WEEKLY BRIDGE OUIZ ANSWERS

Q 1 - Neither vulnerable, as South, vou hold:

♠ J 5 ♥ O 5 ♦ A J 9 5 **♣** A 9 6 4 2

Right-hand opponent opens one diamond. What call would vou make?

A - A two-club overcall would not be the worst bid ever made, but it would still be a bad bid. A two-level overcall in a minor should show a six-card suit or a good hand with a decent five-card suit. This hand doesn't measure up. Pass.

O 2 - East-West vulnerable, as South, you hold:

♦ A.J.8 6 5 ♥ Void ♦ K O 7 4 2 **♣** O.J.4

Partner opens one spade and righthand opponent jumps to three hearts. What call would you make?

A - Bid four hearts, showing a hand too good to bid four spades. The bid does not show a void. Should partner venture a five-level cue bid, you can show your heart control by bidding five hearts.

Q 3 - Both vulnerable, as South, you hold:

♠ A 10 ♥ K 9 ♦ 7 2 **♣** A K Q J 10 5 3

Right-hand opponent opens one spade. What call would you make?

A - The hand is too good for a twoclub overcall. You can't be faulted if you double and then bid clubs, but we suspect that the winning bid is three no trump.

O 4 - North-South vulnerable, as South, you hold:

♠ A K O J 9 ♥ K 7 3 ♦ A 7 3 ♣ A 10

As dealer, what call would you make?

A - Should your range for a two no trump opening be 20-21, as is common today, this hand is too good for that bid. This hand is easily worth 22 points. Open two clubs and rebid two no trump.

Q 5 - East-West vulnerable, as South, vou hold:

♦42 ♥ AJ4 ♦ AJ753 **♣** KQ8

EAST SOUTH WEST NORTH Dbl 1. 300 Pass What call would you make?

A - The most likely game for your side is three no trump. You can't make that bid with no stopper, but bid three spades and see if your partner can.

Q 6 - Both vulnerable, as South, you hold:


♠86 ♥ K 10 9 8 6 ♦ K 9 7 4 **♣** 5 2

NORTH EAST SOUTH WEST 102 1NT What call would you make?

A - A two-heart bid would likely see the opponents compete in a black suit and you'd have to bid three hearts. Bid three hearts now. You might shut them out.


