



Editors Note

Another partnership brings benefits to the lakeside community

Lance corporal Daniel Centilli, USMC, was serving in Afghanistan during Operation Enduring Freedom when the high-mobility multipurpose wheeled vehicle he occupied was hit by an improvised explosive device. He returned home to Pell City in 2012 with a traumatic brain injury and post-traumatic stress disorder, which eventually

led to his death four years ago.

To honor her son's memory and help other U.S. military veterans transition back to civilian life, Alana Centilli has founded Dovetail Landing, a 50-acre facility at 11534 Stemley Road in Lincoln where veterans can "find peace and serenity while working their way back into society as they knew it before the military."

Described as a "reverse boot camp" for returning veterans, the nonprofit center has the goal of being a single location providing all the

resources veterans might need without not having to worry about where they will live or eat while getting the care they need when returning home.

Groundbreaking ceremonies were held late last year, and just a few weeks ago Dovetail Landing and Central Alabama Community College (CACC) announced a new partnership between their two organizations.

"Our alliance with CACC is a significant stride towards providing veterans with robust, industry-relevant training that paves the way for successful careers post-service," said Alana Centilli, who serves as Dovetail Landing's president. "Together, we are crafting a future where our veterans are well equipped with skills and acknowledged and valued in the workforce."

The partnership involves "a mutual commitment

to serving and uplifting veterans, providing them comprehensive workforce training and educational programs to enhance their credentials and skills." CACC makes available its resources and connections to provide training and career guidance for veterans, and Dovetail Landing will promote CACC as the preferred provider of

such programs.

"This exemplifies CACC's commitment to serving our veterans," said college president Jeff Lynn. "By combining our educational and training expertise with Dovetail Landing's programs, we aim to empower our veterans with the skills, credentials, and opportunities they need to thrive in their post-military careers. At CACC, we believe in creating opportunities that have a lasting impact. This collaboration is not just about providing education and training. It's about creating sustainable career pathways for our veterans

career pathways for our veterans and ensuring they have the support and resources they need to succeed in their endeavors."

More details will become available later, but news of the partnership is another example of individuals and organizations working together for the benefit of the lakeside community. We're happy to include it in this issue of Lakeside Living. THERE'S NO BETTER TIME FOR FISHING THAN NOVEMBER

The month of November can be great for bass fishing on Logan Martin. Water temperatures are cooling, and the bass are feeding. Major feeding windows will present themselves as the days become shorter. There is no better time of the year than fall for fishing. Spotted bass, largemouth bass, and striped bass will actively feed in preparation for the winter. This is a great time to throw a jerkbait for hard reaction strikes.

Jerkbait is exactly what it's called: a bait that jerks and has erratic action. This is especially important in the midto-late fall because baitfish will act very erratic. This is also because the shad are under constant stress from gamefish attacking them. The jerkbait is perfect for the situation. Some of my favorite jerkbaits are the KVD 200 and Spro McStick. I opt for the smaller, 2-hook models in November. Pair these lures with a medium bait cast rod and bait cast reel. You can also use medium spinning reels for this setup. Line of choice will be 10-12-pound fluorocarbon, but monofilament will work as well.

When targeting these bass In November, I always start at the creek mouths. Small cuts and pockets off the main river will hold bass and baitfish as well. If you can find the baitfish, you will find the bass. Always keep an eye out for schooling fish. Busting action on top of the water is a dead giveaway. When using the jerkbait, I like to reel the bait down a couple of cranks and then start jerking the rod on slack line. This will make the jerkbait move erratically from side to side. This reaction will cause the bass to smash the lure. Hold on tight, the big spots will rip the rod out of your hand.

Third annual Lakeside Live brings the Logan Martin community together through music and fellowship











Perhaps the biggest crowd-pleaser is the festival's annual Battle of the Badges contest between Pell City's police and fire departments. The competition includes a tug-of-war and various obstacle courses.






"The police won the competition this time," Cambron said. "I was really proud of them because the fire department had won the first two. You could tell they were ready this year."

to know the community," Cambron said. "I'm really proud of the relationship between the community and its law enforcement and first responders, but it's always good to remember they are people just like us."

Cambron noted he got the inspiration to start the festival growing up in Columbus, Georgia. "I knew I wanted to recreate something similar to their River Fest. It was something I always loved going to as a kid."

Proceeds from the festival benefit The Five 16 Foundation. which gives back to various Pell City and community organizations each year.

"We were able to raise \$10,000 this year," Cambron



Despite saying goodbye to summer, many locals had disco inferno coursing through their veins on a recent weekend, thanks to The Black Jacket Symphony and Pell City's Center for Education and Performing Arts.

I was among them.

It wasn't the first time I had seen The Black Jacket Symphony, and I don't intend on it being my last. It was, however, my first time attending Live at Logan Martin. This year – the fourth annual show – the symphony performed "Saturday Night Fever," the soundtrack to the 1977 film that popularized disco and propelled John Travolta to stardom.

Before attending the show, I

debated if I should watch the movie. I consider myself to be quite the pop culture afficionado, so I was somewhat ashamed to admit that I have never seen such a cinematic classic. I decided it would be more fun to let the music be a surprise and just enjoy the unknown.

The weather was absolutely perfect, and I was thankful the storms from Hurricane Idalia had

subsided. Navigating to the designated venue at the park was a breeze, thanks to CEPA staff, who used golf carts to shuttle attendees to the concert area.

A Black Jacket Symphony show is more than a concert. It's an experience.

Jay Willoughby, one of the band's founders, describes its shows as "note-for-note representations of classic rock albums." To date, the Black Jacket Symphony has created live shows based around more than 40 classic albums, including "Hotel California" by The Eagles, "The Dark Side of the Moon" by Pink Floyd; "Purple Rain" by Prince; "A Night at the Opera" by Queen; and "Sgt. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band" by The Beatles.

The band selects the musicians specifically to fit each show. With



such an operation, it is able to rotate and travel with multiple shows at once, expanding its audience and musical catalog.

As the sun began to set over Logan Martin Lake, the evening was just heating up.

"I can't imagine a better way to spend the holiday weekend," I thought to myself. My boyfriend and I found the perfect spot near the back of the crowd but still close to the water, where a fleet of boats had already docked.

After checking the Alabama score one last time, I was ready to time travel back to the 1970s.

The Black Jacket Symphony kicked the show off with vigor,

giving an organic performance of "Stayin' Alive" by The Bee Gees. I was immediately impressed with the vocalist being able to match the famous falsetto of the brothers Gibb.


The band transitioned right into another Bee Gees classic, "How Deep is Your Love," which sounded fantastic.

These additions might seem small, but they truly set the group apart from being just another cover band. Black Jacket musicians always pay attention to every detail in an album, and it shows.

Not to my surprise, several people throughout the evening stood up and danced, showing off their best disco moves. Black Jacket always has this effect on crowds.

Each Black Jacket Symphony show is unique, but one thing is always the same—the second half of the show is more of a party, a greatest hits-style setlist. Some of these instant mood boosters included "Celebration"



by Kool & The Gang; "I will Survive" by Gloria Gaynor, and "Le Freak" by Chic.

Leaving the show, I knew I would have several of those

songs in my head for weeks to come – and that I had to add "Saturday Night Fever" to my watch list.

Rollin', rollin', rollin' ON THE RIVER

Local waterways have a staunch ally and advocate in the Coosa Riverkeeper

Justinn Overton and I exchanged waves upon my arrival at Lincoln's Landing, where she was at the helm of the Coosa Riverkeeper's boat tied to the dock.

"Does this vessel have a name?" I asked as a settled onboard.

"Its name is the Olive II, and there's a great story behind it, which I'll tell you later," she replied, having untied the craft and begun steering it in a half-circle away from the landing, headed north.

The executive director of
the Coosa Riverkeeper – a
nonprofit membership organization
dedicated to protecting, restoring,
and promoting the Coosa River and its
tributaries – was on the water that morning to
patrol a portion of the waterway and collect some
water samples for testing.

"We serve as the voice of the Coosa River,"
Justinn said when I asked her to explain what the riverkeeper does. "We monitor the river and the more than 1,000 pollution permit holders in the Coosa Valley. We investigate pollution reports, respond to citizen complaints, conduct research, and educate the public. Our work is all about protecting public health and public waterways."

For someone who grew up enjoying the outdoors and especially the water, she's the ideal person to take the lead in advocating for waterways in central Alabama.

"Coming to Logan Martin Lake was a huge part of my childhood," she said. "I got involved with advocacy in high school and got my degree in environmental advocacy at the University of Alabama. Our state offers so many great opportunities for exploring the outdoors,

> and I am very rooted in what it means to be an Alabamian. Our natural resources are important to us, and when we protect them, they protect us."

Justinn's organization is responsible for 220 miles of the Coosa River and its tributaries, from Gadsden to Wetumpka. "It's a large area, but what happens in Gadsden can affect Logan Martin, and so on

down. Our waterways are all connected."

I asked her to identify the biggest challenge the Coosa Riverkeeper faces.

"Two things," she said, "and they're somewhat related. First is funding, meaning that we are a nonprofit organization and there are a lot of other worthy causes that people can give to. So over time, as we continue to build value with our services and our programs, we hope it won't remain nearly as much of a challenge as it still is.

"The second is the social and systemic thing





that keeps me up at night: the ways in which our state agencies are captured by industry. The idea, for example, that an average person with a construction site could get fined more than a multi-million-dollar corporation that's doing something that's arguably much more hazardous to public health is disturbing. We're going to have to change the system so that it's more fair for everyone who uses this river. And everyone should be held accountable. It shouldn't matter if the business has a lot of jobs that it offers. There shouldn't be a choice between the economy and the environment. Our political structure makes it seem like there has to be."

"You mean the idea that if, say, a person is concerned about the environment they don't care about the economy at all?" I ventured.

"Exactly, but listen – there is economic value with all the fishing tournaments this river hosts. It's a place for ecotourism. People come here to rent houses. People come here to buy houses. Nobody wants to do any of those things in waters that are polluted. It loses its value. So the question is, how can we as an organization continue to educate the public and build wealth while also holding the people that are





build wealth while also holding the people that are violating the law accountable? That's a really big job."

"What are some of the challenges to water quality in the river?"

"A huge problem in growing places like Pell City is turbidity," she said. "A way to think about turbidity is what a creek looks like after rain. Have you ever noticed how after a rain event, a lot of our waterways and creeks are very, very muddy? That does a couple of things.

"First, E. coli likes to hitchhike on on dirt particles.

So if there's a high concentration of turbidity, that can be an indicator that there might be a high concentration of E. coli. The other thing is that the critters that live in our waterways, their habitat gets altered. So if a muscle, for instance, really likes a rocky bottom and there's a construction site upstream and that construction site has a lot of sediment entering the waterway, those muscles will likely have a problem with population.

"Lastly, treating water with a lot of turbidity is costly for our water systems, so why would we not want to work to prevent dirt getting our waterway if

going to be costly for our water systems, and also it's illegal?"

I was curious about why turbidity is a problem in a place like Pell City.

"It's a growing city," Justinn explained. "There's just a lot of construction going on, and agencies are very limited in their inspection. But Pell City, compared to a lot of other places, has done a fantastic job of locally staying on top of their construction sites. I've actually have had a really great working relationship with city manager, and he wants to make sure that development is done responsibly, but not everybody has leaders in positions of power like that, that will hold people accountable."

"What keeps you going?" I asked.

She smiled. "I get a lot of energy from people who have the same enthusiasm for this voice that I do. I have met some of the most interesting and lovely people through that process. Some real characters Yeah, some real characters. River people are awesome."

As she steered the boat back to Lincoln's Landing, I reminded her that she still hadn't told the story behind the Olive II.

"Right," she said. "So our very first patrol boat was named the Olive. It was a really old shabby, flat-bottom boat, nothing special about it. It was we could afford - a board member leased it to us for like a dollar, and we named it the Olive because the creator of Popeye the Sailor Man was from Gadsden. And his idea originally was that the setting for Popeye was going to be inspired by the Coosa River. But he was told that he needed to make it more accessible, so he changed it to a salty sea instead of a river. Our boat was a green one, so we named it the Olive after Popeye's girlfriend, and then when we got the funding to upgrade our patrol boat, I decided let's get a green and name it the Olive II. It's an homage to Popeye the Sailor Man and an example of one of the ways the Coosa River system has inspired culture."

TRY THESE RECIPES FOR TASTY TWISTS ON TRADITIONAL AUTUMN FARE

November by the lake means chilly days and nights, football Saturdays, and thoughts of thankfulness in the company of family, friends, and food. Whether you choose to prepare them for a game day gathering or traditional family meal, Lakeside Living is happy to offer the following suggestions that are sure to bring cheer to your seasonal table.

Autumn Harvest Pizza

A riot of joyous fall flavors and colors come together in this easy autumn recipe that's perfect for any weeknight or weekend meal. Start by prepping your own pizza dough (it's easier than you think) and then pile it with cheese and the bounty of such seasonal veggies as squash, eggplant, and spinach. A topping of bacon gives it a boost of flavor, but you can easily edit that out if you want to keep it vegetarian (and if you want to make this recipe vegan, sub the cheese for your favorite non-dairy alternative or coconut oil).

Prep Time: 1 hour 20 minutes Cook Time: 40 minutes

Yield: 1 large or 4 small pizzas

INGREDIENTS FOR PIZZA

- 1 1/4 tsp active dry yeast
- 1 tsp sugar
- 1 cup lukewarm water
- 1 ½ cups white flour
- 1 cup whole wheat flour
- 3 to 4 tbsp olive oil and 1 or 2 tbsp. more to roll the dough or as needed.
- 1 tsp salt







FOR THE TOPPINGS

- 1 carrot, cut in rounds
- 1 cup cubed squash
- 1 eggplant cubed
- 1 red onion cut in wedges
- 1 red bell pepper in julienne
- 3 tbsp honey
- ½ tsp ground cumin
- 2 tbsp olive oil plus 1 tbsp more to finish
- salt and black pepper
- 6 oz. grated mozzarella, goat cheese or blue cheese
- 4 slices cooked bacon, chopped
- 1 tsp dried oregano
- 1 tsp dried thyme
- zest of 1 lemon
- zest of 1 orange
- 1 tbsp. sesame seeds
- 4 tbsp roughly chopped almonds
- 1 bunch baby spinach leaves

DIRECTIONS

- 1. In a bowl, combine the dry yeast with sugar and water. Add the flour next, then pour 4 tbsp. of olive oil and combine using your hands, working it into a dough. Add more oil if they mix is too dry. The dough should be sticky and moist but also easily formed into a ball.
- 2. After about 4 minutes you should be able to form a ball. Place in a Ziplock bag and leave to rise someplace warm for about 1 hour.
- 3. For the pizza topping, combine the carrots, squash, eggplants, onion, and the red bell pepper with the honey, the cumin powder, and olive oil, then season with salt and black pepper to taste, tossing to fully coat. Transfer to a baking sheet and bake at 350 degrees until golden. Reserve warm.
- 4. Take the leavened dough and roll it out directly on a pizza pan with fingers moist with olive oil. This will yield 4 small pizzas or 1 large one. Brush with olive oil and bake at 350 degrees for 8010 minutes or until golden.
 - 5. Remove from oven, top with cheese, fall harvest

vegetables, the bacon, and finally more cheese. Bake for another 4 minutes until the cheese is melted, then finish with oregano, thyme, the lemon and orange zest, the sesame seeds and the roughly chopped almonds, the baby spinach leaves, and a drizzle of olive oil.

Cheddar and Bacon Buttermilk Biscuits

Serve these buttery biscuits with the main dish at lunch or dinner.

Prep Time: 20 minutes
Cook Time: 25 minutes
Yield: about 1 dozen biscuits

INGREDIENTS

- 1 ¾ cups cold flour
- 4 1/4 teaspoons baking powder
- 2 tablespoons white sugar
- 1 ¼ teaspoons baking soda
- ½ cup (1 stick) unsalted very cold butter cut in cubes
- 1 cup cold buttermilk
- 6 ounces grated cheddar cheese
- 6 ounces chopped bacon, sautéed
- ¼ cup chopped chives
- 1 tablespoon melted butter
- 1 teaspoon sea salt
- 1 cup (2 sticks) butter at room temperature
- ¼ cup maple syrup
- ¼ teaspoon cinnamon

DIRECTIONS

- 1. In a big bowl, combine the flour with the baking powder, the sugar, and baking soda.
- 2. With 2 forks or a pastry cutter, cut the cold butter into the flour mixture until it looks like breadcrumbs.
- 3. Add the cold buttermilk, the cheese, the bacon, and the chives and fold over until the dough separates from the walls of the bowl. Do not to overmix.
- 4. Put the dough onto a flat surface and roll the dough with a wooden rolling pin to get the dough about 1½ inches thick.
- 5. Cut using 2 1/2 inch cookie cutter. Place them on a baking pan covered with unbuttered baking paper. Brush the biscuits with melted butter and sprinkle with sea salt.
 - 6. Bake for 12-15 minutes or until golden brown.



- 7. Let cool for 4 to 6 minutes and serve
- 8. For the maple butter: place the butter in a bowl, add the maple syrup and the cinnamon, and whisk vigorously with a wire whisk until fluffy.

Hidden treasures among the southern longleaf pines

Stuffing hands into the pockets of my hoodie in an attempt to get warmer against the briskness of the breeze, I leave the dirt road to go deeper into the forest, to explore the undeveloped waterfront lot. The brilliance of the early afternoon sun pierces through the canopy of long,

slender needles of the southern longleaf pine. As I relish the pine smells that pervade the air, I cannot help but admire the soaring heights of these trees, which can grow up to 100 feet.

The Pinus palustris Miller species, protected due to almost having reached extinction from being heavily timbered in the late 1800s and early 1900s, cloths the entire state of Alabama, symbolizing the state's beauty and history.

Thus, the southern longleaf pine is appropriately designated as the official state tree.

Rustling sounds pull my attention up in time to see a bald eagle in flight, its magnificent talons hooking as anticipating prey. The sun's brilliance enhances the sheer whiteness of the eagle's head. I stop walking to watch the graceful sweeps of the eagle's wings, along with seeing the sheer whiteness of its head enhanced by the sun's

brilliance as sharp contrast against the dark green canopy of pine needles and cones. When I no longer can see the bald eagle as it continues flying away further away, I resume walking.

Spotting a fallen ten-inch cone, I reach down to pick it up. Recalling my younger days as a Girl Scout when we would collect the large, woody cones to use as decorations by painting them in colors of Thanksgiving or Christmas, I smile at the perfection of the cone in my hand. Maybe I will paint this one to bring back nostalgia.


Having reached the other end of the lot to get a better view of the lake, I lean against the brownish red bark of a pine tree. On another tree a few yards away, a pair of squirrels chase each other across the lower hanging branches. Pausing in their chittering for a moment, their perceptive dark eyes meet mine to determine if I would not chase after them. Then one of them scrambles away, and the other follows it.

Gingerly placing my pine cone on the ground, I settle on the ground by crossing my legs and

After a few more moments of appreciating my surroundings, I stand up and brush off the

needles from the seat of my jeans. My movements seem to startle a pair of blue herons as they slap their wings, emerging from the trees to my left. Fumbling to pull out my phone, I managed to take a few pictures before they are gone. I cannot wait to get back to the house to show my friend, who has been wanting some pictures of the blue herons to use as inspiration for painting.

A walk in the woods never fails me when I need inspiration. And the strength and resilience of the southern longleaf pines never fail to instill awe within me.



A floral paradise on the shores of Logan Martin

Varieties of flora abound in the Settles' lakeside landscaping



For Dr. Harold Settle and his wife Virna, their home on the Logan Martin shoreline is a refuge cloaked in nature. The home is surrounded by an astonishing collection of flora planted by the Settles.

"These banana plants were given to us by the neighbor," the doctor said, pointing out an example. "I was doing stress tests at the office one day, and I looked at a patient's address and recognized our street. I told her that Virna always threatens to come over and take some leaves. The neighbor came over the next year with nine banana roots to plant.

"Virna answered the door, and the neighbor asked her if her mother was home—she thought Virna was my daughter," he added with a laugh.

The Settles have an herb garden just outside their back door featuring thyme, basil, parsley, rosemary and lavender. The front corner of the home has two Savannah Holly trees.

The list of plants on the property is expansive, but there are Japanese maple trees, camellias, Japanese cherry trees, ferns, a Dutch iris, a Meyer lemon tree, peppers, clematis, daffodils, hostas,














a plum tree, a live oak similar to the ones on Toomer's Corner in Auburn, a Harry Lauder's walking stick plant, a persimmon tree, blueberries, and what this writer would consider enough roses to enter the parade in Pasadena, California.

"The landscaping never stops," Harold said. "There is always something that needs to be done. I had both hips replaced last year, and it has taken me seven to eight months to recover."

With all the upkeep necessary for the yard, the Settles do not sleep late. "Generally, we do all of our work in the morning, and in the afternoons, we don't work. If it is a hot day, we will get in the swimming pool," he said.

"Virna wanted a swimming pool. I did not. She kept after me and would say, 'I don't want to get in the lake; I can't see the





bottom.' Finally, after four years, I looked into it and saw that it could work, so we used Hollywood Pools in Vestavia Hills. I don't know why she didn't talk me into it sooner."

According to the doctor, "to properly tour the yard and see everything, it takes about one hour and two glasses of wine."

The wine cellar in their basement stands at the ready for any lengthy lawn tours or for a casual afternoon at home.

"We have some wine every afternoon to relax. We try to drink decent wines, but we do not drink very expensive wines," said Dr. Settle, who stopped practicing cardiology in December 2017, "but I have started working again doing 20 hours a week for Social Security. I am usually here working in the yard."

The grotto in their backyard was formerly a dog pen.

"The stained glass windows in the grotto are from the Veranda on Highland restaurant in Birmingham. I got them from Southern Architecture in Cullman. They have quotes from Hemingway and Shakespeare," Harold said.


From his perspective, the home has evolved considerably over the last 30 years, including the additions of Virna's grotto and the pizza oven. "But the best addition has been Virna."

"The water feels good today," Justinn Overton said as she settled onto a large rock in the middle of Yellowleaf Creek, a tributary of the Coosa River that is home to the coldwater darter, Etowah heelsplitter mussel, and cylindrical lioplax snail.

The presence of such aquatic creatures in local waters may not mean much to many outdoors enthusiasts, but, as staff riverkeeper and executive director of Coosa Riverkeepers, it means a lot to her.

She is passionate about the biodiversity in the Coosa, Logan Martin Lake, and all of Alabama's waterways. Protecting such environmental habitats and keeping the water safe for those who live by it and enjoy using it is the focus of her work, which sometimes involves

It's important work, but it can be emotionally taxing, which she explained during a late morning excursion to the scenic and tranquil creek.

How important are Alabama's natural resources?

"Being able to connect people to their environment is important. It's good for your mental health to be outside. It's good for your physical health to be outside. We live in a state where there's a lot of there's a lot of arguments that if you care about the environment, then you don't care about the economy, but I think that's a really antiquated way to look at it, because you need healthy people for a healthy economy. In order to have healthy economy, you need healthy workers. You need healthy people healthy air and water and soil."

How she feels when she's on or by the water: "Honestly, I'm normally really giggly. I become very childlike and playful. I think that's because I feel very safe. I'm comfortable on, in, and by the water. I grew up visiting Logan Martin Lake, and the excitement and anticipation I felt then – 'Okay, we're almost there. Okay, when can we get in? Okay, when can we get on the boat?' – I still feel all these years later. I can't I can't help but smile because part of my job is going to some of the most beautiful places in this river system, but then I also have to see some of the most horrific places in the server system in terms of pollution

and in terms of just poor regulation. Even on the days when I have to look at the ugly stuff, it makes me appreciate the places that that are still being protected."

An early advocate: "I was very active in high school, and I started a group that did cleanups and things around our school. I've always been very service-oriented, and I don't shy away from the difficult things or the hard work. My name, the Latin meaning is 'standing for justice or righteousness.' I don't know if that got into my subconscious, but I feel like I was supposed to live up to the meaning of my name. I feel very privileged that I get to speak for this river and for the people that use it."

Does that responsibility get overwhelming sometimes? "It does take an emotional toll on me. So many people reach

out to us because they need help from their local government, or county or state. They've tried those avenues, and they haven't heard back. So when they reach out to us, we have an immediate sense of urgency because I feel like it's really important to treat everybody's issues like it's happening in my own backyard. It's a personal issue for them. This is their property value. This is their ability for their grandkids to come over and swim safely. I take a lot of that really hard to my heart, and there's also days where it's like this system, whatever that may be, it's so disjointed and broken that it can be just overwhelming in itself. Like how can we be effective and results-oriented and data-driven within the confines of the budget that we have? Like I need way more staff to do the work to the to the maximum extent of what needs to be done. So, yeah, I've burned out and I've burned up.

We're protecting a public resource, so the intensity is a real thing. I have been an intense person my whole life, so I guess I don't know anything different, but I have I have the best team. I really do.

The Coosa Riverkeeper team:

"Each one of them brings so much to the work, and they bring such unique perspectives because of their own circumstances and how they interact with water. I love being able to learn from them. So much of the work we are doing involves trying out ideas, and that is not always easy. I really appreciate how brave they all are, because I've asked them to create programs and structures and do things a lot of them had never done before. So I love them. They're the best."

Her ideal day on the river: "My favorite section to be on is the Coosa below Jordan Dam. There's a seven-mile stretch there where the river free-flowingly runs. It's the only part of the river system that runs like that anymore because of all of our reservoirs. I love being down there because it's where our geographic region makes the transition to the coastal plain, so all the trees are dripping with Spanish moss. There's cypress knees along the riverbank, the river moves and flows,

and it feels almost like primordial there. I'd be in a canoe and would probably camp on an island down there that night. We just did that recently, and it was so much fun. There would be coolers with lots of fruit and beer and water and snacks. I'd probably want my staff there, because every time we're on that stretch of water there's all these shenanigans going on.

The last book she read: Keeping the Chattahoochee, by Sally Sierer Bethea. "She is one of my heroes. She started Chattahoochee Riverkeeper, which is one of the largest riverkeeper programs. I admire her so much. I'm the only female waterkeeper in the state, so I have a lot of admiration for how she changed people's lives for the better through her work."


Three things she can't live without: "Earl Grey. Tea is such a pleasurable experience. I have to have some amount of snacks on me, because being on the water, I'm not always in a place where I can eat a lot, but I need to graze so that I don't get

hangry. And I cannot live without my AirPods because I take a lot of calls on the boat or on the road or putting a trailer on or while I'm backing the boat down. They are an extension of me, especially with this job.

The food she could eat every day: "Easy – I love Mexican food. Huevos rancheros is one of my favorites because I love breakfast, and it's Mexican so it allows me to enjoy both at once."

The food she hopes to never eat again: "English peas. I hate them.
There's no place for them in this world. I don't care if the queen of England walked in right now, I wouldn't even eat them to be polite."

If, while patrolling the Coosa, she saw a penguin waving from the bank: "I would think he's probably there because he got lost and he probably is looking for directions to how to get south. But I'm gonna have to tell him that he can't he can't go through the dams."




