Talented SENIOR looks toward future in teaching

ANNISTON — For Anniston High School senior Alicia Berry, the journey to graduation has been, in her own words, “crazy” — a whirlwind of growth, challenges and moments that shaped who she is today.

A native of Anniston, Berry said her proudest accomplishment isn't just one moment, but the consistency she maintained throughout her high school career.

“I think my biggest accomplishment is just maintaining a good grade point average throughout my whole time,” Berry said. “Just being overly good in my studies, I guess you could say. Keeping that up, even with everything going on.”

Berry graduates with a 4.1 GPA, a mark of academic excellence that came alongside a full schedule of extracurricular activities. She played softball — moving from third base to center field — and served as section leader for the upper brass in the school band, where she played French horn.

Beyond athletics and music, Berry immersed herself in student organizations, including National Honor Society, Beta Club, FCCLA and a mathematics club.

Along the way, she found guidance in mentors who helped shape her path. Among them,

culinary arts teacher Darrelyne Jackson stands out.

“When I first got here, I didn't know what I wanted to do,” Berry said. “She helped me out through that, and I feel like she was one of the biggest people that believed in me during that time.”

Berry's high school experience also brought personal lessons — some harder than others.

“You can't trust everybody,” she said. “You call everybody your friend, but sometimes people change. You just have to be friends with yourself before you make decisions and put your trust in everyone.”

Still, the memories she cherishes most are filled with laughter and camaraderie, especially during band camp.

“Everybody is just having fun,” she said. “We all

getting yelled at for not sounding off and just making good memories together.”

When Berry first arrived at Anniston High as a freshman, she described herself as quiet and reserved. Four years later, she sees a different person.

“I was probably shy. I didn’t talk to anybody. I was really closed off,” she said. “But now I’ve been more open, and I can speak for myself. All my teachers and everybody around me just pushed me to be more open, and I really appreciate them for that.”

That growth has helped shape her future plans. Berry will attend Troy University, where she plans to study secondary mathematics education.

Her goal is rooted in her own classroom experiences.

“I saw some of my peers not grasping math,” she said. “I was always able to catch on, and I realized I want to come back one day and help my community find more ways to learn.”

Looking ahead five to 10 years, Berry envisions a life grounded in purpose and fulfillment.

“Teaching, getting a house, making my family proud,” she said. “Maybe back here, maybe not. Who knows where the road takes me, but definitely successful and happy.”

Outside the classroom, Berry enjoys creative outlets like painting and writing poetry – and, to the surprise of some,

building an extensive Lego collection.

As she prepares to graduate, Berry carries with her a deep appreciation for the place that shaped her.

“Anniston is a big part of who I am today,” she said. “People don’t always know what goes on inside the school, but it’s shaped me a lot.”

Representing Anniston High School as a graduating senior is something she doesn’t take lightly.

“It means a lot,” she said. “It’s a great honor and appreciation. I wouldn’t rather be anywhere else.”

As she reaches this milestone, Berry credits her family for their unwavering support.

“My mom for always being there and believing in me, and my dad too,” she said. “Always being there and talking me up, getting me through everything.”

Her advice to younger students is simple but heartfelt.

“Don’t try to please everybody. Just be yourself,” Berry said. “Find something that you like and push forward with it. Don’t let anybody talk you out of it.”

Shelby Blumenberg becomes Oxford High's first IB DIPLOMA CANDIDATE

OXFORD — When Oxford High School senior Shelby Blumenberg walks across the graduation stage in May, she won't just be closing a chapter. She'll be making school history.

Blumenberg is Oxford High's first full International Baccalaureate diploma candidate, completing the globally recognized two-year program that only recently became available to OHS students. The program, which emphasizes college-level coursework, interdisciplinary learning and international perspectives, was authorized at Oxford three years ago. Blumenberg is the first student able to complete the entire diploma track from start to finish.

"It is very extensive and can cover up to two years of coursework at the college level," Oxford High School's IB coordinator Julia Hill said. "Shelby is our first person who has gone through the whole two-year program."

Hill said the school began offering individual IB courses earlier, but Blumenberg is the first to complete the full diploma. Seven students are expected to follow next year, with growing interest among underclassmen.

For Blumenberg, the path began early. She credit-advanced as a freshman, took AP courses as a sophomore and discovered she wanted something more immersive.

"Originally I didn't plan to do the full diploma," she said. "But after talking out more details about what IB is, I was really interested in the possibility of getting a second diploma."

Her favorite class pushed her to think beyond traditional coursework.

"One of the common things we use to explain it is, how do we know what we know?" she said of the program's Theory of Knowledge course. "It really helps relate all of your classes together."

The IB diploma also requires an extended essay, a creativity-activity-service portfolio and a month-long project aimed at personal and community growth. Hill said those components help students connect their learning to the world around them.

"You're not just learning in isolation," Hill said. "You're seeing how what you learn affects your community and other communities worldwide."

Blumenberg has done all of this while remaining deeply involved in school and community life. A dedicated cheerleader, she performs for OHS and competes through the World of Performing Arts and Universal Cheerleaders Association. She is active in the Academy of Fine Arts and Languages, studies Spanish and helps organize cheer clinics for younger students. Outside school, she volunteers through her church, supporting efforts to help unhoused residents in Calhoun County.

Hill said Blumenberg's example has already shaped the next wave of IB students.

"They'll be like, well, Shelby's doing it," she said. "She's still involved in cheer, dance and church. So it is doable, even though sometimes the intensity of the program, all the testing, happens at once."

Blumenberg hopes her journey encourages others to take academic risks.

"I'm hoping to show them that challenging yourself isn't always scary," she said. "If you want something, go for it."

Her own goals are already mapped out. She plans to attend Belmont University and major in international business before heading to law school. With the credits she's earned, she expects to enter

college as a sophomore or even a junior.

"I hopefully will be able to graduate before the four years with the extra credits," she said. "Then I'll get into law school and be able to be a lawyer at a very young age."

As the first IB diploma candidate in Oxford High School's history, Blumenberg knows her name will be remembered. "It's kind of cool knowing I'll be the first one," she said. "It's exciting for sure."

PIEDMONT — A Piedmont High School senior preparing to graduate in May, River Cox has built a record of academic success and personal growth while overcoming early-life challenges.

River began living with Keena and David Cox at age 13 and was formally adopted at 15. He said his experience in Piedmont schools helped shape who he is today.

"I would say it's the teachers. Like any teacher that you have, you can't always have a close relationship with. Here at Piedmont, that's on another level," he said.

He said his first-grade teacher was Tiffany Farmer, who also taught him again in fifth grade. She stands out as being the most influential.

"She was always really kind to me, and she always made me laugh whenever I was kind of down some days. She is a really good teacher."

Academically, River has excelled.

"I'm an all-A student," he said. "I have an honors diploma, and I'm also in the National Honor Society."

Beyond the classroom, he participates in the school's Fire Academy Program and volunteers through Big Brothers Big Sisters. In his younger days, he played football and other sports. Currently, he is focused on excelling in track and field.

"Before I was adopted. I felt I would enjoy the Big Brother Big Sisters program," he said. "It's always nice to have someone close to your age who is not an adult."

River said he enjoys spending time outdoors, especially fishing.

"My favorite hobby to do is fishing. I find it really peaceful," he added.

After graduation, he plans to attend the University of West Alabama in Livingston to study forestry technology.

"It's something that I can see myself doing because it doesn't involve me being inside," he said.

River said a job shadowing experience helped solidify his interest.

Looking ahead, he said his mindset will guide him through challenges.

"My attitude for problems that I have, like the other problems I'll have in life, well, it's just life. Things are going to happen, but it's not going to stop me from achieving my goals."

He also leans on his faith.

"I always rely on God to be a shoulder to lean on," he said.

School leaders say River's determination stands out, noting his perseverance and character as he prepares for his next chapter.

His principal, Adam Clemens, said River is
