



hen looking to relocate three decades ago, God led me to Pell City. And I just quit looking. I couldn't tell you exactly why, but it just felt right. A lot has changed since then, and while it might be difficult to reach a consensus on what makes Pell City the incredible community that it is, most will agree that there is nowhere else that we would rather live and raise a family. Whether it's our beautiful Logan Martin Lake or our historic downtown, the excitement of our athletic complex or our expanding retail and entertainment opportunities, the quality and dedication of our local educators or the caring warmth of our local churches, Pell City holds something special for everyone.

If you are lucky enough to live here, you probably already know what I mean. If you are here today as a visitor, I would like to welcome you to our wonderful community. I hope that you can spare a little extra time to grab a bite, visit our beautiful lake, and get a taste of what makes Pell City so special. If you're running short on time, just ask a couple of folks. I'm sure they'll be glad to tell you why calling Pell City home just feels right.





PELL CITY It's the whole package!

ell City is the largest city in St. Clair County, Alabama. It sits on Interstate 20 between Birmingham and Atlanta and on U.S. Highway 231, known as the short route to Florida. Nestled comfortably in the foothills of the Appalachians, it offers a breathtaking view of the surrounding mountains.

A 2023 report places Pell City's population at more than 13,000, with the number projected to exceed 14,000

by 2026. Its median household income (2023) is slightly more than \$73,043, with median property value exceeding \$238,000.

Pell City's top employment sectors include manufacturing, health care and social assistance, and retail trade. Outdoor recreation is strong, thanks to Logan Martin Lake and municipal parks offering picnic areas, fishing spots, and walking trails.

St. Clair County has been called

the fastest-growing county in the Birmingham between during the 2020s, and Pell City has significantly contributed to the county's growth.

"There's just a great energy in Pell City right now," says Jay Jenkins, a longtime member of the Pell City Council. "We're focused on smart growth that keeps our taxes low, provides opportunities for people to work close to home, and gives our families plenty of places to live and play. It's the whole package."

From a Missed Train to a Thriving Community

very town has a story, and Pell City's began with an unexpected delay.

In 1890, a missed train became the unlikely spark that shaped the city's history.

In 1890, 29-year-old insurance man Sumter Cogswell was on his way to Talladega when he missed his connection at the Pell City depot. Stranded for the night at the Cornett House, Cogswell glimpsed possibility in what others might have dismissed as simply a whistle-stop town.

Even before his arrival, Pell City had roots. Investors had secured a town charter in 1887, with New Yorker George H. Pell—namesake and owner of the Pell City Iron and Land Company—among them. The location was strategic, sitting at the crossroads of four rail lines: the East & West, the Seaboard Air Line, the Talladega & Coosa Valley, and the Georgia Pacific.

Cogswell's vision gave the young town momentum. He brokered the \$50,000 sale of its property to the Pell City Iron and Land Company, which began




shaping the community. By 1891, Pell City was officially incorporated.

But prosperity proved fragile. The Panic of 1893 shuttered the Pell City Iron and Land Company, leaving the town nearly deserted.

A decade later, Cogswell returned—and refused to let Pell City disappear. He and his wife Lydia purchased the struggling town for \$3,000. Determined to see it thrive, Cogswell donated 150 acres to the Pell City Manufacturing Company, which later became Avondale Mills. The textile company became the community's heartbeat, fueling its economy and drawing hard-working families who would define Pell City's identity for generations.

Growth continued after World War II. In 1956, the nearby towns of Eden and Oak Ridge merged with Pell City, increasing its population and reach. The construction of Logan Martin Dam in 1964 brought a new era of prosperity, creating Logan Martin Lake—a





recreation destination that continues to draw visitors and residents alike

Pell City has also weathered setbacks. Avondale Mills closed in 2006, and a fire consumed its historic building two years later. Even the smokestack's 2015 demolition made national news when it collapsed on contractor Timothy Phifer, who narrowly survived.

Through it all, Pell City has remained resilient. Its past is not only preserved in history books but also in living traditions. Each April, the Pell City Historic Walking Tours invite residents and visitors to step into the town's story. Led by local volunteers and supported by The Heart of Pell City and the Pell City Chamber of Commerce, the

free tours highlight the city's historic architecture and enduring spirit.

More than a century after Cogswell's fateful missed train, Pell City stands as a testament to vision, perseverance,

and community pride. The town continues to grow, honoring its past while embracing its future—proof that even the smallest moments can shape generations.

The Museum of Pell City

Preserving the Past, Inspiring the Future

or lifelong Pell City resident Julia
Skelton, history isn't just something
to read in a book—it's personal.
Standing before a framed map of the
old Avondale mill village inside the
newly opened Museum of Pell City, she
traced her finger along Mulberry Street.

"My family lived here," she said, smiling as she pointed out the area of her childhood home. "All of the streets were named after trees. And if you'll look at this old photograph," she continued, turning to a visitor, "I'll show you the house I grew up in."

Like many who call Pell City home, Skelton remembers how much life in the small town was influenced by Avondale Mills in decades past. "We lived a block from it," she said. "My daddy worked for the mill, my mother's family worked for the mill, and my grandfather was chief engineer for the mill in Sylacauga." She remembers the Avondale baseball teams, milkshakes at the Rexall soda fountain, and the exciting changes that came with the creation of Logan Martin Lake. She even remembers the tornado that roared through Pell City in the late 1960s, leaving \$5 million in damage in its wake.

Now, those memories—and thousands more like them—are preserved in the 4,000-square-foot museum that celebrates the people, places, and milestones of Pell City's 133-year history. Dedicated to the continuous preservation of the city's



historical legacy, the museum is housed on the second floor of the Pell City Municipal Complex.

Inside, visitors can step back in time through vintage photographs, artifacts, and scale models. The exhibits showcase a diverse collection: Cropwell School's graduating class of 1926, the Coosa River Ferry, the H.L. Davis Store in Easonville, the Mountain View Hotel in Cook Springs, the Coal City Lightweight Championship Boxing Bout, and the Wattsville Coal & Iron Co. There are snapshots of small-town life—fishing, skiing, and swimming on Logan Martin Lake—alongside exhibits

honoring local military veterans, artists, musicians, and athletes who helped shape the community's identity.

The museum also features "The Pell City Works" exhibit, which tells the story of the city's humble beginnings and growth, while the "Making Alabama" exhibit focuses on the history of the state and how communities grew out of the roots of working class families. There's even a recording studio space provided for documenting oral history.

"We all realize Pell City is such a great city and a great place to be," said Mayor Bill Pruitt. "We have a very long,



long history of people who put us in the position to be where we are today, and this museum honors that. While I knew it was going to be good, I did not realize the amount of work and attention to detail that has gone into it."

Carol Pappas, president of the museum's nonprofit board, attributed the credit to project designer Jeremy Gossett and "the effort of many who worked tirelessly to make sure that we carry out this mission. For generations, we have let so much history slip by without being preserved. This museum helps fill that void and will be a remembrance of people, places, and events that make this city such a special place. We are proud to be able to create this museum for our community."

The city itself also played a critical role, providing space, infrastructure, and support. "We couldn't ask for better partners than the mayor,



city manager, and council," Pappas added. "They provided us the space, infrastructure, and, best of all, moral support. Without their support, none of this would have been possible. Their vision is to be commended, and the legacy it creates will last for

generations."

For so many residents like Julia Skelton, that legacy is personal, a reminder that Pell City's story is still being written—one display, one family, and one memory at a time.

Economic Development

Location, transportation, and a collaborate spirit add up to continued growth in Pell City

s county seat of one of the fastest-growing communities in Alabama, Pell City is a hub for industry, manufacturing, and retail. St. Clair County has been among the top five fastest-growing counties in Alabama for five decades, having added more than 10,000 new residents during the past 10 years. Centrally located with two interstate systems, rail access, large tracts of developable land, and collaborative, forward-thinking leadership, Pell City and St. Clair County continue to attract investment.

The St. Clair County Economic Development Council (EDC), the county's official economic development organization, supports industrial, institutional, commercial, and leadership growth. The EDC partners with chambers of commerce and other organizations to help facilitate key programs, provide resources, and manage major industrial programs.

In 2024, Allied Mineral Products



LLC invested \$23.5 million to launch an expansion of its Pell City plant that produces a variety of heat containment refractory products used in industrial applications.

"Since its founding over 60 years ago, Allied Mineral Products has grown into a global company, serving multiple industries and registering sales to more than 100 countries," Alabama Commerce Secretary Ellen McNair said. "With a worldwide presence, the company could have selected another location for this investment, so this expansion in Pell City is truly a testament to the workforce there."

The EDC has also expanded its focus to tourism. To meet rising demand, Shivaay Hospitality LLC opened an 89-room TownePlace Suites in 2025.

"Pell City is always supportive of





new investment, but this new hotel will give more people a chance to see and visit all the great things we are accomplishing here. It will also help support the numerous manufacturers we have by providing another place for their executives and team members from out of state a comfortable stay while on business in town," said Mayor

Bill Pruitt.

Stan Batemon, chairman of the St. Clair County Commission, echoed his support. "As our county continues to market tourism events in and around our community, it is important to have a variety of well-known hotel brands to offer. I believe the word is getting out on what our community offers, and these

gentlemen have made a great decision in investing in St. Clair County."


In 2025, Pell City also broke ground on new Olive Garden and LongHorn Steakhouse restaurants. This \$6 million project is a partnership between Darden Restaurants, I-20 Development, the City of Pell City, and the St. Clair County Commission.





The community's appeal extends beyond business. Pell City boasts a vibrant downtown, a modern sports complex, the Center for Education and Performing Arts (CEPA), and Logan Martin Lake—a popular destination for recreation and events such as the Logan Martin LakeFest & Boat Show, Bulls on the Lake Rodeo, and CEPA's Live at Logan Martin concert series.

As industries grow and new businesses arrive, supporting companies follow—fueling a balanced economy built on strong public and private partnerships. With a thriving mix of industry, retail, recreation, and quality of life, Pell City and St. Clair County continue to redefine themselves while building on the strengths that have sustained their growth for decades.

Industry

A diverse mix of industries powers Pell City's growth

rom steel fabrication to automotive interiors, Pell City is home to a wide range of industries that fuel both the local economy and global markets. Whether products are manufactured in the city's industrial park or at facilities throughout the greater Pell City area,

products made here reach consumers around the world.

In St. Clair County, automotive supplier Eissmann Group Automotive ranks among the top manufacturing employers. In Pell City specifically, Garrison Steel—a leader in structural steel fabrication for clients across the Southeast—is also a major employer.

The following businesses are prime examples of the thriving industries that have chosen Pell City as home.

Advance Tank & Construction


Garrison Steel








Health Care

Tourism

The gateway to Logan Martin Lake, and a hub for Alabama tourism

ell City is known as the Gateway to Logan Martin Lake, so it's no surprise that the lake drives tourism for the city. Nature-based tourism is a significant part of St. Clair County's economy, and Logan Martin Lake continues to be both a refuge for residents and a destination for visitors.

With more than 600 miles of shoreline, the lake offers countless opportunities for recreation. Visitors enjoy boating, fishing, birding, and waterfront dining at the many restaurants along its shores. Families and groups often gather on Pirate Island, a popular boating destination that features a grill, a swimming area, palm trees, flowers, a hammock, and even a treasure chest. Visitors to the area can enjoy a day spent lakeside on a sandy beach or take a picnic lunch to Lakeside Park or Logan Martin Dam Park.

Each May, the city hosts Logan Martin Lakefest & Boat Show at Lakeside Park, drawing tens of thousands of attendees to the south's largest in-water boat show. The family-friendly event has something



for everyone with live music, lake lifestyle vendors, a variety of gourmet food trucks, and even a fireworks show. Lakeside Park also features walking trails, fishing piers, picnic areas, playgrounds, and wide-open fields for relaxation and recreation.

Founded in 1963, the Birmingham Sailing Club is located just 10 miles south of Pell City on nine acres of

land along Logan Martin Lake. The clubhouse, perched atop a knoll, offers a panoramic view of the lake and sailing area. A large deck overlooking the lake completes the setting, making it ideal for both recreation and community gatherings. The club offers a Junior Sailing Camp each summer and hosts weekly races and regattas.

Visitors can enjoy a day on the

water, then continue their experience in the heart of the city. Beyond the lake, Pell City offers a welcoming downtown business district filled with shops, dining, and local character. Each December, downtown Pell City comes alive with the annual Christmas parade, a holiday tradition organized by the chamber of commerce that draws thousands of spectators. Floats adorned with lights, marching bands, convertibles carrying local dignitaries, and Jolly Old Saint Nick himself fill the streets with music and cheer.

The St. Clair County Fair is a recent addition to the county's lineup of events. The fair showcases a variety of attractions, including a livestock show for local showmen, a vendor market highlighting area farmers and small businesses, carnival rides, a car show, and much more. The annual event is well on its way to becoming a community tradition—one that celebrates agriculture, supports local enterprise, and provides family-friendly fun for all ages.

The Pell City Sports Complex adds another dimension to tourism, hosting athletic events and annual highlights such as the Bulls on the Lake Rodeo in July.



Nearby, the region's reputation for motorsports adds to its draw. The Talladega Superspeedway is a legendary venue for NASCAR fans, while Barber Motorsports Park in Leeds offers both a world-class track and the Barber Vintage Motorsports Museum, home to one of the world's largest motorcycle collections.

Tourism is a growing sector in St. Clair County, supported by the St. Clair County Economic Development Council (EDC)'s "Visit St. Clair" initiative.

"The people who attend are staying in our hotels and eating at our restaurants, and it is an opportunity to be hospitable and attract people and businesses to our region," said Blair Goodgame, Tourism Coordinator for the EDC.

Goodgame, a lifelong St. Clair County resident, sees tourism as vital to both the economy and the community. "One of my favorite things about St. Clair County is that you always get more than you expect here. There is a welcoming spirit, and people have a deep passion for the outdoors and what it means to be friendly, good neighbors," she said.

As Tourism Coordinator, Goodgame dedicates her time to showcasing the many attractions of St. Clair County to visitors, businesses, and prospective industries.

"Tourism," she explains, "goes handin-hand with economic development." Calling it a "clean" industry, Goodgame emphasizes that it reflects the vitality of a community something companies look for when deciding where to invest.

When asked about the county's assets, Goodgame quickly points to its



diverse offerings. At the top of the list are the resort-style settings of Neely Henry Lake in the north and Logan Martin Lake in the south. From there, she highlights destinations like Horse Pens 40 near Steele, the Mustang Museum of America in Odenville, and the Forever Wild preserve in Springville. Outdoor enthusiasts have access to outfitters, kayaking, bouldering, off-road trails, extreme sports parks, and competitive events. The area is also home to motorcycle racing, aerobatic flight instruction, summer camps, and national tournaments.

The arts are equally strong in St. Clair County. Goodgame describes a thriving creative community that spans visual arts, music, and theater, with galleries, concerts, songwriter festivals, stage productions, and learning opportunities through local music and dance schools.

For those planning special occasions, the county also boasts an array of wedding chapels and venues










well-suited for reunions, receptions, conferences, and conventions.

Visual and Performing Arts

Celebrating Pell City's creative spirit, from theater lights to gallery walls

rom the Center for Education and Performing Arts (CEPA) to the Pell City Players to the artists of Gallery of Eden, local creatives have built a thriving community with venues to showcase their work.

These three cornerstones of Pell City's cultural scene emerged around the same time. The Pell City Players, a nonprofit community theater, was formed in 2006 and debuted with Cat on a Hot Tin Roof in March 2007. That same year, construction was completed on CEPA, which opened with its first performance, and Artscape welcomed visitors to its downtown gallery.

Together, these groups provide meaningful outlets for creative expression across the community and beyond.

Ash Arrington, executive director of CEPA, has been involved since the creation of the Spotlight Drama Education and Outreach Program and founded the first Spotlight Club at Moody High School in 2017.

"CEPA and the Spotlight Program are dear to me," Arrington said. "Both have provided me access to the arts that wouldn't have been possible otherwise. I am incredibly grateful for that and want to share what has been given to me with as many people as possible."

Spotlight is a countywide program designed to make theater accessible for all ages. It now supports eight drama clubs across St. Clair County, with more than 400 members producing 10–12 live productions



each year at CEPA.

CEPA has also welcomed a variety of performers to its stage, including The WingNuts, a group of aviation enthusiasts who play music from the 1960s–80s, and the Black Jacket Symphony, which has recreated over 40 classic rock albums live, note for note, for audiences across the U.S.

For nearly two decades, the Pell City Players have showcased local talent while also giving back through scholarships for Pell City High School seniors active in theater.

"Pell City is a growing community. People are coming into town who want to go to the theatre," said founder Kathy McCoy. "The Pell City Players work as a team to present a production where you'll definitely be taken on an adventure. We carry the

name, Pell City Players, to represent our town in the best fashion."

McCoy added that the group's scholarship program is a source of pride. "We don't want these students to miss out on achieving their goals. The Pell City Players are so proud to provide this opportunity," she said.

Located on Cogswell Avenue in the historic heart of downtown Pell City, the Gallery of Eden enriches the community by supporting local artists and fostering arts education. Where "we are serious about art" and "dedicated to presenting the best of the best of local and regional artists," the gallery showcases a diverse collection of contemporary artwork, offers classes in a range of mediums, and serves as an exhibition space.

The Gallery of Eden stands out as a



hub for art enthusiasts and casual visitors alike. With its thoughtfully curated exhibitions and rotating displays, it offers a dynamic space where creativity thrives.

Collectively, CEPA, the Pell City Players, and the Gallery of Eden highlight the vitality of Pell City's creative spirit. Together, they ensure that residents and visitors alike experience the best in local visual and performing arts—making creativity a cornerstone of community life.

ike a welcoming home, a house of worship offers comfort in both the good and hard times. It fosters family togetherness, encourages spiritual growth, and provides a place of peace and refuge from life's storms.

With more than 30 churches in the Pell City area—ranging from Baptist to Catholic, Episcopalian to Methodist, Pentecostal to Seventh-Day Adventist, and nondenominational congregations—each plays a role in serving the spiritual life of the community.

In 2014, it relocated to Pell City's Lakeside Park and a year later partnered with the city to build its current amphitheater overlooking the lake.

Services are held on Sunday mornings at 8:30 a.m. from May through September in a casual, "come as you are" setting. Each 30-minute service features a guest speaker and special music from local churches. In addition to worship, Chapel in the Pines gives



back by awarding seasonal grants to local nonprofit organizations through weekly offerings.

congregation with extensive ministries, a small and close-knit church family, traditional worship, or more contemporary styles, Pell City offers a


