we wanted to provide Asheville with something a little different."

Smith and Warren are no strangers to the community. They are both teachers at Asheville High School and have lived there since the 1980s.



Caviar Deviled Eggs

Allow yourself to splurge by trying this simple, beloved appetizer with a major culinary upgrade, not to mention presentation points. After all, it is for a special occasion, right? (And if it isn't, there's certainly nothing wrong with making one up.)

Prep Time: 15 minutes

Cook Time: 10 minutes

Yield: 6 deviled eggs

Ingredients

6 eggs, hard boiled, shells removed
2 tablespoons crème fraiche
2 tablespoons mayo
1 oz. caviar
salt and pepper, to taste


Directions

Take each hard boiled egg and determine which half of the egg the yolk falls toward. Cut about 1/3 off of the egg where the yolk lies. Remove the yolk, very carefully – you don't want to break the whites. Slice off a small piece of the white on the opposite side of the egg which will allow the egg to stand straight. Reserve the hollowed eggs.

Mince the rest of the egg whites and yolks and mix in a bowl with mayonnaise and crème fraiche, stirring until fully incorporated. Season with salt and pepper.

Place the egg mixture into a piping bag with a large star tip. Pipe the egg mixture into the hollowed eggs, first filling the hollow and then to about 1 inch above the cut top. Garnish the top with 1/4 teaspoon of caviar.

Baked Salmon and Saffron Risotto

A perfectly baked salmon filet pairs with a fragrant saffron risotto in this gorgeous recipe that will carry you through any season.

Prep Time: 15 minutes

Cook Time: 20 minutes

Yield: Serves 4

Ingredients

For the salmon

Four 6-8 oz. filets of salmon
1 teaspoon fresh chopped parsley
1 tablespoon fresh chopped dill
3 tablespoons extra virgin olive oil
Juice of ½ lemon
Salt and pepper to taste

For the roasted red pepper sauce

8 oz. roasted red peppers
1 tablespoon butter
1 pint of heavy cream
1 cup grated Parmigiano cheese
1 tablespoon corn starch
Pepper to taste

For the risotto

1 cup of risotto rice
2 cups of chicken stock
1 teaspoon saffron
2 oz. (1/2 stick) of salted butter
3 tablespoons of grated Parmigiano
½ cup of frozen or fresh peas
Salt and pepper to taste

Directions

In a sauce pot on a medium heat, melt the butter with the dry risotto rice. Once the butter is melted and incorporated into the rice, add the 2 cups of chicken stock and saffron to the sauce pot and bring it to a boil. Add in the peas and stir. Continue stirring frequently for about 5 minutes until the stock is absorbed into the rice and the rice is soft. If the stock disappears and your rice is still hard, add some more chicken stock and continue stirring. Add the grated parmesan cheese, salt and pepper to taste and mix. Remove from heat.

In a bowl, combine the parsley, dill, olive oil, and lemon juice and mix. Then pass the salmon through the mixture coating both sides. Crack some

fresh pepper and a bit of salt over each filet. Bring a sauté pan to a medium heat and lightly sauté the salmon, skin side down for 4-5 minutes. Then pass to the oven to complete baking for another 4-7 minutes depending on the thickness of your salmon filets. The salmon should easily flake off with a fork, and then it's done.

Add the red roasted peppers to a blender and puree. Add the heavy cream to the blender and puree for about 10 seconds, just until the cream and red roasted peppers are fully combined. Bring a large sauté pan to a medium high heat and add the butter. Once the butter is melted, add the cream and roasted red pepper mixture from the blender. Once the mixture

begins to simmer, slowly add the parmesan cheese whisking it as you add it to keep the parmesan cheese from lumping and to make sure it fully incorporates in the sauce. Make a corn starch slurry by mixing with a small fork in a small bowl the 1 teaspoon of corn starch and 1 teaspoon of water until it's fully liquified and not clumpy. Then whisk into the roasted red pepper sauce the corn starch slurry and continue whisking – you'll notice the sauce will start to thicken. Add salt and pepper to taste, and remove the sauce from the heat.

Stuff a ½ cup measuring cup with the risotto, and then turn over onto your plate. Plate the salmon and then pour some roasted red pepper sauce around it.

Chocolate Ganache Tart with Sea Salt Flakes



Sweet with just a touch of saltiness, this is an ideal finish for a romantic meal. It calls for Couverture chocolate, a high quality chocolate that contains a high percentage of cocoa butter (at least 30 percent). The cocoa butter produces a smooth chocolate that melts and tempers easily and is silky and mellow on the tongue. If not serving right away, keep this beautiful and decadent chocolate tart in the fridge and add the salt when you serve.

Prep Time: 15 minutes

Cook Time: 3 hours 10 minutes

Yield: 1 large tart or 6 mini tarts

Ingredients

For the crust

2 cups all purpose flour
½ cup cocoa powder (bitter or bittersweet)
1 cup confectioner's sugar
¼ teaspoon. salt
1 ½ sticks of unsalted butter, cubed
1 large egg yolk
1-2 tablespoons chilled water

For the ganache

7 oz. couverture chocolate, 60 or 70 percent cacao
1 cup whipping cream
2 tablespoon white sugar
¼ cup unsalted butter, cubed
2 tablespoons whole milk, chilled
2 tablespoons sea salt flakes

Directions

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F.

Prep your food processor with a kneading attachment.

Place the flour, cocoa powder, sugar, salt and butter in a food processor and pulse until the mix gets to the texture of fine meal.

Add the egg yolk and the chilled water (keep in the fridge until use) and process until the dough ball forms.

Transfer the dough to a flat surface. If needed, sprinkle the surface with cocoa powder so it won't stick. Knead with your hands just until the dough is unified.

Roll out the dough to about ¼ inch thick.

Cover an 11-inch non-stick tart pan or 6 individual tart pans with the dough. Press the dough down on the edges then cut any extra overlapping dough with kitchen shears or a knife.

Let it rest in the fridge for about 30 minutes.

Blind bake the tart crust. Cover the tart with parchment paper (or aluminum foil) and fill with rice up to the very top. This will prevent the edges from falling down while baking.

Bake 10 to 15, until dry and just

golden. Remove from the oven, discard the paper and rice, and then bake for another 10 to 15 minutes.

Let it fully cool and remove from the pan. It should slide out easily. Set aside and get started on your ganache filling.

Place the chocolate (in pistoles, chips or previously chopped) in a medium bowl and set aside.

In a medium pot, heat up the milk, sugar and cream until just boiling.

Remove from the stove and pour into your bowl with chopped chocolate. Do not mix. Do not stir! Let it rest for about 2 minutes.

Using a metal whisk, vigorously whisk to incorporate all ingredients.

Add the cubed butter, one cube at a time, mixing until butter is fully melted. The heat from the preparation will melt the butter.

Pour the ganache into the tart(s), up until the very edges. Do it while the mix still warm. Very gently tap the tart (or tartlets) against the countertop to get the air out and the mix to settle.

Let cool at room temperature, until fully set and ganache is hardened. This will take about 2 hours.

Just before serving, sprinkle evenly with the salt flakes.



PLAN NOW TO GIVE A CHRISTMAS GIFT TO ALABAMA'S ENVIRONMENT

Your 2024 tree can become a fish habitat in Logan Martin Lake, other state waterways

At the end of the holiday season, there's always one last annual tradition: the removal of as many as 25 to 30 million real Christmas trees from homes across the United States, including many in communities around Logan Martin Lake.

Reducing, reusing and recycling can make a positive impact on the environment, especially when performed simultaneously. That lesson can be applied disposing of your Christmas tree.

Fortunately, there are many options for responsibly recycling Christmas trees. One of the most popular ways is to find a natural use for them, including sinking trees in lakes and ponds to support fish habitat.

According to Rusty Wright, an Alabama Cooperative Extension System fisheries specialist, fish are naturally attracted to submerged trees for many reasons.

"Small fish use the trees as a form of protection from larger predators," he said. "Larger fish use it as a place to wait for their prey to pass by. They also use it as protection from predators such as large fish-eating birds."

Additionally, Christmas trees can

serve as a surface for algae that supports the many insects and other aquatic animals that fish use as food. That, in turn, benefits anglers (who have their own role to play in supporting the environment) seeking to snag those fish.

"Trees help anglers more effectively catch fish," Wright said, noting that the "fish harvest, particularly harvest of bass, is critical to keeping predators and prey in balance."

For decades, Alabama Power has collected Christmas trees to use as fish habitat in its reservoirs across the state, including Logan Martin. Since 1993, more than 60,000 old Christmas trees have been used to enhance Alabama fisheries, said Mike Clelland, an environmental affairs specialist with the company.

He added that it's not only residents who make use of the program. This year, about 100 trees from a nearby Home Depot that remained unsold after Christmas 2023 will also be recycled through the partnership.

In spring of 2023, a group of 14 adults and 23 students representing Alabama Power, conservation initiatives, and bass fishing organizations dropped bundles of Christmas trees, tied to cement blocks, into reservoirs.

"We're supplementing the natural habitat in the bottom areas of the lake," Clelland said. "These trees can last about four to six years before they deteriorate, and even when the tree is gone the blocks remain. The fish love it."

Bass Anglers Sportsman Society (BASS) was among those involved. "BASS has a history of making conservation of our aquatic resources a high priority," said its conservation director, Gene Gilliland. "Alabama Power has been a great partner in those efforts for many years, working hand-in-hand with our state BASS Nation chapters and high school fishing teams on habitat enhancement projects that benefit everyone that fishes on Alabama Power reservoirs. Projects like these not only serve to help restore aging habitat, but they also offer an opportunity to educate younger generations of anglers about the

importance of protecting our aquatic resources for the future of the sport."

Many municipalities around the state offer drop-off location for natural trees. In some cases, the trees will be chipped into mulch for use by park departments. In other locations, the organic material is made available to residents for their gardens.

"Check with your local municipalities, as some have tree collection points," said Jeremy Pickens, an assistant extension professor of commercial horticulture. "These trees are often turned into mulch and sometimes the mulch is free."

Another option for repurposing Christmas trees, especially for folks in rural areas and with larger properties, is to use the trees to create natural habitat, for the benefit of multiple animal species.

"Christmas tree piles placed throughout a landscape can provide wildlife with escape

cover and thermal refuge," said Norm Haley, an Alabama Extension forestry, wildlife and natural resources regional agent.

According to Haley, the best method is to pile multiple trees on the ground. Rabbits, raccoons, opossums and even coyotes can use them as shelter, especially during the winter.

"These piles are not only used by rabbits but also by many game and nongame animals, including birds," Haley said. He suggested bird watchers spread peanut butter and birdseed on the branches to provide a winter food source.

By responsibly recycling and repurposing Christmas trees, Alabamians can provide one more gift each holiday season to benefit the state's natural environment. Actually, that would be two gifts, because recycling or repurposing natural Christmas trees also reduces the amount of waste going into landfills.

TRAINING WITH TEAM USA

Talladega athlete joins floorball delegation in Iceland



Last fall, 22 American athletes traveled to Iceland to participate in an international training camp for the sport of floorball, a Swedish floor hockey variant that has been played, mostly in Europe, for more than 60 years.

The American delegation, which included Talladega resident Ryan King, was a combination of rookies and veterans to the sport, which has surged in global popularity in recent years. They were pitted in exhibition games against Iceland's and Canada's teams. Those exhibition matches served as auditions, of sorts, to determine the Team USA roster for this month's 2024 World Championship qualifier matches against Canada.

For King, it's been a short journey to floorball's national tier. He first discovered the game a couple of years ago, when he watched it played at the 2021 World Games in Birmingham. "I was immediately captivated, just by the flow of the game," he says. During intermissions, spectators were allowed onto the court "to participate, just to run around with the ball and have fun with it," and King jumped at the chance. Before long, he'd signed up for Birmingham's Steel City Floorball Club, which organizes weekly pickup games, and was soon invited to join its Birmingham Vulcans travel team.

Floorball is played in a gymnasium. Players use hockey-like sticks to shepherd a Wiffle-like ball up and down a court toward a guarded goal. "It's nostalgic, in a way," King says. "It's the combination of a few sports into one, almost like a backyard sports activity that you would play growing up with your friends. The flow of the sport reminds me a lot of soccer, which I've played and coached for a combined 20-plus years. It's just really fun and brings out the kid in me."








The American floorball community is a mix of young and old, he says: "It's becoming very popular with the youth, but it's also popular with former hockey players. Obviously, as you get older, your body's not able to maintain that level of competitiveness in hockey. But there's a lot of hockey characteristics in floorball, so people gravitate toward it. It does get physical, especially at the professional and international level, where you're allowed shoulder-to-shoulder contact and things of that nature. But it's definitely not full-contact hockey. You get the best of all generations, in all honesty, and simple sports camaraderie. It's a very positive community."

It's taken training to play semi-professionally, of course. King says he's been focused "on getting my skillset down, getting the hand-eye coordination back from my youth, keeping the ball moving. I focused a lot on defending — just the simple things."

Coaches noticed his improvement, and he was soon asked to join the Chicago Mad Dogs floorball

team at the U.S. floorball nationals in Arlington, Texas earlier this year. A Team USA scout saw him play ("I had a really good showing," King says) and sent him a formal invitation to the Iceland camp.

Even though he's been playing floorball for less than two years, for King the opportunity is the culmination of a lifelong dream. "I've been an athlete my whole life. I've been in advanced athletics since I was about 9 or 10, and I've been working hard to basically get to this point in my life where I can represent my country in a sport I'm actually passionate about," he says. "I've come close on numerous occasions but unfortunately just did not have enough of what it took to get myself out there. Simply being considered for a spot on Team USA and asked to contribute to the effort is an honor. But I know that I've been working hard, and I've been doing a lot of studying, all of the things that I need to. And just for them to recognize that, to see that in my play, really does mean a lot."




Lakeside Flora & Fauna

Finding the embodiment of grace, hope, and vibrancy in a lakeside songbird


Bending down onto the freshly mopped hardwood floor, I lean over an upraised knee to tie the shoelaces on one of my canary yellow running shoes. Shifting my body to tie the other shoe, my mind is filled with thoughts of “Do I have to do this?” and “Do I really have to run?” Once properly tied, I slowly stand to my full yet nearly petite height. With a slight stretch of my neck, I take a deep breath before pulling open the front door.

Outside, it is still dark, and it is so chilly that my sharply exhaled

breath smokes out in the air. The ice is still formed as daggers hanging precariously from the eaves and tree branches. However, I lean into the cold air as I mentally command my feet to move. “Give it a few minutes,” I tell myself as my hips and thighs feel the incline of the hilly driveway blanketed with pine needles and oak leaves. Feeling the strenuous pushing and pulling of my leg muscles the faster I move my feet, from walking to jogging, then to running, my lungs take in more of the cold air, waking me up more.

Few minutes turn into few miles and then more as I let my thinking brain propel me into more mental running rather than the actual act itself. When

the inky darkness of the sky whispers into cotton candy-ness of gray, I feel lighter, not feeling the ground beneath my running shoes. By the time I reach the edge of the lake beyond the trail that weaves around a park peppered with pavilions and wooden picnic tables, the sky colors into a cerulean blue as the sun rises, bringing a golden aura. The sun’s warmth melts the sharp icicles, causing sporadic splattering around me, some voluptuous drops of melted ice splotching my hair and shoulders. I slow down to a stop, to stand in a brightly sunlit spot at the forest edge, within the shadows filled with foliage. While letting my hair dry in the sun, I absorb its goldenness as the



sun touches everywhere that my eyes can see like King Midas.

So Long, Bob

Lakeside Living's chief photographer heads to the house after four decades of documenting the Logan Martin lifestyle

Lakeside Living has been in continuous publication for 30 years, 13 on newsprint and 17 as a magazine. This is the first issue that has been produced without the contributions of our former chief photographer, Bob Crisp.

Bob retired at the end of 2023, after 37 years as a photojournalist for Consolidated Publishing, which produces Lakeside Living and its parent publication, The Daily Home. During those four decades, he became one of the most constant and familiar figures in the communities that he covered and was invited into hundreds of homes on and around Logan Martin Lake as the primary photographer for this feature, Lakeside Living in Style.

According to Bob, it all started as an accident.

"It was March 30, 1986," he recalls. "Easter Sunday. I was 24 years old and still living in Florence after graduating from the University of North Alabama, and we hadn't really figured out what we were going to do yet. We were looking for a place to rent in Birmingham. But we had driven out to the lake that Sunday, and when we got to the old post office, there were about 10 newspaper boxes lined up outside it. I saw the big yellow Daily Home box, and I thought that sounded like it would be local, so

we bought one."

He noticed an ad for a house for rent and went to speak with the landlord about it.

"He said he had never rented a house to anyone that didn't have a job before," Bob said. "I asked him if he was retired, and he said no, he was the publisher of The Daily Home. So I went back to the car and got out my resume.

I still believe there wasn't even really an opening, but Mr. Thornton just hired me to make sure I could pay my rent."

At first, the job was understood to be temporary, with Bob helping out Consolidated staff photographers through NASCAR race weekend. "That was the Winston 500, won by Bobby Allison that year," he said. Temporary soon became permanent, and Bob photographed every race at the Talladega Superspeedway since, 76 of them in a row, including during the COVID year, when he was the



only local photographer allowed to shoot at the track`.

His photography has appeared in all of Consolidated Publishing's publications and garnered Bob so many awards from the Alabama Press Association and the Alabama Associated Press that he lost count of them (but believes the number is "well north of 100").
