

CALENDAR KEY

Fishing Condition: This is the overall rating for the whole day, based upon our formula:

Best Good Fair Poor

Best Time: This column lists the best time of the day when, according to our formula, fish will be blting: MORNING; EVENING.

After you've hooked your catch, landing it isn't difficult, but it's best to employ caution – for the benefit of you and the fish. Following are some helpful tips.

1. As the fish gets closer to the boat, drop your entire rod and reel to your waist.

2. If the fish goes under the boat, get your rod tip in the water and follow it.

3. When the fish rolls over on its side, you'll know it's ready to be landed. Even if you can't see it, you'll be able to feel it.

4. For smaller fish, lift them from the water by hand, cradling your catch around its middle to remove the hook.

5. For larger fish or those with sharp teeth, it's best to use a net. Place it in the water and lead the fish into it head first.

6. Don't stab the net at the fish. If you don't get it the first time, re-aim and try again.

7. Get it out of the water and take the hook out as quickly as possible so you can either release it promptly or store it in a live well.

8. Rubber nets are preferred for catch and release fishing, plus they minimize touching the fish.

ebruary is the month of love, but acts of love occur year-round through the humanitarian efforts of charitable organizations. Whether it comes in the form of a hot meal or a new car seat for a new baby, nonprofits and their compassionate volunteers love to make a difference in the lives of those who seek their services.

The lakeside area is home to many philanthropic

agencies aimed specifically at helping people in need, and representatives of those nonprofits say they too have a need – for more volunteers. Following is information about four such organizations and how you can get involved.

The Red Door Kitchen

The Red Door Kitchen in Talladega provides a nutritious noontime meal to anyone in the Talladega community

who cannot prepare or obtain a meal due to a financial setback, poor health or lack of resources. More than 36,000 meals with meat, vegetables, fruit, dessert and beverages are served each year, either in its recently upgraded facility or by volunteers who deliver meals to people who are homebound. Many of those served are referred by First Family Services in Talladega.

The Red Door Kitchen receives funding from individuals and organizations that hold food drives or make financial donations.

"The community has been very good to us," said Billy Sparkman, president of the board of directors. "Churches and various civic groups will make donations throughout the year, some foundations have adopted us and provide financial support, and the city of Talladega helps to fund us because we provide a service to the city. We are a United Way funded program in part, so donations through United Way can be designated for The Red Door Kitchen, but our biggest donations come from Afternoon of Praise at the Ritz Theater."

The proceeds from last year's Afternoon of Praise concert, in addition to grant money, allowed The Red Door Kitchen to make some upgrades to its building. A walk-in freezer, double convection ovens, metal shelving and other improvements have already been made.

But volunteers are needed.

"One of our biggest needs right now is volunteers to deliver meals," Sparkman said. "A person can deliver

one day a week if they want to, or an organization can take a route and divide it up. It's really fun to deliver meals. We may be the only person that person sees that day, so drivers develop a bond with the people they serve. It's a great way to stay active after retirement."

He added that dedicated volunteers are hard to replace when they age out. "It would really be nice if some younger people in the community stepped up to take their place." The Red Door Kitchen is at 500 South St. W. For more information, call 256-362-3663 or visit the Facebook page.

Samaritan House

Samaritan House serves people in the Talladega and Alpine communities who



qualify for their services. According to board president Charles Montgomery, Samaritan House can assist with food, clothing, utility bills, prescription medication and co-pays for doctor visits if the applicant's income falls below a certain amount. "We have our own guidelines. Anyone who needs help needs can come in and see if they qualify," he said.

Each year before Christmas, Samaritan House raises funds to buy toys for children whose families are selected by First Family Services in Talladega. Last year, it raised almost \$3,000 to buy gifts for 35 children.

In the summer and fall, it distributes fresh produce to lowincome housing residents. "We get produce from Farmers Market at Pepper Place in Birmingham and bring it back to Curry Court or Knoxville Homes and give it out," Montgomery said.

Samaritan House receives funding from the city of Talladega, the United Way and from individuals, churches and other organizations. Food drives are held regularly by civic groups and

schools.

"Food drives are wonderful, and they help us tremendously, but that can of beans that cost a dollar at the grocery store, we can get it for a quarter at the Community Food Bank in Birmingham. So financial donations do go further," Montgomery said. "We can also use the money for our other services, like assistance with utilities."

Samaritan House also needs more volunteers. "If someone could volunteer one day a month, that would be wonderful. They can do what they like to do. If it's filling grocery orders, they can do that. If it's folding clothes, they can do that. They can learn the routine and meet the other volunteers. We can find a day for them to work."

Samaritan House is open from 9-11:45 a.m. Mondays through Thursdays. For more information, call 256-362-7698, or visit the offices at 1301 Allison Mill Road in Talladega. **Good Works Charitable Foundation**

Good Works Charitable Foundation is a soup kitchen and mobile food pantry. It holds a monthly event called The Community Table every third Monday at the 19th Street Recreation Hall in Pell City. "Beginning at 6p.m., we give away a hot meal and free groceries to anyone who shows up. We serve about 600 people a month," said co-founder Carrie Leland. The only requirements are that recipients must live in St. Clair County and be in need of food.

"We see people who come once or twice, and then they don't need us anymore," co-found Jean Speer said. "We see people who come every month, because they need us every month, and we see people who were once recipients become volunteers and donors."

The organization relies on

sponsorships from local businesses, corporations and churches to provide money for food. "We need sponsors," Speer said. "It costs about \$1,000 a month to buy the groceries." They also need volunteers to prepare and serve the monthly meal.

"We are an all-volunteer organization,"

Leland said. "We don't have a storefront, so we don't have that overhead. One hundred percent of what we take in goes back out."

Ann's New Life Center

Ann's New Life Center in Cropwell serves women in the Pell City area who are faced with an unplanned pregnancy, a stressful pregnancy or anyone with a young child who is having parenting issues.

"We serve the whole family," said director Dani Christophersen. "We want fathers to come, grandparents and anyone who is involved with the baby."

Many of the center's patients are high school

and college-aged and are faced with an unplanned pregnancy. "They can come here to get their pregnancy confirmed, and we can talk to them about what to expect with their pregnancy. We can help them set goals for the future and teach them how to take care of their baby," Christophersen said.

The center offers free pregnancy tests and free ultrasound scans to confirm pregnancies. A trained nurse performs ultrasounds and runs the clinic aspect of the organization. "One of our goals from the very beginning of the ministry was to become a medical clinic. Over the last year, we have done that," she said, adding that the clinic operates under federal regulatory standards.

Free parenting classes are available, and patients earn "baby bucks" for attending the classes. They

can spend the "baby bucks" at the clinic's boutique to purchase necessary items like diapers, clothes, cribs or car seats. Classes focus on parenting skills and issues like potty training and proper discipline for young children.

"Since becoming a medical clinic, our expenses have increased significantly, and that is going to be one of the biggest challenges this coming year," Christophersen said. "Financial donations are needed. Donations for the boutique are always welcomed. Car seats and cribs have to be new, and diapers and baby wipes are always needed. But one of the biggest things we need right now are volunteers. We need people to donate their time."

Volunteers receive training and are placed in positions according to their abilities and what they like to do. "We have people who clean and organize, some just answer the phone, and some work directly with the patients."

The clinic is in Lake Plaza at 3440 Martin St. S., and walk-ins are welcome. It is open from 9 a.m.-4 p.m. Tuesdays and Thursdays. For more information, call 205-338-4580 or visit the website www.annsnewlifecenter.com.

Logan Martin offers superb setting for competitive sailors

he Birmingham Sailing Club is the premier place for sailing on Logan Martin, and its nautical

themed clubhouse has a history that actually predates the lake

When the clubhouse was constructed in 1963, there was no water in sight. The first boats weren't launched until 1964, after Logan Martin Dam created the lake that covered the land with water.

Located 10 miles south of Pell City, the clubhouse sits on 9 acres of mostly waterfront property on the west side of the reservoir, some two

miles above Logan Martin Dam. At this site, the lake is approximately one mile wide and offers excellent sailing conditions.

"This club was founded, and is still very focused, on one design sailing," said 2017 Commodore Dave Hackney. "One design sailing essentially means that there are fleets of different types of boats, there are five boats to a fleet, and right now there are three fleets -- the Flying Scots, the Thistles, and the J-22s."

A fenced parking area is filled with such various

kinds of sailboats on trailers, and a limited number of slips are available for members who prefer leaving their boats in the water.

The main area of the clubhouse is actually the original structure. The left and right wings of the building were added sometime in the 1970s. Large wall-towall windows spanning the length of the back of the clubhouse offer a panoramic view of the lake and sailing area, which includes paved launching ramps and both fixed and floating docks. White wicker settees, matching chairs, and wooden rocking chairs provide plenty of seating. "The rocking chairs are awarded to winners of races," said Toni Hackney, who is married to Dave, and enjoys sailing with him as part of his crew. "Their names and the name of the race they won are engraved on a small, gold colored plaque that is affixed to the back of

the chair."

The interior of the clubhouse is decorated with small, colorful, triangular flags called burgees. Each burgee bears the insignia of every sailing club whose members have visited BSC. "We present our burgee to clubs that we visit as well," Dave said.

Clubhouse facilities include men's and women's dressing rooms. Both are equipped with private toilets, cinderblock showers with tiled floors, vanities with mirrors and changing areas. These areas can be accessed from the inside of the clubhouse or by an outside door. These facilities were added in the early 1990s.

A full kitchen is located in the left wing. Members and their families enjoy a meal, either catered or prepared on site, after each regatta. "We have a great group of people here," Dave said, adding that the club currently has 143 members.

There is plenty of room for storage in the rear of the clubhouse. This storage area also serves as office space, which is where the club's regattas are scored and recorded. The clubhouse is not air-conditioned. It is naturally cooled by winds off the lake and by six ceiling fans. The original fireplace provides heating for chilly evenings.

Outside, on the grounds to the left of the clubhouse, there is ample space for tent camping both on grass and in the preserved wooded acres. A pavilion serves as a grilling and dining area for campers.

In addition to sailing, the Club provides a lake swimming area with a dock, a fire pit and a playground for young children. "The playground was built by one of our members," Dave said.

The sailing program consists of Sunday afternoon races throughout the year, beginning the first week in February. Monthly one-day regattas are held during the spring and summer, as are invitational regattas, which attract entries from other clubs throughout the Southeast. The club also has a junior sailing program and an adult Learn to Sail program.

'It gets you a little closer to God'

Cropwell angler appreciates quiet times on the lake

> or George Crain, a good day fishing is any day he gets to go.

"Fishing gets you a little closer to God, to be honest," the Cropwell resident said. "It makes you feel a bit more in touch with the moment at hand." Crain believes that's important in the fast-paced workaday world of American society.

He believes it's so important that he obligates himself to participate in a certain number of fishing tournaments each year to make sure he gets in enough therapeutic time on the water.

"I fish for fun first, and if I win

it."

pay for some expenses along the way, well, that's great," he said. "If you start thinking about fishing for a paycheck, you'd better make sure you really do love it. When you're by yourself 12 hours a day in Wisconsin in the winter practicing for a trail tournament, you're not going to last long if you don't love

enough to

Crain developed his love of fishing as a child, on fishing trips with his father and grandfather.

"I remember sitting between them in the boat when I was probably 7 or 8. My dad liked to fly fish, and in 1952 he designed his own boat. In the 1950s, boats weren't of a size for two people to fly fish in one, and Dad came up with a swivel seat system that overcame that problem."

Other anglers would ask where he got the boat.

"My dad and grandfather would tell them, 'We made it.' Then they'd ask, 'Would you be interested in making us one?' And my dad and grandfather would say, 'No,'" Crain recalled with a chuckle.

When his father relocated to Florida in the mid-1970s, he sent his son a sevenpage letter containing the instructions for building the boat. More than 40 years later, Crain still has the boat he built following his father's directions.

Now 64 and retired after 28 years with the Birmingham Fire Department, where he worked as part of the high-angle rescue team, Crain says he feels 35 and views age as a matter of being "as old as you feel. Most of my fishing buddies are younger than I am, so that helps."

A B.A.S.S. and FLW trail tournament participant and a Bassmaster Classic qualifier, Crain appreciates his wife for supporting his angling endeavors. "She's always my biggest fan, and she's probably more competitive for me when I'm in a tournament than I actually am. That's important, because if your family isn't behind you, competitive fishing is probably not something you need to be doing."

The unpredictability of fishing is part of the sport's appeal for Crain.

"Everybody likes catching fish on top water and seeing the fish react to the bait, but I get excited about dropping down below so you don't know what you've hooked. You can get a bite caught up in some foliage and think you've caught a 30-pounder, then pull it up to find out it's just a two-pound fish. But it's still exciting."

This time of year, fishing deeper water is an effective strategy,

according to Crain.

"When the water is cold, the fish drop down 10, 12, 15 feet, and you can usually catch a lot of fish in winter because they bunch up more than they do in warm weather. They'll be around rocky areas where the sun heats up the rocks. They're looking for every bit of warmth they can get. As warm as it's been this year, though, if you're fishing the Coosa River chain, you can find them up to 3 and 4 feet of water during the day to eat, and they'll ease back down as it gets darker."

Even after a lifetime spent fishing, Crain said he's still adding to his knowledge of the sport.

"Bass fishing is very simple, but it becomes more and more complex as you learn the ins and outs of it. That's what makes it so interesting. You'll never know all about it, but it sure is fun." \mathbf{k}

ive Alli Brascho the choice, and she'll take the lake over the beach any day. Even in February.

"There is simply nothing like a winter on the lake," she said. "Nothing. The water is down, it's morning, there's fog skirting over the lake, the orange, purple and red sun is rising – it might just be my favorite time to be on the lake. At least it was when the house was full and lived in year-round. Now, it's more of our summer home."

Brascho, a self-described "lake girl," is a college senior studying voice performance at Samford University, but she still spends time at the lake as often as she can and treasures memories of growing up on Logan Martin, some of which she shared on a recent afternoon back by the water.

Winter lakeside memories: "I spent a lot of time outside with my neighbor Jackson



Williamson, who was my best friend. We are pretty close in age, so we grew up together. We loved to see if the lake had any ice and walk along the dried shore. One year we tried to plant a pine tree in the dead of winter with a pine cone. It didn't work, but I was hopeful.

"I remember my dad driving us to school in the mornings, frost and fog covering the field in our neighborhood, my Aunt Jill coming over in the evenings to make sweets with us and visit my mom, my Gran and I waking up in the mornings to watch the sunrise on the back porch with coffee for her and warm milk for me. There was so much peace. It was a cold, eerily beautiful time made warm by family, a fire and plenty of blankets."

Warmer memories: "My mom smiling as we swam is something I always associate with the lake. Katie, our golden retriever, chasing our boat along the shoreline as Dad pulled us on the inner tube. We would compete with my siblings as teams. The team that fell off the most lost, so Jackson and I would do our best to keep each other on the tube. But it was fun to watch him fall off, even if we lost."

Her favorite lakeside activities: "When I was little, it was tubing and running around in my bathing suit all day. My mom made sure we spent plenty of time outside playing. She says she'd just strap a life vest on us, let us loose and watch us run. Now that I'm older, I prefer to watch the other kids be pulled behind the boat. My dad is a champion water skier, and he's constantly teaching someone how to ski or surf. It's always a joy to watch their faces light up when they get it right. I still enjoy skiing occasionally, but I'm nowhere near as good as my father."

Her ideal day on the lake: "My family is instrumental in the perfect lake day. I love when my aunts are over. It doesn't feel right if they aren't there. 'Brascho burgers' are a must, made by my dad and uncles. The most important thing is the feeling I get when everything lines up just right. It can't be forced, planned or manufactured. It just happens. I'm light, content, at peace...it's a timeless emotion."

If she were stranded on the hypothetical desert island with one book, one piece of music and one meal: "For the book, I'm gonna go with the Bible. I have about a million verses I've been trying to memorize since I was 12...maybe I'd finally do it. For music, I could live with listening to Frank Sinatra or Bing Crosby for the rest of my life. I also love Ed Sheeran, but I'm equally infatuated with Stravinsky and my friend Maggie Boswell's music. I think I'd have to take a mix tape. Or a *Hamilton* CD. For food, it would be steamed green beans, mashed potatoes, balsamic drizzled asparagus and my mom's tomato and feta chicken."

"I love helping people get into a home that is just right for them," she said. "To




purchase a home is a huge thing, and it's a great accomplishment for a lot of people. To see them get what they want and be satisfied is very rewarding for me."
