



## Traditional storytelling with a positive message

Singer-songwriter Peter Boyle is jazzed about his upcoming performance at the Logan Martin Lakefest and Boat Show.

He considers it a second chance of sorts, as he was scheduled to appear at last year's event, but an unexpected illness forced him to spend that weekend in the hospital instead. Recovered and now at work on an album, the Cropwell resident can't wait to take the stage at Lakeside Park later this month.

"Man, it's a fantastic opportunity," he said. "I hated I missed it last year. My music is home-grown. Its roots are buried right here in Cropwell and Pell City, and I'm looking forward to playing the songs I've written for the local folks and getting their feedback."

Boyle describes his sound as "a mix of traditional country, folk, bluegrass and Southern rock all rolled into one." The audience for his set — which kicks off the Lakefest entertainment at 4 p.m. Friday, May 15 — can expect to hear how he blends those styles in such songs as "Easonville," "Secrets of Life" and "Southern Train," which have as their influences Logan Martin Lake, Richey's Grocery in Pell City and central Alabama in general.

"My songs are based on my life experiences," he said. "It's traditional storytelling that carries a positive message. I believe people from this area can relate to them."

Accompanying Boyle on the Lakefest stage will be guitarist Ryan Ollard of Iron City Pickers — a local group that will perform its own set the following afternoon — and Boyle's 13-year-old daughter, Blair Marie.

"Let me tell you, man, she is fantastic," he said. "She has an angelic voice that can sing anything from Miranda Lambert to opera. She has more talent in her pinky finger than I have in my whole body."

Boyle's journey as a musician has hardly been traditional. Born in Ohio, he grew up in southern California and "was in bands on and off for several years, everything from country to Southern rock to alternative to hard rock." In his mid-20s, he took a break from music to go back to school and now has two degrees in psychology and counseling. He began getting back into the music scene and in March 2013 was challenged to write a song for Autism Awareness Month.

"The challenge was to write the song without using the word autism within the lyrics," he said. "Being a singersongwriter, as well as a mental health professional, I took this challenge to heart and what emerged was a song with a far greater reach than I could have possibly imagined. 'Tomorrow's a Better Day' is a song inspired by God, and it reaches into the lives of all individuals that may be struggling in the countless number of life's circumstances."

It's a song he's sure to include in his set at Lakefest. In this issue, we're proud to provide you with plenty of information about the entire event. Some of its original organizers were kind enough to recall its early days and explain the many ways it supports lakeside communities.

Also in this issue, we preview such upcoming events as the Pell City Block Party, the Riverside Poker Run and the first-ever Summer Lights on Logan Martin Lake. ### **Spring Crappie Fishing Tips**


Crappie anglers often consider fishing to be at its best in early morning, but spring fishing can be more successful in the late afternoon and early evening. Early in the season, water usually takes three days after a cold front before it warms significantly enough to increase crappie and bass activity.

Because water warmer than 40°F is more buoyant than cooler water, spring warming creates a shallow, warmer layer of water late in the day on the downwind side of the lake. Although air will cool quickly after sunset, water retains its heat for quite some time. Because of the warmer water and better predatory efficiency of crappie during low light conditions, these fish feed more aggressively in the late afternoon and early evening during the spring. Night fishing can be excellent as fish move into a lake's tributaries.

Both plastic and marabou jigs catch crappie, but the small jigs have an advantage. Small jigs stay in the crappie's strike zone longer than large jigs. Although many colors are used, anglers often use yellow and white, sometimes with a brightly painted head. Black jigs seem to be more effective during crappie spawning season. Because lighter line helps anglers feel the action of the jig, eight-pound test is the maximum suggested. A four-to six-pound line may yield higher catches at the cost of a few more jigs.

Fishing line should be heavy enough to pull a crappie hook out of a snag without breaking but should be light enough that the split shot keeps the fishing line tight. Twelve-pound test monofilament line may be ideal. Remember that unused live bait may not be released into the water being fished.

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# Thousands to meet at the lake this month Logan Martin Lakefest and Boat Show set for May 15-17

Settling into the upholstery of the bow seating in Jerry Woods' office and looking out at the afternoon sun glistening off the water is about as close as one can get to cruising Logan Martin Lake in a pontoon boat without actually doing it.

He's been on the lake for 10 summers as the owner of Woods Surfside Marina and is among the original organizers of one of its biggest annual events, the Logan Martin Lakefest and Boat Show. Lakeside Park in Pell City plays host to this year's event May 15-17, when Woods predicts more than 7,000 people will "fill up the local hotels and restaurants."

"It's taken on a life of its own since the first year we did it, which was a true learning experience," he said. "We used to have to beg people to come. This year, we had people begging us to let them in to be a part of it."

Billed as the South's largest in-water boat show, Lakefest opens at 1 p.m. Friday, May 15, and concludes 4 p.m. Sunday,

May 17. Vendors' fishing boats, pontoon boats and other powered watercraft will be in the water for test drives, and exhibits of outdoor kitchens, patio furniture and fishing tackle and product demonstrations will also be part of the event.

Live music is scheduled Friday and Saturday, including such local performers as Peter Boyle and the Iron City Pickers. Tiki Island Concessions, whose crab cakes were a hit at last year's event, joins Golden Rule BBQ in headlining the food vendors. Such "fair foods" as funnel cakes, corn dogs, cotton candy and snow cones will also be available.

Admission and parking are free. Upon entering, attendees will receive tickets for giveaways of such products as kayaks, paddle board and Yeti coolers.

"It's a great opportunity to come out, enjoy the lake, test drive a boat and meet some people who support the lake lifestyle and love giving back to the community," said Eric

Housh, another Lakefest organizer.

"Lakefest LLC has donated around \$50,000 back to the community and local organizations in the four years we have put on the event," said Justin Hogeland, who handles advertising and public relations for the event. "We expect to give another \$10,000 to local causes after this year's Lakefest."

Beneficiaries of Lakefest proceeds include the Logan Martin Lake Protection Association (LMLPA), the Alabama Sheriff's Boys Ranch, the Pell City Police Department's DARE program and local civic organizations and school sports teams.

"Every year, we've been able to identify different organizations that were needing help in a variety of ways," said Fred Casey, owner of Tradesman Company and another of the event's original organizers. "Through the years, we've seen exponential growth in how we've been able to give back to the community."

Casey and Woods said the small group that created Lakefest had no idea the event would so quickly turn into the attraction



it has become.

"Historically, Lakefest was an idea that myself and Fred conceived when Bill Herford was running for mayor (of Pell City) and we were talking about what we could do to promote Logan Martin," Woods said. "At the time, Mike Riley was president of the LMLPA, and with Eric Housh and Lee Holmes, we put together the concept of an on-thewater boat show."

"We realized one of the things we were utilizing the least in promoting our area was our greatest asset – the lake," Casey said.

"We wanted it to accomplish a number of objectives," Housh said. "We wanted it to be a three-day celebration to kick off summer that brings the community





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
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
together, showcases the lake, highlights local businesses and supports worthy charitable organizations. We also wanted to work with local sponsors to cover the costs so that no one has to pay admission. It is a very cool thing that our sponsors do for the community. They don't have to do it, but they choose to invest in us, and we appreciate their support."

This year's sponsors include America's First Federal Credit Union, Town and Country Ford, Poor House Branch Marina, Extreme Printing and KOs Body Shop, Caribe Club

"The city (of Pell City) has been tremendous in its support," Woods said. "Bubba Edge and the parks and recreation crew





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have been fantastic to work with. They make things happen for us. The Pell City Police Department has been great at helping us with traffic and safety. So many people dedicate a lot of time to making this event something that the entire community can be proud of."

Housh described Lakefest as an event to be enjoyed by residents of lakeside communities, even those who are not in the market for a new boat.

"It's just a great opportunity to come out, eat some great food, listen to some great music, see some neat things and enjoy being at the lake."



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


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# Three big events on the horizon Block Party, Poker Run, Lake Lights set for June



Thousands are once again expected to attend the 16th annual Hometown Block Party in Pell City.

Now that Logan Martin has returned to full pool, it's time for event season on the lake.

Following the Logan Martin Lakefest and Boat Show this month, three of the year's biggest events are coming up in June.

Pell City's Hometown Block Party:

#### 5-10 p.m. Saturday, June 6

The 16th annual event is expected to again bring thousands of people to downtown Pell City, the Gateway to Logan Martin Lake.

"Traditionally, the block party was scheduled on the first Friday in June, but it was moved to the first Saturday for logistical purposes," said Lisa Gaither, executive director of the Greater Pell City Chamber of Commerce. "Many of the same vendors and features that everyone has come to know and love will still be available."

Work is still underway on securing stage sponsors and scheduling musical

acts, but the Jonathan East Band, Jamison Taylor, Vintage 6 and Nashville Bound are among the performers that have already been scheduled.

There is no admission fee for the event. information, call 205-338-3377.

#### Riverside Poker Run: 10 a.m.-2 p.m. Saturday, June 20

The seventh annual event begins at Riverside Landing and benefits the Riverside Beautification Organization (RBO).

Registration is set for 3-7 p.m. Friday, June 19, at the landing. The cost is \$15 per poker hand. Cash prizes of \$300, \$200, and \$100 will be awarded for the best three hands.

Participants will receive a map showing the seven docks on which cards are available. An eighth "mystery" dock will be designated but not shown on the map, according to Teresa Hammond of the RBO.

"It will be clearly identified and easy to find, even though

you won't see it on the map," she said. "The way the game works is you follow the map to get the cards that make up your poker hand," she said. "At each dock, you draw one card, and at the end you pick your best five cards to turn in as your hand."

Each dock will have a different theme, such as Mardi Gras, and each will showcase a prize to be given away at the end of the event. Participants will receive poker chips before launching their boats, which they may leave at each dock to be eligible for the prize giveaways.

"And you don't have to have a boat to be a part of the Poker Run," Hammond said. "You can visit each of the docks from the Coosa Queen riverboat." Reservations for the riverboat ride cost \$15 each, in addition to the event registration fee, and can be made by calling 205-763-2319.

Food vendors will be available at the landing throughout the event, and Caribe Steel Drums will provide entertainment. For more information, call Hammond at

Summer Lights on Logan Martin Lake: 6 p.m.,

#### Saturday, June 20

This first-ever event kicks off at Woods Surfside Marina in Cropwell with live music and food vendors. The parade of decorated boats will light up the lake after a shotgun

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

start at 8 p.m., with Pell City Police Chief Greg Turley leading the procession in the department's marine patrol vehicle.

The parade will end at Lakeside Park, where spectators will be able to see all of the boats as they turn around to return to the marina. Admission and parking at the park are free. A \$10 minimum donation is requested of boaters taking part in the parade. Proceeds will benefit the Pell City Police Foundation. Registration is open through June 13 or until the field

reaches 100 boats.

Judges for the best decorated boat contest will be stationed on the Coosa Queen, from which the event will be broadcast live on 94.9 FM. First, second and third place winners will be named after the parade.

Lakeside residents are encouraged to



decorate their docks for the event and submit photos of them for the best decorated dock contest. "You don't have to be on a main boat route to participate," said event organizer Nancy Locklar. "It's really pretty when people all over the lake have their decorations up for a week or so at night. And, of course, we want this entire event – including boat and dock decorations – to be family friendly."

For Libby Perry, an ideal day on the lake is a fishing getaway. "My husband and I have done it before," she said. "It was like a date, and it was wonderful. An overcast day, out in the boat, just me and my husband – that's a perfect afternoon."

A self-described country girl, Perry's love of fishing and the outdoors complements her work as the 4-H agent assistant with the St. Clair County Extension Office. As she was feeding the ducks at Riverside Landing on a recent morning, she discussed her work, family and adventures on the lake.

**About 4-H:** Four-H is the youth development and education program of the Alabama Cooperative Extension System for students in grades K-12. "For almost 100 years, 4-H has helped youth in Alabama and across the nation develop into resourceful citizens and responsible leaders," Perry said. "It stands for head, heart, hands and health. It spans all interests, races and backgrounds, and it costs nothing to join."

**The best part of her job:** "The kids. They're fun, and they make me laugh. I know so many of them from being at their schools that it's almost like I'm a celebrity whenever I go anywhere. There are always kids coming up and talking to me."

**Summer camp:** "I did go to 4-H camp when I was in school, and it was my favorite camp. I'm going back with St. Clair County June 1-3 at the Alabama 4-H Center in Columbiana. The kids will be doing the typical camp activities – canoeing, archery, swimming and hiking – and there's something there this year called the giant swing. I'm not sure exactly what it is, but I can't wait to do it."

**Another upcoming 4-H program:** The Clover Classroom. "It's our ninth annual summer workshop series, and it will be held throughout the month of July. Anyone between ages 8-14 is eligible to participate, even if you're not a 4-H member or you don't live in St. Clair County." Workshops will deal with such topics as cooking, salsa making, fishing, photography,



sewing and wildlife. More information is available by calling 205-338-9416 or visiting www.aces.edu/counties/StClair/4-H.

Besides 4-H: Perry serves as secretary for the St. Clair County Farmers Federation's Women's Division, works as a representative for Mary Kay cosmetics and is a member of the Mt. Zion Free Will Baptist Church.

**Her family:** Perry and her husband John have two children. Their son Brandon is 17 and employed at Dairy Queen in Pell City, and their 12-year-old daughter Brooke plays youth league softball. Both are award-winning 4-Hers.

**Her extended family:** "I'm kin to a whole lot of people here. My parents are Ellis and Laura Diana Lawley. My grandmother had several kids, and her kids all had several kids, and a lot of them still live here in Pell City."

Out in the country: "My dad took me out with him all the time when I was little, so I'm a country girl from way back. I love the country, I love camping, I love riding around on the four-wheeler and I love the water. Being on the lake or out on the river calms me and makes me happy."

Her biggest catch: A five-pound catfish. "It was overcast when I caught it. It was the best day."

**Lakeside style:** "Usually I go in jeans, a t-shirt and tennis shoes. I've gone in flip-flops, but I do a better job of reeling in when I've got good tennis shoes on. And plenty of sunblock."

Jud Alverson didn't grow up on Logan Martin, but after he and his wife Lindsey bought their first lake home in 2002, he realized life elsewhere just wouldn't be the same.

"Once lake life gets in your blood, it's hard to leave," he said. "I took it for granted."

The Alversons resided in Pell City's Pine Harbor

community for five years before moving to a larger home away from the lake at a time when Jud, a mortgage loan representative, "thought it would be a good time to take advantage of the market. I regretted it, and we bought this lot when it came open. I missed the lake, and I missed Pine Harbor, and we were lucky enough to be able to do



something about it."

Their current home – across Logan Martin from Lakeside Landing and just south of Lakeside Park – was completed in 2012. "This house fits our family," Jud said. "I have no desire for a mulligan on this house. We love the views. Every room on the first level has a view of the water."

The 3,500-square-foot house sits on "three-fourths of an acre, maybe seven-eighths." It has four bedrooms and

three-and-one-half bathrooms, with a patio space that looks down on 225 feet of water frontage with a beach area, boat house and 135-foot boardwalk.

"We use all of it," Lindsey said. "We knew exactly what we wanted when we had it built. It's cozy all the time, and when the weather gets warm, this is where we want to be every weekend. Saturdays are for grilling out, going out on the boat and hanging out on the patio, and Sunday we do

Mackey Docks & Boathouses. The work, Jud said, was necessary because of a chemical problem related to the treatment of the structures' original lumber.

"We built the boat dock immediately after we bought the lot, before we even built the house. So people who, like us, built a pier around 2008, 2009 or 2010 could potentially have the same problem with their wood going bad. Between our dock and the boardwalk, we have an awful lot of wood down there on our shoreline."

The boardwalk with its accompanying beach area was constructed to fill a 10-foot-by-20-foot area in

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

"And I sit in the swing and hold the camera, waiting for them to catch the big one," Lindsey said.

"That rarely happens," Jud said wistfully, leaning on the kitchen bar and propping his face on his hand as he looked out at the water.

"It has a few times," Lindsey replied.

"At the end of the day, we just love living in Pine Harbor," Jud said. "I'm not saying it's better or more special than any other neighborhood, but we think it's a unique community because of the great people who live out here."



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

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


