

Our take: Reclassification brought a new day for Anniston, and the challenge is to win in Class 5A despite having the third-smallest enrollment in that classification. Oh, and do it with only seven returning starters from a team that went 5-5, tied for fourth in its 4A region and missed the playoffs a vear ago. But Anniston didn't move up alone. Alexandria and Lincoln made the same jump and again will be in Anniston's region. Too, Anniston has a 68-man roster, including a Quint Dobbins returning and improved at quarterback. The Bulldogs also have a dynamic player in receiver/cornerback Tae Miller, who will see time as a "wildcat" quarterback, and Hakeem Ross has come on board as a dangerous receiver. So, don't count Anniston out. See where the Bulldogs stand by their Sept. 26 open date. This could be a sleeper team, in terms of making the playoffs.

However, the Falcons return one of the top up-and-coming recruits in Alabama in Justin Foster. He will be asked to become a do-everything player for the Falcons this season. Felder has said the senior could line up at different positions on either side of the ball this season. During the Falcons' spring game against Wadley, freshman Mitchell Baker, also a soccer player, launched numerous field goals with plenty of leg. If this team is locked in a tight battle late in a game, look for Baker to be cool, collected and ready to kick clutch field goals. The Falcons

return 13 of 24 players from last year's team that fell in the first round. That's rare for a 1A program, so experience will be on Donoho's side this year.

OUR TAKE: After losing a large senior class from last season, head coach Clint Smith may be happy with whatever results he can get this season. Jacksonville returns 13 seniors, and Smith will look for those players to bring leadership to his young team, hoping this group can become the squad he believes they have the potential to become. Do-everything player Sid Thurmond is back for his senior season, and Smith has hinted at lining him up at quarterback during certain situations. He's a threat to make plays from anywhere on the field. Smith will have to replace two key starters off last year's team — quarterback (Jackson Bell) and featured running back (Dominique Thomas). Many teammates are saying sophomore Tae Ackles is the next top running back for the Golden Eagles. He's a big guy for his age and has shifty feet to accompany his speed. Quin Veasley is set to take over for Bell under center, and he has a powerful arm. Jacksonville is in a top-heavy region, so the Golden Eagles will have a tough fight in getting back to the playoffs.

However, just three of those 28-or-more games were wins for the Thunder. Four more wins and four fewer losses would have reversed last year's record from 3-7 to 7-3. Had the Thunder held Donoho, Spring Garden and Gaylesville to 31 points, they would have ended the regular season 5-3 in region play and advanced to the playoffs. The offense should be potent again. All-state quarterback Daylon Brackett returns for his senior season. Senior Kris Armprester and freshman Walker Messer return as wide receivers. To retool his running attack, coach Tommy Miller has shifted Andre Garner, a starter at slot receiver last year, to tailback. Also, 2013 starting tackle Thomas Orms will move to fullback. If the ground attack jells, it should keep opposing defenses from loading up stop Brackett. Line play will tell the tale for the Thunder, on both sides of the ball.

Thursday, August 21, 2014 **Page 14** **OUR TAKE:** Oxford lost a generational player in running back Roc Thomas, but the Yellow Jackets also lost 10 starters on defense, including nose tackle Kenyan Richey, who didn't get Thomas-like attention but made the center of Oxford's defense a place opponents didn't want go to. Still, Oxford coach Ryan Herring sees the makings of a team that could be better overall than the team that went 9-3 with Thomas et al a year ago. Third-year starting quarterback Ty Webber will go from the pistol formation to the shotgun, run more read options and pass a little more. Wide receiver Tre Gamble will be counted on to be that dynamic playmaker. If converted safety Thomas Rudolph can give Oxford and effective threat at running back, and wide receiver Jacob Cook can keep double coverage off Gamble, then the Yellow Jackets will have an effective offense. While the defense will have new starters at 10 spots, Herring sees more speed this year. Oxford had to get it done without Roc Thomas at times last year and has the makings to prove that life after him will be just fine.


