#### The man who made Mr. Gip cry

ne of the great American bluesmen is coming to Logan Martin Lake, and I am pumped about it, I don't mind telling you.

Kent Duchaine is a modest fellow, so he would likely disagree with being described thusly, instead preferring to talk about the blues greats he's worked with over the years, which is what he'll be doing between songs during his 3 p.m. set at the Logan Martin Blues, Brews & BBQ festival at Lakeside Park on Saturday, August 19.

"Boy, I'll tell you what, there's no telling what will happen," he said with a chuckle by phone from his home on Lake Eufuala in Georgia, a day or two back from a European tour of 40 shows in Great Britain and 5 in Italy. "I'll play some of my original songs in traditional blues styles, then a few lovey-dovey tunes, and then we'll take a trip across America, from my hometown in Minneapolis, down the Mississippi River to New Orleans."


The musical journey will be accompanied by stories about the musicians Duchaine has known and shared the stage with since he started playing blues in Minneapolis bars four decades ago: Muddy Waters, Bukka White, Johnny Shines and legendary bluesman Robert Johnson, who died at age 27 in 1938. Shines and Johnson were contemporaries, and Duchaine got to hear all of Shines' stories about Johnson when they toured together in the mid-1990s.

Duchaine will have to leave Logan Martin immediately after his set, bound for Tuscaloosa where he's booked to play the Johnny Shines Memorial Blues Fest. "I always do the Johnny Shines festival," he said. "Two festivals on the same day is going to be tough, but I'm excited to be asked to come and play in Pell City."

Organized by the Greater Pell City Chamber of Commerce, the Logan Martin Blues, Brews & BBQ festival – with its barbeque cookoff, children's activities and entertainment by five other acts besides Duchaine – promises to be a fantastic late summer event. Lakeside Living celebrates late summer in this issue, with features about lake life in August, some tasty beverage recipes, a preview of CoosaPalooza and a visit to a Riverside home that we're sure you'll enjoy reading.

But before moving along to them, here's a fun story Duchaine told about the first time he played Gip's Place near Birmingham, one of the last honest-to-goodness juke joints in America. World-famous and revered by blues fans, it's been operated by Henry Gipson since 1952.

"Gip used to come in and see me when I played late nights at Marty's (in Homewood). We hit it off, and he asked me to come and play at his place. Eventually I did, and there was a houseful there that night. People were partying, Gip played a little, and I played a lot."



As the night went on, Duchaine was on stage with Leadbessie – his 83-year-old National Steel guitar – when two stern, tough-looking characters in Gipson's employ approached the stage.

"They said, 'Boy, we want to talk to you."

Somewhat apprehensively, fearing he might have offended his host, Duchaine said, "Sure, what's up?"

"They said, 'Boy, you made Mr. Gip cry. He wants you come back and play every Saturday night."

Be at Lakeside Park at 3 p.m. for the blues festival, and you'll understand why.

#### Late summer fishing tips

Bass fishing in the heat of the summer can be slow and frustrating. Here are a few tips on how to make for a more successful trip while bass fishing in late summer.


Start out way before sun up. At least an hour before the posted sun rise is best, because posted sunrise is only about 30 to 45 minutes later than when it gets light enough to fish. By getting started that early, you are taking advantage of two things.

First, the water temperature is the coolest that it is going to be for that day, and in the late summer, cooler water usually means more active fish.

Second, you will be taking advantage of about one hour of low light conditions. Bass, like most other fish, feel more comfortable lurking in the shadows or low light. Thus the fish are more cooperative towards eating your lures.

Fishing these conditions, it's good to start with a spinner bait, inline spinner bait or a buzz bait. All three put off major sound vibrations, allowing the fish to hone in on the sound. Working the lures will vary from day to day but you can almost guarantee if you toss it on the edge and slowly retrieve it back to the boat, it won't be long before a bass is pulling on the other end.


ugust is a special time, once described by writer Victor Nekrasov as a month of apples and falling stars, of hot days that are sunny, clear and hinting of advancing autumn.

neighborhood near Funderburg Bend Road that was initially developed by her grandparents – but have relocated to Birmingham, where they both work, Michael as a dentist practicing at Cahaba River Family & Implant Dentistry in Vestavia and Meagan as director of marketing and advertising for Schaeffer Eye Center. The property was covered with trees then, and they cleared it off and built. As a wedding present, they gave my parents the land across the street from where they built. My parents, Cris and Randy Freeman, have lived here for 32 years, and this is where I grew up. This is all I've ever known."

Megan has many childhood memories connected with Logan Martin, including losing her first tooth while inner tubing on the lake. The tooth was literally lost, and she remembers placing a drawing of it under her pillow for the tooth fairy.

Michael is the son of lake dwellers Mike and Jayne Price, and one of his earliest lake memories involves his father teaching him to waterski.

"We had a jet ski, and my dad put me behind it and told me, 'Hang on, and don't let go.' It wasn't long before I went face first into the water, but I didn't let go." Front yard or back yard, "the best part of summer is spending time on the lake with family and friends and being out in the sun." August, she added, is an ideal time for it.



"Inflatables are very big right now," according to Meagan.

In the meantime, there is always still so much to do."





have the venue from Friday to Sunday, and they get all five guest rooms. #### **Dreamsicle Margarita**

Cheers to lake weather with a Dreamsicle Margarita. Use fresh oranges, and you will be so pleased you took the time to mix up this refreshing, nostalgic treat.

- 2 oz blanco tequila (I chose a wonderful new tequila I found, Codigo)
- 1 orange, squeezed
- 1 oz Lillet blanc
- 1 egg white
- orange peel


#### **Blueberry Mojito**

- mint to garnish



#### Frosé

The perfect summer party drink. There should be a warning label on this official drink of summertime that is so delicious and so easy to drink. For the smoothest Frosé, blend in your Vitamix.

- 1 bottle rosé (I chose Gerard Bertrand)
- 3-4 oz simple syrup
- 1/2 cup frozen strawberries
- 2 lemons, juiced

Pour rosé into a 13×9" pan and freeze until almost solid, at least 6 hours, I did this overnight. Meanwhile, bring 1/2 cup sugar and ½ cup water to a boil in a medium saucepan; cook, stirring constantly, until sugar dissolves, about 3 minutes. Reserve for blending Frosé.

Scrape rosé into a blender. Add lemon juice, 3-4 son simple syrup, 1/2 cup frozen strawberries and purée until smooth. Transfer blender jar to freezer and freeze until frosé is thickened, about 30 minutes.

Blend again until Frosé is slushy. Divide among glasses.

Garnish with small roses, rose petals or strawberries.

#### Prickly Pear Margarita

A popular menu item out west, the prickly pear is named for its pear-like shape and size. This fruit comes from any of several varieties of cacti. Prickly pear has a sweet but not overly sweet flavor that will take your margarita to the next level. It actually pairs very well with a little spice, so if you like the heat, throw in a jalapeño.1/4 cup blueberries

- 1/2 cup crushed ice
  2 oz freshly-squeezed lime juice
  3 oz Grand Mayan Reposado Tequila
  1 ounce Cheri's Prickly Pear Cactus Syrup (or other prickly pear syrup)
- , pinch of salt
- lime wedges for garnish

In a blender, add crushed ice, lime juice, tequila, prickly pear syrup and salt. Cover and pulsate 4 or 5 times. Taste and adjust with syrup or lime juice according to your taste. Serve in salt-rimmed glasses with a lime slice and serve immediately.



up, and the workers would come in and get their tools," Teresa said with a laugh.

### 25 years -- and counting -of summer swim lessons Written by Adrinece Beard Photographed by Tucker Webb

Jean Speer's motto is 'if I provide the pool and I provide your lessons for free, there's is absolutely no reason for you and or your child not to learn.'

Speer describes swimming as a life skill, one people can use for the rest of their lives, as recreation or in an emergency. She believes it's a particularly important skill for residents of Pell City, because it is a lake community.

A native of the community, she has swam most of her life, starting at age 2. She later became a lifeguard for such public pool services as the YMCA and was inspired by a swim instructor, Keith Etheredge, who taught her the importance of giving lessons. Etheredge is now the head football coach of Pell City High School.

Speer currently trains three swim coaches from Pell City. They are Macayla Doss, 16, Margaret Seay, 17, and Hilary Hadley, 18, who rotate with Speer each week helping her coach the students. "It gives me more one-on-on time with them," said Speer.

"The first thing that Ms. Jean always teaches is water safety. Unintentional drowning is a big thing," said Seay. Speer teaches her swimmers how to pull themselves up from underwater, in case they are ever thrown in, as Doss says she was by her father who was teaching her the skill. "It was fun," Doss recalled.

"My teaching is a little unconven-

tional," Speer said. "Most swim instructors will teach you to float and sit on top of the water first. I do not do that. I teach underwater swimming from day one. If a child falls into this lake or into a pool or any body of water, it does no good for them to be able to swim on top of the water if they can't get themselves up."

For the past 25 years, she has taught more than 1,000 youngsters, including second-generation and special-needs swimmers. With the help of Facebook, the word about her free lessons spreads quickly in St. Clair County, and each year there's a waiting list of 50 or more people, which is all the more reason she welcomed Doss, Seay and Hadley to the team.

"I have never charged for a lesson and I never will," Speer said.

Children as young as 3 years old come from Pell City, Talladega, Lincoln, Leeds and Birmingham to be taught. However, priority is given to returning swimmers, their siblings and those with special needs. Each child gets five days worth of lessons, which are 45 minutes long.

"Truthfully, you can only keep a child's attention for 30 minutes," Speer said. "If they leave frustrated, they don't want to come back the next day. If they leave having a good time, they're geared up for the next day."



Adults are also welcome. Speer's eldest swimmer was 78.

She said the biggest challenge is getting people over their fear of water, which, to her surprise, comes more from

adults than children. "They're much more cautious as adults because they've had a traumatizing experience or know what can happen.

"I have a lot of grandmothers who now want to take their grandbabies to the pool, but they can't swim," she said, in reference to the senior citizen swim class she offers this summer. "It is a group of 12 women, mainly grandmothers and a few mothers. They either never learned because they didn't have access to water, or some incident occurred when they were younger that made them terrified of water, or they never thought it would be something they'd be interested in."

This summer, Speer finished the 8-week lessons with 172 students. Everyone is awarded with a bronze, silver or gold medal for their accomplishments. At first, parents are discouraged by their children not doing as well as others in the class, but Speer assures they will get it in their own time. "Swim is 90 percent confidence, 10 percent skill," she explained. children's transition from start to finish. "I love to see when they are happy that they've succeeded at doing something, and they're like 'I did it'," Doss said. "It just makes me happy."

Seay said, "Everybody goes at a different pace, but you can always see how some kids maybe just got over their fear and others are like fish."

Each year, Speer recognizes Jordan Decker, in particular. Decker, 31, was her first special-needs swimmer as a child with Down's syndrome.

"He is my biggest accomplishment within that. He has won multiple medals in the Special Olympics for his swimming." She said he is the reason she continues to teach children with special needs.

Speer hopes her three trainees will continue to do what she did for them for the next generation of swimmers, although she never intends to give up teaching. "I hope that I can always do it. I hope I can do it when I'm a senior," she said.

Both Doss and Seay attested to this, witnessing the

dock, 5 poker chips with my number on them and one playing card marked with my number on the back.
