

RED: THE (UN)OFFICIAL COLOR OF JANUARY FISHING

The month of January can be great or it can be really difficult for bass fishing. As Old Man Winter is in full swing, bass tend to get really lethargic and less active. Their diet changes significantly in winter. Bass will tend to be sluggish and feed more on crayfish, versus shad and fast swimming

baitfish. January is the perfect time to slow down and target bass with redcolored crankbaits, rattletraps, and bladed jigs.

I love to target rock structures in January. Key targets to look for include any kind of rock structures. Rock, sea walls, and riprap will hold heat and maintain heat longer than any other structures. The ends of boat ramps are

great concrete structures this time of year also. Bass will bite flat-sided red crankbaits in the middepth range, red shad raps, and red rattle traps. Fish all of these baits slowly, crawling them through the rocks.

When fishing these red-styled crankbaits, try to slow your retrieve and feel the rock structures with the bait. Typically, the bass will be laying on these rocks in 2-8 feet of water soaking up the much-needed heat. I focus on creek drains, creek channel swings, and offshore creek humps. Anywhere there is rock present in creeks could yield a large pre-spawning bass.

Tackle needed will be small red crankbaits. The Berkley Frittside Crankbait in red is a great option. Lipless red crankbaits in ½-ounce size work great

> as well. Red shad raps in Numbers 4, 5, and 6 always perform. Pair these baits on light line, 10-pound test fluorocarbon and a parabolic bending rod. Typically moderate/medium action works best. I like to use a slower gear ratio reel, to slow down my speed of the bait.

The good thing about fishing in the winter is that you could potentially catch your largest bass ever, based on weight size. Bass in winter will often be

the healthiest and heaviest versus any other time of the year. Get out and catch your personal best this month!

It was an honor to take part in this year's festivities.









Truly was the pinnacle of my career'

LAKESIDE AREA ARTIST MAKES SPECIAL PRESENTATION TO CRIMSON TIDE COACH

Not many Alabama fans can say they have met Coach Saban.

Even fewer can say they have met his wife Terry. Or been a special guest for the Tide's weekly "Hey Coach" broadcast from Baumhower's Victory Grille in Tuscaloosa.

Renowned artist and Pell City native David

Foote, 60, did just that and more this fall when he was given the opportunity to present two special commissions of his signature detailed bird carvings to Alabama Head Coach Nick Saban and his wife Terry.

"It was November 3, the Thursday before

the LSU game," he recalls. "I brought my niece and nephew-in-law, who is a huge Alabama fan and knows the Tuscaloosa area well."

During 40-plus years of creating art, Foote has produced thousands of pieces and is now known all across the nation. "I've been extremely lucky for someone who is from a small town to be able to meet so many amazing people. I've lost count honestly at how many birds I've worked on over the years."

Although Foote said he has been blessed and humbled that his art has opened many doors, nothing has compared to presenting his work to the Sabans.

"It truly was the pinnacle of my career," Foote said. "Being from the state of Alabama" and a big Alabama fan witnessing Saban rise to

> his greatness made it extra special."

Foote presented a yellowhammer carving, titled "Rammer Jammer." to the beloved football coach and a cardinal to Mrs. Terry.

"I spent about 450 hours on the

yellowhammer and about 250 on the cardinal. I used Tupelo wood, which is popular

among carvers because it is good for detailing. The tree itself is in the gum family and is often found in swampy areas."

Foote said he decided to carve the state. bird for coach Saban due in part to the "Rammer Jammer" cheer. "It's also a very







beautiful bird despite it not having much yellow on it. Many people know it's the state bird but don't know what it looks like. It only has yellow on the underside of its wings. Its real name is the northern flicker. It was given its nickname, the yellowhammer, back during the Civil War."

Foote said that meeting the Sabans was something he will cherish forever. "I sat right across from Mrs. Terry the whole time. She asked me to present Coach with his bird during a commercial break. She didn't know I had one for her too. That was a surprise."

When asked what the Sabans thought of their special carvings, Foote said they loved them and gave them a thorough inspection with amazement.

"Coach Saban seemed afraid at first to touch it and asked me if it was real wood because it looks so lifelike. He really complimented the details. Mrs. Terry loved the cardinal so much she said she wanted it displayed on a mantel inside their home."

The artist added that Saban praising the bird's lifelike details was the perfect compliment. "Since 2015 I've really focused on working on hyper-realism carvings."

Foote was diagnosed with stage three throat

cancer that year, and it was the ultimate health battle. "My body responded in shock to the treatments, causing me to lose white and red blood cells. I spent 31 days on full life support," he said. "My family thought I was going to die. It took me months to get back my strength, but by the grace of God I got better, and as soon I was able to walk down to my shop I started carving again. It was then that I made a promise to myself to do more of the style I wanted to do."

During an later commercial break of "Hey Coach," Foote overheard Mrs. Terry talking to one of her

assistants who was concerned about how to get the birds safely to their destination.

"I told her that I would take the birds to anywhere they needed to go, since I traveled in a special van and had the proper boxes to transport them safely," he said. "I was completely shocked when she said she wanted them to go to her house. When I told my nephew, his eyes got as big as a kid in a candy store. Seeing his reaction also made my night."

Foote said that the entire experience is something that he and the rest of his family will never forget.

"Mrs. Terry has since reached out thanking me

again and said they plan to put the yellowhammer on display at the future Nick Saban Center in Tuscaloosa."

Foote grew up on Logan Martin Lake during the 1960s.

"It hardly had any houses surrounding it back then," he said. "There was more wildlife, and it's where I developed my love for shore birds and aquatic life. Although I don't live on the lake any more, it will always be near and dear to me."

Foote said his parents were always encouraging

and also played a huge role in his love of art and carving. "My mother loved art and was an antique dealer. She noticed my love of art around the time I was in preschool. My dad built furniture and was also good with wood and making furniture. He was a true craftsman. I owe a lot to them and what they instilled in me."

It's always a Sunny day at PELL CITY HIGH SCHOOL

Campus Goldendoodle offers support to students, making a difference in their lives

Mary Dollar pushes the office door open. Within seconds, a bundle of blonde curls resembling a four-legged teddy bear rushes to greet her. Sunny the Goldendoodle refuses to contain her affectionate excitement. She jumps, standing on her back legs, resting her paws on Mary as though she is reaching out for a hug. Mary is Sunny's favorite person.

Canines are a rare sight on school campuses, but Sunny is a familiar and accepted member of

the Pell City High School community. She doesn't know a stranger.

"She's in the hallways, in the classrooms," says Amy Smith, the college and career counselor at PCHS. "She even goes to pep rallies. Students, teachers, and staff love seeing her around school."

Looking for creative ideas to improve support for student mental health, Amy watched a presentation given by Service Dogs Alabama, a nonprofit that trains dogs to work with people of all ages and needs. Dogs assist people with physical mobility, mental health, seizures, and







intervention for autism and post-traumatic stress disorder.

"The presentation demonstrated how dogs could help people through all kinds of issues, and now because of that, we are very fortunate to have Sunny," Amy says.

Trained by Service Dogs Alabama as a facility dog to work in a school setting, Sunny is able to work independently, off the leash, and seek out students in need of support or comfort.

"When we walk into a classroom it's like she just knows who needs her," Amy says. "Sunny is usually quick to recognize someone who might be struggling, even if a human doesn't."

PCHS sophomore Morgan Russell remembers Sunny's influence as she adjusted to life in high school.

"I remember when I came to high school as a freshman, she was always roaming the hallways," Morgan says. "When you're in the counselor's office, Sunny's favorite thing is to sit next to you with her head in hole in the arm of the chair. She's very calming but can be rambunctious at the same time."

Mary, who is the school nurse, sees students who

experience anxiety heightened by academic stressors and circumstances in their home lives. She says the number of anxiety cases has increased in the last year and attributes the rise to the challenges students face while trying to navigate a post-Covid world.

"If students are having a bad day, anxiety often manifests physical symptoms, and their demeanor changes," she says. "Some students have anxiety attacks and feel like they are dying. Sunny picks up on students' signals and is a calming presence for them."

Sunny even supports students with diabetes. Mary says if students are having trouble with high or low blood sugar, having Sunny around helps them cope.

But Sunny likes to do more than offer emotional support. She participates in campus life, helping students create memorable experiences.

When Morgan decided to find a date for homecoming, she let Sunny join in the fun.

"I was like, you know what, I want to give Sunny a first experience, a homecoming proposal experience," Morgan says.

Morgan placed a sign with the request printed on it around Sunny's neck. With Sunny by her side, Morgan held up a sign that read, "If my puppy dog eyes don't work, maybe Sunny's will." Call it puppy dog eyes. Call it charm. Call it a stroke of genius. The proposal worked. Morgan's date said yes.

Sunny wins hearts wherever she goes. PCHS



senior Zibby Housh fell in love with Sunny at first sight and decided she needed her own Goldendoodle.

"We always had dogs in my house growing up, but I never got to pick one out," Zibby says. "I sent a picture of Sunny to my mom and told her I needed one. All she said was, 'Ask your dad.'"

Zibby's request started out as joke among family members, but Zibby knew if she wanted her dad to take her seriously, she needed to approach the matter another way. She needed to speak his language, the language of a businessman.

"My dad is a business man, so I decided to convince him with a PowerPoint presentation," Zibby says. "I wore business clothes and made him sit down for the presentation to convince him I needed a dog."

Zibby also put together an online campaign, collecting signatures of people who supported her efforts to get a Goldendoodle. In June 2021, the Goldendoodle who answers to the name Wags joined Zibby's family.

"My dad would not admit that he loves that dog, but I'll come into the living room and they will both be napping, snuggled up together," Zibby says.









Now Wags and Sunny play together in the park from time to time.

When Sunny is not walking around campus offering support to students, she lives with Amy.

"She's off the chain at home and just loves to have fun," Amy says. "But she knows when she's at school, she's at work. She knows what her purpose is."

As a service dog, Sunny is funded by a grant through the school system.


"We think every school needs dogs," Mary says, reaching out to hug her biggest four-legged fan. "Sunny makes all the difference in these kids' lives."

REVEALING THE BEAUTY OF TREASURES OF THE EARTH

Lakeside area craftsman transforms semi-precious stones into functional art

Gerald Hoyle's fascination for rocks started at an early age.

As a youngster growing up in the southern tip of rural St. Clair County, his family's property offered all kinds of opportunities for rambling and roaming and getting a close up look at the earth he walked over. He'd find treasures on his ramblings, things that caught his eye and his interest and he'd often take them home and add them to a collection. Some of the "rocks" turned out to be pieces of history, actual arrowheads like lots of kids like to spot, and he later learned that these were the tools of native people who lived throughout the area centuries ago.

Hoyle still enjoys the allure of the earth. Now age 77, he has more time since retiring some 15 years ago to hone his interest and add to the creations he turns out of his own. He says he might find a piece or two here and there, but he often orders his stockpiles of stone to work with in the shop out behind his home. This is where he has slabs and hunks of rock materials of all kinds, and he takes off often to spend hours in the tool-filled getaway he likes



to create in. He still lives on the family property he grew up on, wandering the fields and creek banks as a youngster where he started his fascination with geology and archaeology, and for the history of the area he lives in.

Arrowheads offered themselves up easily to young boys with the interests he had, and





Hoyle finds the same joy in much of the same these days. He'll craft his own replicas of historic pieces, using research in the books he's collected that guide the detail he chips into his own. But crafting pieces of semi-precious rock into wearable art is now a pursuit, and his pieces and pendants come in about as many colors and shapes as he can find to inspire them. He carves knife blades and forms the leather cases that shields them, and adds pieces of stone and other accents to give finish to the results.

The interest in jewelry has attracted his wife, Mary Margaret, to the process. She likes adding her own touches to some of the pieces with beaded borders or silver edging so they can be worn on a chain. The couple of 51 years laughs when they might not "see" the same end for a certain piece in progress, she's produced plenty of her own, and her husband does the same, too. When he's working, you can hear

the chipping and slight pounding as he turns tools to the rocks, and there's some light chatter made to himself as he "flakes" and picks pieces from the rock.

There are so many possibilities in the process there's room for the Hoyles to share their ideas, and sharing the results is likely what Hoyle enjoys most about the designs he turns out. "He just loves handing them out to people and telling them about them, probably as much as he likes making them, Mrs. Hoyle said.

Hoyle can talk for hours on the subjects he enjoys, from the raw pieces he finds himself and how they are used, to the relics and ways of the native inhabitants of the area to the processes he uses to finalize a design. Hoyle and his wife were

married after he served in the U.S. Air Force as an aircraft hydraulics specialist in Germany, but were somewhat acquainted earlier in their lives. Their families knew each other through their family connections, he said. He was 24 when they married, and he recalls what he was thinking at the time about choosing a wife. "I was saved by then, and I told the Lord that I didn't know if he wanted me to have a wife or not," Hoyle said. "I was at my uncle's house, and she just walked in. It was her, there was no doubt about it."

Since then, the two have remained on Hoyle's family land, where his childhood home still stands, and enjoy a piece of solitude together with their creative sides and their pets. Mrs. Hoyle is a quilter

Finding inspiration for the new year in the skies above Logan Martin

BUTEO LINEATUS.

I savored these two Latin words in my head before whispering, "beauty-o."

The sound fits, considering the gorgeous markings and coloring of the Red-Shouldered Hawk, the more handsome cousin to the Red-Tailed Hawk. Yet the better-looking avian cousin has smaller feet that cannot grasp prey bigger than a squirrel. Medium-sized between a goose and a crow, the Red-Shouldered Hawk is a perch hunter, its sharp gaze opportunistically alert for any small mammals such as voles, chipmunks, mice, and squirrels, along with smaller birds, reptiles, and frogs.

The Red-Shouldered Hawk swoops down from its high perch among deciduous and coniferous trees before gliding, flying low in the openness of the forested wetland, baring its talons to stealthily surprise-attack any prey. The wide banded tail and flight feathers with bold black and white stripes are enhanced by the rust-colored patches on the upper shoulders and reddish bared belly. The translucent crescent window markings in full display as the wingtips slightly forward, the distinctive reaching posture of this soaring hawk exudes a powerful stance, its sharp, hooked bill completing its prominent form. The Red-Shouldered Hawk is considered one of the most beautiful, if not the most striking, among birds of prey.

"Beauty-o," I say again, yet softly with a smile, as I observe the rust-colored raptor perching on

a branch of a mature oak tree some yards away, about 50 feet above the ground. What appeals to me the most about this slender, forest dwelling Buteo is the feeling I get from seeing such beauty, which parallels with the Cherokee belief of the Red-Shouldered Hawk with its razor-sharp vision and hearing as symbolism for courage, strength, and power. Seeing the raptor means that we are receiving protection from danger, from enemies.

Perhaps part of the danger involves unproductive patterns of doing and thinking such as allowing negative thoughts invade our peace. Seeing the soaring hawk reminds us to figuratively fly above and beyond our day-to-day thoughts. Instead, we are to have the bird's eye view of what is happening around us, what is going on in our lives, as a way to quiet our minds from anxiety and fear, to reconfigure and detach from unhealthy thought patterns.









What is even more wonderful about seeing the Red-Shouldered Hawk in our backyard or soaring over the lake means that whatever we are doing is working and helps contribute to a healthy, vibrant ecosystem. The acclaimed gold standard of backyard birding is attracting the presence of hawks due to their rarity among all kinds of birds. Providing an avian-friendly space with convenient food sources encourages this phenomenon; achieving this feat proves that we are ready to take on bigger tasks and challenges that would expand our horizons in any or all areas of our lives. Heeding the Cherokee belief, the presence of the Red-Shouldered Hawk means a message of vision, vitalizing us to envision the path ahead with a greater role in life.

I could not think of a more fitting winged symbol than the Red-Shouldered Hawk to herald the new year with the promises of new beginnings while manifesting our hopes into tangible results and goals.


For Brooke, the kitchen is the heart of the home.



The Robinsons did not get a boat until Brooke was in college, but they still spent a lot of time on the water. "A lot of our friends would ride by











"We have a party every Christmas Eve
















No matter if it's a text or a phone call and it's after hours, I will answer, and if my dogs are in the background barking like crazy, I'm going to apologize, then see how I can help, letting them know that I am here for them no matter what. I haven't been doing this long, but thus far, my clients rave over my ability to walk them through every step and keep them informed, my level of patience, and most of all how, I treat them more like a close friend than just a stranger trying to buy a house."

Barton says that with inflation taking over the economy, it has some buyers and sellers hesitant. With increased interest rates, people are reconsidering and trying to hold out for something more comfortable. Nevertheless, people still need homes.

To prospective buyers, she advises being pre-approved for a loan before they start looking at homes. "Without knowing what you qualify for, you could fall in love with a \$200K house, feeling like it checks off all your boxes, but only be approved for a \$100K. To have that pre-approval in place helps not only the agent but the buyer to be confident in the houses they are viewing."






