From the Editor

The cosmopolitan country girl

didn't recognize Tiffany Pate (née Moseley) when we crossed paths at Lakeside Park. It had been at least 15 years since I'd seen her, and she hadn't been much older than that at the time.

We were in Pell City to discuss the archery team she was coaching for a St. Clair County school, but once the conversation serendipitously revealed that we'd grown up in the same small town and attended the same high school back in Georgia, she asked if I knew her father.

"You're Tiffany Moseley," I replied densely, feeling like a fool as I suddenly saw Kenneth in his daughter's face.

In the old days, I had frequently worked with Kenneth and Gloria Moseley, who were both teachers. They'd been very helpful to me back when I was starting out as an education reporter, but I'd lost touch over the years.

So Tiffany and I spent a few fun minutes reminiscing about the provincial rural Southern town we both still call home and where, while in high school, she was cheerleading captain and active in the FFA and 4-H clubs.

"I think I was once in the local paper seven times from front page to back," she recalled with a laugh. "That was the stuff back then."

Tiffany and her siblings are the seventh generation of Moseleys to grow up on the

family farm, a sprawling and picturesque 2,700-acre property near the Georgia-Alabama border.

"I remember going out there a time or two," I said. "It's a long way from anywhere."

"I know. When you go to town, you make it worth your effort. But I enjoy hanging out on the farm. It's pretty out there."

Tiffany described a bucolic childhood that included bicycle excursions with her cousin, lunching at her great-grandmother's house (where the bread pudding was made from leftover breakfast biscuits and children knew to be on their best behavior because "she could knock you into next week with her pocketbook"), and playing in the woods with her sister.

"You have to be creative when you live out in the middle of nowhere," she said. "There's nothing like being barefoot in a mud hole making mud pies and trying to get your little sister to eat them. She never fell for it that it was chocolate."

"I suspect, though, that there's a bit of the cosmopolitan in the free-spirited country girl," I ventured.

"Oh, sure. I love to go to New York, and I can dress up and class it up when I need to, but my favorite days are still when I'm on the tractor and Daddy's behind me on the baler."


After we parted ways, I realized that

CALENDAR KEY

Fishing Condition: This is the overall rating for the whole day, based upon our formula:

Best Good Fair Poor

Best Time: This column lists the best time of the day when, according to our formula, fish will be biting: MORNING; EVENING.

March is ideal for crappie, bass fishing

Crappie and bass anglers often consider fishing to be at its best in early morning, but spring fishing can be more successful in the late afternoon and early evening. Early in the season, water usually takes three days after a cold front before it warms significantly enough to increase crappie and bass activity.

Because water warmer than 40 degrees is more buoyant than cooler water, spring warming creates a shallow, warmer layer of water late in the day on the downwind side of a lake. Although air will cool quickly after sunset, water retains its heat for quite some time. Because of the warmer water and better predatory efficiency of crappie and bass during low light conditions, these fish feed more aggressively in the late afternoon and early evening during the spring.

Early season crappie fishing begins when daffodil leaves push their way out of the soil, usually by late February. These early season crappie can be caught in shallow water, especially around woody debris and in vegetation over a hard bottom near deeper water. Some of the year's best catches occur at this time. For anglers unable to fish during the day, night fishing can be excellent as fish move into a lake's tributaries.













labama Power Company is making a concerted effort to survey, protect, collect, catalog and store artifacts recovered from its project lands, including the Logan Martin Lake reservoir development, according to its senior manager for cultural resource management.

The effort, Bill Gardner recently said to members of the Logan Martin Lake Protection Association, involves making sure individuals who use the lake conduct themselves properly, especially when the water isn't at full pool.

"We want to protect our cultural resources, and there have been some interesting finds on APC





general, which is the property of Alabama Power Company.

"Driving on the lakebed can compromise a site," Gardner said. "Cultural resource sites on Alabama Power Company projects or properties should not be disturbed. Cultural resources should be left in place, period."

Artifacts that are collected and preserved from sites are cataloged and stored for further research. Some artifacts are compared to artifacts found in other areas to give researchers a better understanding of cultural movement and differences, which Gardner said is why it is important to keep sites intact until qualified archeological researchers evaluate or survey them.

Site surveys were initially completed before APC reservoirs were constructed, but anytime a resident requests a shoreline permit to build a structure, such as a pier or seawall, that area must be surveyed for possible cultural resources, he said.

Lakeside residents who find what may be historic artifacts are directed to leave the items where they are found and immediately report the find to the local APC Lakeshore Office in Ragland by calling 205-472-0491.

"If you live on the lake and you notice what you believe may be unscrupulous activity, like people driving around or searching for items on the lakebed, please call it in," Gardner said.

hinese New Year ends on March 2, but you can get a taste of Chinese cuisine all year long at Jade East Buffet in Pell City.

Manager Leo Liew said the restaurant offers "the only Chinese buffet in town," and some of the most popular items for buffet

lovers include sesame chicken, sweet and sour chicken, Mongolian beef and hibachi fried rice with yum yum sauce. The buffet features two hot bars for serving a variety of flavorful dishes made with chicken, beef, pork or shrimp, several vegetable dishes, soups, rice, noodles and egg rolls. A cold bar features fresh salad fixings, crab, shrimp, a variety of fruits and an assortment of cakes.

Whether you choose to serve yourself at the buffet or order from the dine-in/take-out menu, it is helpful to know some Chinese words and phrases used to describe different culinary preparations.

mein and lo mein. These are stir fried dishes made with noodles, meat, vegetables, and spices. The difference is that chow mein noodles are fried crispy, and lo mein noodles are boiled soft before being tossed with the other ingredients.

Chop suey is also made with chicken, beef, pork or shrimp. It also has vegetables, but the vegetables are not cooked as long as other Chinese dishes, so they are still crunchy when served. Ingredients are cooked with a sauce thickened with corn starch, and served with rice instead of noodles.

Moo goo gai pan is a stir-fried dish with chicken and assorted vegetables including mushrooms, carrots, water chestnuts, snow peas, or bamboo shoots.

If you want to spice things up, choose dishes with the words "Hunan," "szechuan" or "kung pao."

Jade East Buffet offers Hunan beef, chicken and shrimp. The main ingredients for heat are chili pepper and garlic. Szechuan peppercorns, chili peppers and garlic provide the heat in Szechuan beef. The sweet, spicy flavor is milder than Hunan beef, but it will still make your lips tingle. Liew said the chefs at Jade East Buffet can make these dishes as hot, or not, as you please.

Friendly, attentive servers and a relaxed atmosphere make for an enjoyable dining experience. The restaurant, which also offers sushi and sashimi, is open Tuesday through Thursday from 11 a.m. to 9 p.m., Friday and Saturday from 11 a.m. to 10 p.m. and Sunday from 11 a.m. to 9 p.m.

Jade East Buffet offers a frequent diner card and a church donation card upon request. With the frequent diner card, every 10th lunch is free. With the church donation card, 10 percent of the amount spent on any given date will be donated to the church of your choice.

"We believe in giving back to the community, and this is just one small way we do that," Leiw said.





oating enthusiasts will tell you that money can't buy happiness, but it can buy a boat, which is the next best thing.

I attended the 47th annual Birmingham Boat Show at the Birmingham-Jefferson Civic Center and spoke with boat lovers, dealers, and others in the know about the latest trends in the boating industry. More than 600 of the newest, sleekest, fastest boats were on display and priced ready to sell. The show also featured the latest in motors, fishing gear, outfitters, personal watercrafts and water sports.

I must admit, I don't own a boat, and my expertise is limited, but I know a fabulous pontoon boat when I see one. I was immediately drawn to the classic lines and eye-catching exterior colors of the 2018 SunCatcher Diamond Elite 326 SS on display by Wedowee Marine. Their sales team was using the boat as a temporary office, and technician Ted Hammonds invited me onboard.

"Did you notice the powder-coated pontoons and tower? That's one of the latest trends for pontoon boats," he said, before showing me the interior.





In the bow, plush seating doubles as storage space for towels, tackle, totes and other things brought on board. A pedestal table with cup holders allows passengers to picnic, while under-deck storage for skis and water toys makes this boat perfect for fast-paced fun. The stern features two full-length lounge couches with lighted cup holders, built in stereo speakers and extra storage space. Stainless steel railings set off the swim deck and ski tow area.

The command center features touchscreen technology with adjustable split-screen views and digital gauges. RGB lighting is incorporated into the speakers and subwoofers and can be controlled by a Bluetooth enabled app on a smartphone. The high-back captain's chair reclines and swivels, and an elevated console provides an excellent helm.

"I have one just like this, and I love it. So not only am I an employee of Wedowee Marine, I'm a satisfied customer," he said.

The price tag of \$79,999, was a tad too much for me, but I had a feeling someone with excellent taste and a deeper pocketbook would come along and take her home.


I made my way across the exhibit hall, weaving in and out of brightly colored boats with shiny sparkle paint, until a Super Air Nautique G23 stopped me in my tracks. With its Tahitian Green and Mystic White gel-coat exterior and signature tower design, the sporty wake boat was a headturner.

The G23 is specially designed for wake boarding and wake surfing. Professional wake boarder and wake surfer Noah Flegel, who is ranked sixth by the World Wake Association, rides behind a G23 when he trains and competes. He is sponsored by Nautique and Hyperlite wakeboards, and he was on hand to promote both. It was my pleasure to meet and speak with the 20-year-old rock star of the wake world.

"I've been wakeboarding since I was 3 years old," he said. "I grew up on the intracoastal waterway in South Florida. I used to see kids wakeboarding, and from the time I was 2, I asked my parents to let me do it. One day they did, and I've never looked back."

In 2011, Sports Illustrated Kids named him SportsKid of the Year, and Team Nautique welcomed the freckle-faced phenom to its premier team of athletes in 2013.

"The Nautique G23 makes the best and biggest wakes you can get," he said. "I do flips and spins and other stunts, and the bigger the wave, the more air you can get. I've probably been 30 feet in the air. It feels like flying. It's crazy. If you're in control, it's not that crazy, but if you lose control,

it's scary. Falling 30 feet on your face is not fun."

He turned pro in 2014, and recently designed his own line of wakeboards and wake surfboards manufactured by Hyperlite.

"My line is called the RIOT series. I have two different

wakeboards and two different wake surfboards. I basically designed the entire shape, and then I worked with Hyperlite to fine tune it for production. I had a little input on the graphics, but I did most of the shaping, and they did most of the aesthetics."



After perusing party barges and wake makers, I made a beeline for the bass boats displayed by Sylacauga Marine.

A man wearing a T-shirt with "EAT. SLEEP. FISH. REPEAT" printed on the front walked slowly around a red and white Nitro Z17 on a custom-matched trailer. A sales representative engaged him in conversation, and I overheard her say something like this:

"The Nitro Vortex Technology hull with the Rapid Planing System delivers a smooth, dry ride with faster acceleration and precision handling. This boat comes with a Mercury 90 ELPT 4-Stroke motor, a fishfinder, a Minn Kota trolling motor, a built-in cooler, a 23-gallon livewell and the trailer it's sitting on."

I didn't eavesdrop long enough to find out if she made the sale, but many boats at the show had SOLD signs on them. The sales reps I spoke with, which also included such local dealers as Poor House Branch Marina and Woods Surfside Marina, were friendly and knowledgeable. They were familiar with the latest design trends in the industry and filled me in on what's hot.


- On the floor, carpet is out, and new synthetic flooring is in. Flooring made from contemporary vinyl offers the same comfortable, non-skid surface, yet dries in minutes and eliminates rotting and mold.
- On the dash, analog dials are out, and digital displays are in. Digital touchscreen displays connect to all systems in the boat. The engine, GPS program, stereo, fish finder and

other systems can be controlled with one touch. The screens are also designed to be viewed from any angle.

- For lighting, filament bulbs are out, and LED is in. LED lights are watertight to eliminate corrosion. They consume very little energy and can be tuned to an array of colors for interior lighting and for night vision when fishing after dark. LED lights can also be integrated into the stereo system.
- More versatile seating allows passengers to sit, sun and sleep all on the same piece of furniture. Forward facing seats allow you to enjoy the view while underway, and with a flip of a cushion, you can face aft to watch the wakeboard action.
- Social media has added a new dimension to boating. Boaters are using their iPhones and GoPro cameras to capture and upload pictures to Facebook, YouTube and Instagram. New boats have built-in mobile phone charging stations and waterproof action camera mounts.

But innovation and imagination weren't limited to the boating industry. Custom-built docks, lifts and boathouses are also on the cutting edge with newer designs and maintenance-free materials. Everything from flotation devices to fishing rods is bigger, brighter and better for 2018.

Attending the Birmingham Boat Show was fun and educational, and I plan to attend next year's event. I still don't own a boat, but I have friends and family who do, and that's the next best thing.

ANNUAL RENEW OUR RIVERS LAKE CLEANUP HAS SIGNIFICANT ECONOMIC IMPACT

labama Power Company has announced that 15 million pounds of waste have been removed from adopted waterways – including Logan Martin Lake and the Coosa River – since the start of the Renew Our Rivers (ROR) program.

ROR began in 2000 as the result of a one-time river cleanup event in Gadsden organized by now-retired Gene Phifer and other Alabama Power employees who took the initiative to clean litter along the Coosa River.

Today, the environmental stewardship program is nationally recognized as one of the largest river cleanups including river systems across Alabama, Georgia, Florida and Mississippi. Thousands of volunteers participate each year. In 2017 alone, more than 4,700 volunteers removed roughly 295,000 pounds of trash and debris from Alabama waterways. This year, the program is set to host 30 cleanups, including the 18th annual Logan Martin Lake cleanup March 17-24.

Both Alabama Power Company and the Logan Martin Lake Protection Association (LMLPA) will work collectively to provide volunteers with cleanup supplies and other essentials between 8 a.m. and noon on March 17 or 24 at one of the collection sites listed at www.lmlpa.org.

"It's a fun time to get the family out," said Mike Clelland, an environmental specialist with Alabama Power. "Everybody who participates gets a free t-shirt and free

The free lunch is provided at the picnic at noon on March 24, at Lakeside Park in Pell City to celebrate the conclusion of the cleanup efforts.

What's most important is the environmental impact volunteers have on maintaining the lake and protecting the wildlife, according to the ROR chairman for Logan Martin.

Mike Riley said leaving unsightly trash in the lake can have an adverse effect on the birds, ducks and fish. Plastics, for example, are long-lasting and durable or non-biodegradable, despite their ability to disintegrate from long periods of sun exposure. Unfortunately, they can also be hazardous to wildlife, which is sometimes known to die from plastic ingestion.

Riley said the amount of trash removed from Logan Martin Lake depends

on how many volunteers participate, the weather and how observant everyone is about keeping trash out of the lake.

"Any trash you see on the road will end up at the lake," he said.

For this reason, volunteers are also encouraged to adopt-a-road or clean up behind litterbugs.

Last year, the Logan Martin cleanup had 832 volunteers, compared to only 100 in 2001. The LMLPA also documented that 6.25 tons of trash were collected from the lake in 2017, a 13 percent increase from 2015.

As of now, Riley is expecting 928 volunteers to be present at Logan Martin Lake next month. However, more volunteers are welcome to participate by signing up online at www.lmlpa.org or calling Riley at 205-531-2372.

"We were hooked on the lake," Susan said. "It was our dream to have a house on the lake, but we would look at Smith Lake properties because that's what we were familiar with."


Her brother owned a home on the banks of Logan Martin Lake, but because of their busy schedules, they didn't see each other often.







hatever he's doing, Brandon Turner doesn't believe in settling for good enough.

"I want to be great at anything I do," he said. "Be better than good. That's my new

It's an attitude the collection manager at Metro Bank happily brings to his new role as president of the Pell City Chamber of Commerce, which he assumed in January.
