



#### Simple Ways to Catch Fall Bass

Elite Series pro Boyd Duckett says if you're seeing a lot of schooling bass break the surface, it's always a good idea to throw a topwater before leaving the area. Whether you're throwing a walking or popping topwater, it's important to make long casts and fish quickly.

**Catch larger fish with a walking bait**—"My favorite walking bait is a Yamamoto Tate' 100 Series," Duckett said. "Walking topwater baits absolutely catch bigger fish in the fall and I think it's because they really trigger a bass' predatory instincts. That big bass thinks something is trying to get away and it can't help but attack it."


Tired of short strikes on your topwater lures? In order to hook more bass, Duckett suggests reeling in your lure when it gets halfway back to the boat. Most of his short strikes come while his lure is close to the boat, so he reels it in quickly to avoid missing any opportunities at a big bass.

**Get more bites with a popper**—"You'll definitely get a lot more bites on a small topwater popper, such as a Yamamoto Shibuki 60 Series," Duckett said. "So when it's tough and a limit will carry you a long way, it's the way to go. The further you cast it, the more fish you'll catch, so long casts are essential. I use 8-pound Vicious Braided Line and a spinning rod to get maximum casting distance."

What to look for—"I want to see two specific things before throwing a topwater lure," Duckett said. "I need to see bait on my electronics that is in 5 feet of water or less and I also need to see balls of bait just underneath the surface. It's nothing for a big bass to come up from 5 feet to destroy a big topwater plug."

**Upsize your hooks**—"A lot of times I'll put a larger hook on the back of my walking baits," Duckett said. "You have to be careful not to screw up the balance of the lure, but bigger hooks make it splash more and also help you get more hookups. If you don't buy a bait with ultra-sharp hooks, you need to replace them—a lot of your fall topwater fish will be hooked in the side of the face, making sharp hooks paramount."

Any body of water – Logan Martin Lake included – has the potential at any given time to be the crossroads of the world, the setting for unexpected encounters with individuals you find hard to forget.

You can't plan for it. It just has to happen, as it did late one breezy afternoon when I first crossed paths with Galatea Berger.

Shoeless in a long white flowing dress, she was sitting on a lakeside dock taking in some Vitamin D and doing her best to resemble the fabled ivory statue carved by Pygmalion of Cyprus that is her namesake.

"The movement of the water is very calming," she told me and Carrie. "I find it magical and somewhat hypnotic watching the ripples connect and listening to the quiet sounds of nature. When the sun is rising or setting over the water, it sparkles like diamonds."

# It's time for Fall Frenzy at Lakeside Park Fun event benefits local schools

Bill Pruitt has a passion for the Pell City School System, and Fall Frenzy is the proof. The event, returning to Logan Martin Lake for its second year, benefits the school system, with more than \$25,000 raised during the inaugural.

"\$25,029.53," Pruitt said, to be exact. "When enough

people ask you, it gets burned onto your brain."

Lakeside Park plays host to the event on October 10, offering many activities for attendees to choose from. Pruitt said he is optimistic about the turnout.

"Despite the weather, we had 4,300 people (come last

year). This year, we're having it a little bit earlier in the month. We moved it up three weeks because of a cold snap last year. It was 30 degrees."

Though the main events begin at 10 a.m., early risers may want to participate in the 5K run, which begins at 8 a.m. For those who enjoy a little competition, Fall Frenzy will feature a corn hole tournament at 11:30 a.m. As far as other differences from last year's event, "there will be more carnival rides," Pruitt said.

The day also includes a classic car show, starting at 11 a.m., and live music, starting at 10 a.m. and wrapping up at 6 p.m.

The event is sponsored by the Pruitt & Richardson Charitable Foundation, a project that Pruitt helped start. "The foundation was set up for this event," he said. "It works with the school system to help put money into the schools."

The money raised from last year's event was divided up and awarded based on school participation, an arrangement organizers plan to follow this year.

"Each school organization that participates (plays host) to free kids activities," Pruitt said. "It's an opportunity for them to earn their own money." It's completely up to the organizations of each school as to how they want to

spend their funds. Last year, for example, "the Arts Honors Society purchased senior portfolios," Pruitt said. "Some organizations funded field trips."

Along with Fall Frenzy, the foundation has flourished into so much more. "With (the help of) Police Chief Greg Turley and the high school, we finalized the Lt. Richard Woods Memorial Scholarship," he said. "Richard was a friend of ours. We worked with him a lot through our law office, and it seemed to be the perfect fit."

Woods was a longtime member of the Pell City Police Department who died in the line of duty last year.



# Whatever the name, Pell City teen calls it just plain fun

Seventeen-year-old BayLee Pollard gingerly treads the chest-high, water of Logan Martin Lake, a look of intense concentration on his face.

He's fishing, though the uninformed passerby might not be able to tell. This kind of fishing is a far cry from the pastoral pastime of leaning back in a boat, dry, rod and reel in hand and a line in the water.

He's searching for catfish nests, feeling for them with his bare feet so he knows where to stick his hand – using his fingers as bait – to wrench a bottom feeder from its home.

"Where is it?" Pollard asks himself. "This hole is always

hard to find."

He eventually finds what he's looking for, having felt the hole in the mud. The next second, he bobs in the water, takes a deep breath and plunges into the murky depths in search of his catch.

Five seconds pass. The water is still stirring from where he dove under the surface.

Ten seconds. The surface is now completely calm.

Twenty seconds. A bubble breaks the surface of the water. He's unearthed his prize, or lost his breath.

Thirty seconds. The water is once again calm.

Then, as quickly as he submerged, Pollard reappears, a look of jubilation on his face and a flathead catfish on his hand.

"Wow, I got me one," Pollard said, catching his breath. "That's a good sign."

Pollard has just successfully pulled off what may be the most extreme form of fishing in the southern United States.

They call it noodling in these parts, or catfisting, grabbling or graveling. Pollard doesn't much care what it's called, though his favorite term is "hogging." All he cares about is that it's fun.

Pollard hit several "honey holes" over the course of an hour, but the initial success he took as a good sign seemed instead to be a false indicator. The late summer heat had driven the catfish from their spawning beds,

and no more were biting. Time and time again, Pollard emerged from the water, empty-handed.

He didn't seem to mind too much. It's still fishing, after all.

"That's basically what it is," Pollard said. "It's called fishing for a reason, and not catching."

Pollard is by no means an expert on the extreme sport. He picked it up on a whim in June after deciding the conventional method had grown boring. He decided it was worth a try, having seen televised documentaries and heard stories about the unconventional fishing method.

Much like the orthodox version, fishing tales abound in the world of noodling. And Pollard has heard some doozies.

The man who first showed him the intricacies of the sport, for example, regaled the rookie with a fantastic tale of wrestling a 125-pounder out of the water, with the help of some friends, of course.

Over the course of his brief noodling career, Pollard has also brought back plenty of stories of his own to his grandfather's dock, where his boat is housed. His most recent details a 15-minute ordeal with a 15-pound mudcat that simply would not leave its bed.

It's a hobby Pollard never thought he'd take up. When he first heard of the sport, he called its practitioners crazy. A few months later, Pollard doesn't mind others calling him the same thing, including his mother, Candi Pollard.

"I still think he's a little crazy," she said, laughing, "but it's something he enjoys, so I have to support him."

It might seem crazy, but Pollard has worked the fishing method into a science, and a safe one at that.

He always searches the shallows of older docks and seawalls so the mud has settled enough for catfish to burrow into. He knows the telltale warning signs of reaching

into a snake hole or the maw of a snapping turtle.

He knows to always bring spotters just in case the underwater bouts become too hairy, and he can usually persuade his friends from Coosa Valley Academy to join him.

He's even fashioned noodling poles, 8-foot PVC pipes that house stainless steel hooks, able to test the depth of a nest and snatch a fish out without needing to stick his hand in.

Even with his refined technique, Pollard is not without his battle wounds. Though catfish aren't designed to pierce, cut or tear into their food, the sandpaper-like teeth lining their mouths are still enough to scrape skin off an ungloved hand, leaving scars. Pollard's remind him to always wear gloves.

"I think it was about my fourth or fifth trip," Pollard said." It was when we wrestled with a mudcat for about 15 minutes. It would lock onto your hand, and you couldn't pull it out. Finally we were smart enough – because our hands were all cut up and bleeding – to put some gloves on to fish that sucker out."

For the most part, Candi Pollard can see her son has a handle on noodling safety. With that said, she also understands it's an inherently dangerous activity and can't help but feel apprehension when he takes to the water.

Even so, she has acquiesced to her son's new pastime, so long as he continues to adhere to safe fishing and boating practices.

She has even considered joining him in one of his future excursions.

"Now, to stick my hand in a hole to pull out a fish?" Pollard said. "I will not do that."

That's all right for her son, who is now well along into his senior year at Coosa Valley Academy and too busy to spend all his time on the water anyway.

But next summer promises the same exhilarating adventure he discovered earlier this year. After all, it's just plain fun.

"Once you start noodling, and you first feel it bite your hand," Pollard said, "you're hooked."







While they are in the market for a new RV ("The next one we get, we'd like to have double slides," Jerry said. "We've been looking, but they're hard to find"), the Wallaces have no plans to leave Lakeside Landing.

"We really enjoy it here," Jerry said. "It's not for everybody, but for us, it's great. We've always liked camping and the outdoors, and we feel like we're camping out every day."

Ever since she was a child, Joy Sorensen has enjoyed showing off her basement.

At least that's how she regards the naturally-formed underground chamber with the 12-story ceiling that serves as the main attraction at DeSoto Caverns Family Fun Park near Childersburg. The property has been in Sorensen's family for more than 100 years, and she's the fifth generation to be involved with its operation.

"This cave is part of my DNA," she said. "I've been proud of it ever since I was little. I've always thought it was an incredible place."

Sorensen and her husband Jared, who serve as the park's artistic and events directors, have given it a seasonal makeover this month, transforming it into the Haunted Halloween Park complete with scary thrill attractions and a family festival involving more than 50 actors and entertainers. The Halloween-themed events will be open Thursdays through Sundays for the remainder of the month.

Thrill seekers can visit www.desotocavernspark.com for full details, but Sorensen – sitting with Jared on a lakeside dock – explained what they can expect to see at the haunted park and even told a couple of fish stories.

**The cave:** The Tomb of the Risen Dead. "It will be a lot different from our regular guided tours. The cave is sacred ground – that's not a hidden secret for most of our guests – but in this attraction, guests will be viewed as trespassing on sacred burial ground by the dead army that will be climbing up and rising out of the ground."

**The maze:** The Labyrinth of Lost Souls. "There will be three towers inside the maze with actors in each who will speak to the guests and give them options. The maze will be choiceand-reward-oriented. You'll be given gifts which the characters will coax you to give up as they try to pull you into their world, so the outcome will depend on the choices you make."

**The Festival for All:** For families, younger children and the more faint of heart, the festival area will feature storytellers, fire breathers, stilt performers and family-friendly comedians. "With entertainment like this, we don't think people will be disappointed," Sorensen said. A bonfire, s'mores, hand-dipped caramel apples and other favorite fall foods will be available, and a costume party will be part of the event during its last two weeks.

Is there an age limit for the thrill attractions? "There is not.



They are very definitely PG, but we trust that parents will know their children and which parts of the event will be suitable for them. You can drop your teenager at the thrill area and go with your younger kids to the festival. Then as soon as the teenagers come out of the haunted attractions, everybody can meet up and enjoy the festival together. You don't have to split the family up. We have tried very hard and spent a lot of long nights working to make sure there's something for everyone, and our goal is for this is to be an event families can come to in the fall and just enjoy being together."

**Scary inspiration:** "Disneyworld is a major inspiration for this event, but it's also heavily inspired by some of the top haunted parks in the world, such as Spookers in New Zealand, which is a terrifying park, and Headless Horseman Hayrides & Haunted Houses in Ulster Park, New York, which has been recognized among the top haunted attraction in the United States. It's definitely going to be scary, and I say that as the person who has her head buried in the back of her husband's shoulders at attractions like this."

**Her favorite lakeside activity:** "I love smallmouth bass fishing. Perch is actually my favorite fish to eat, but bass gives the best filets. I'm a fisherwoman at heart. If I don't fish regularly, it hurts."

**Her biggest catch:** A northern pike she reeled in while lake fishing in Wisconsin, although she doesn't remember its exact size. "It was huge, but huge to me is probably minute to anybody else." Her largest smallmouth bass was 19 inches long, "but I've lost many that I could tell large tales about. One thing I've realized is that bass fishing isn't just about fishing. It's about community."

The time she almost needed a bigger boat: "When I was in Australia, the first thing I did was find a way to go deep sea fishing, even though I was in a full dress and heels. Our boat caught a young great white shark that day."

An ideal day on the lake: "I'd start the day with some fishing, go sailing after lunch and then take the canoe out at sunset."

**How she describes herself:** "Joyful. I think I was named well."
