Alabama is blessed with an abundance of water

To fund the management of fishing in public waters, fishing licenses are required for anglers 16 and older. Alabama has two exceptions. For anglers fishing with a pole and line only (the pole does not have a reel) from the bank in the county of residence, a fishing license is not required. For those that like to fish with a pole and line, a Wildlife Heritage License which allows bank fishing statewide is required. Also, Alabama residents 65 and older also do not need a license. However, a Senior License is available to them which allows the Division to collect additional federal funding.

Most of Alabama is blessed with clean water, and the fish in these waters are safe for eating. There are a few water bodies, however, where the Alabama Department of Public Health advises that fish not be consumed. The latest information may be obtained by calling 1-800-201-8208.

Boating Tip

All children under eight years of age must wear a life jacket while on a boat. Why not wear your life jacket as an example to your children. The life you save may be your own!

It's the law! Everyone on board a vessel must have a life jacket available to them. Make sure they fit properly and are in good condition. Also, anyone being towed on skis or a tube, riding a Jet Ski or Sea Doo, or boating within 800 feet below a dam must wear a life jacket.



and found out they were looking for someone to run it," Megginson said.

"We had talked about different places, and then they offered us this one," Isbell added. "The Lord just kind of placed it in our lap. The good Lord has definitely opened some doors for us."

Isbell and Megginson started out as neighbors in Clear Creek Marina.

a hammer and saw. She recently put down new flooring in her home at Clear Creek Marina by herself." She has recently begun "repurposing" old things into new items for the home, she added.

"We (also) have a wide variety of old and unique things, from old rusted signs to man cave items to beautiful antique, refurbished furniture," Isbell said. "Plus, it is a lot fun with my friend, neighbor and partner to do what we have always loved to do—shop."

They also buy items on consignment and work with local artisans and craftsmen such as Jeremy Gentry, who specializes in making kitchen and other household gadgets into working light fixtures and converting bed parts into swings and benches.

Although the two are working to build a customer base off walk-in business, there are already two customers

that stand out.

The first was a 10-year-old boy from Birmingham, who ended up buying an old gray oil can for his grandfather, because the grandfather once owned a Gulf Station. The other is an 8-year-old girl whose parents work across the street and who comes in by herself sometimes to shop. She will say that she is saving her money for a particular item and have it held for her.

When she returns to buy it, she "counts out the money, always the correct amount from her purse," Megginson said. "Neither of the things she purchased was more than \$5, but the experience was priceless to me, and, I hope, the customers."

small to medium size chunks. Peel apples and cut the same way.

Grease a casserole dish and place sweet potatoes in bottom; add apples. Melt margarine and drizzle over the top of yam-apple mixture. In a small mixing bowl, combine brown sugar, cinnamon, and salt; mix well. Sprinkle over the top of casserole. Cover lightly with foil and bake 45 minutes in a preheated 350 degree oven. Remove foil the last 10 minutes so that casserole can brown lightly.

CORNBREAD DRESSING

6 cups cornbread crumbs

2 cups biscuit crumbs

1/2 teaspoon salt

- 1 teaspoon black pepper
- 1 & ½ tablespoons rubbed sage
- 2 cups chopped celery
- 1 & ½ cups chopped onion

½ cup melted butter

1/3 cup broth

½ cup oil

2 cups reserved broth

3 eggs, lightly beaten

Combine first five ingredients in a large bowl. Set aside. In a medium saucepan, combine onion, celery, butter, and 1/3 cup broth. Bring to a boil over medium heat and simmer for 15 minutes. Pour mixture over bread crumbs, and stir in oil, eggs and 2 cups broth. Mix well. Bake in a greased 2 & 1/2-quart baking dish uncovered for 45 minutes at 375 degrees or until set and golden brown. (This dressing does better if it sits overnight in the refrigerator).

GRAVY

½ stick margarine

1/4 cup flour

½ teaspoon salt

- 1 teaspoon black pepper
- 2 cans cream of chicken soup

½ can water

Melt margarine in a heavy skillet. Add flour, salt and pepper and brown the flour slowly. In a medium, mixing bowl, combine soups and water and stir until well mixed. Add to flour mixture and cook slowly until right consistency. (May add 1 teaspoon dried parsley, if desired).

FROSTING:

- 4 egg yolks
- 1 can evaporated milk
- 1 & ½ teaspoons vanilla flavoring
- 1 & ½ cups sugar
- 1 & ½ sticks margarine
- 7 ounces coconut
- 1 & ½ cups chopped pecans

Beat egg yolks, milk and vanilla in a large saucepan with a wire whisk until blended. Add sugar and margarine and cook on medium heat until thickened and golden brown. Remove from heat. Add coconut and nuts and mix well. Cool to desired consistency before frosting cake. Makes about 4 & ½ cups of frosting, enough to frost three layers. 🖳

Ruethemann succeeds Riley as LMLPA head

The Logan Martin Lake Protection Association is under new leadership.

"I've enjoyed my time serving as president, but decided to step down and make way for fresh leadership," LMLPA past president Mike Riley said.

In July, the LMLPA elected then-vice president Linda Ruethemann to the position.

"I retired from BellSouth/AT&T as director of labor relations, moved to the area in 2002 and became a member of LMLPA," Ruethemann said.

By 2004, she was certified as an LMLPA water quality monitor. This year she became a certified water quality

trainer.

"I have been a member of the LMLPA board since 2011 and served as vice president during the 2013-14 term," she said. "Mike Riley and I worked together during our professional careers, and we find working together for a smooth transition quite easy."

Riley joined the LMLPA in 2009 after retiring from BellSouth/AT&T in 2008.

"I was elected vice president in 2010 and president in 2011," he said. "My number one goal was to make the LMLPA more relevant in the area as a protector and advocate of Logan Martin Lake. I promoted LMLPA every

chance I had, and it didn't matter where. Most people had either never heard of LMLPA or thought it was a government agency."

Riley said LMLPA became more involved in the community at large, including partnerships with Logan Martin LakeFest, the annual lake cleanup, manning booths and attending different special events, giving presentations to various civic organizations, implementing monofilament recycling, continuing support of the St. Clair Water Festival, alerting the City of Pell City about the direct effects of having Canada geese in the city park and the issue of what to do about controlling the population of those birds, contesting the removal of Logan Martin Lake as an endangered impoundment with the Alabama Department of Environmental Management (which LMLPA achieved), involvement in the Alabama Power Company relicensing of the lake, modernizing the website and placing LMLPA on Facebook and Twitter and working with various local and government entities on issues such as the water dispute with Georgia and other things that impact the lake.


"I'm especially proud of our recruitment efforts," Riley said. "We reached out to homeowners with property on the lake and added more than 230 new members during my time as vice president and president."

Ruethemann said much of the membership growth in the past couple of years has been on the St. Clair side of the lake.

"I would like to encourage membership growth on the Talladega side as residents there are a vital part of our lake community," she said. "Another area that I would like to concentrate on is the growth of volunteers from our membership. We have many members and potential members with time and talents that are untapped."

Riley said the LMLPA was formed in 1995 to advocate in Alabama's ongoing water dispute with Georgia, to ensure the quality of the lake water and to keep the lake clean for future generations. LMLPA meetings are open to the public and are held quarterly. For more information visit Imlpa.org.



After two years of searching, when she walked in the door she just knew this would be her place of tranquility.

"I let out a sigh, and it felt like a weight was lifted," said Dr. Yvette Hickman, author of "Fountain in the Valley."


Yvette and her husband, Alister, both have stressful jobs. Yvette is a family medicine practitioner while Al is a deputy director for the City of Birmingham. The couple has two children, Allison, 15, and Daniel, 8.

"We started looking for a lake house in 2009," she said. "We wanted a place to relax."

In 2011, they found their perfect spot on Logan Martin Lake.

"We bought the house for the lot," she said. "The house was already built, I think from the 1950s. The other places we looked at had really sloping lots, but this one is level enough for the kids to play football, kickball, catch and other games."

with gardens will often stop by and give us fresh food from their gardens."

Yvette said the family enjoys kayaking and paddle boating.

"We recently bought a pontoon boat," she said. "We take it out as a family—pack a lunch and play cards and board games. Without television and other distractions it gives us the chance to talk."

Yvette said there are no clocks at the lake house.

"We are on 'lake time' here," she said. "We sleep in when we want to and get up when we want to. This is our vacation place to go."



Dr. Hickman said the family chose the lot because of the view and the yard, which is level enough for them to enjoy games of football, kickball and catch.

The lot gently slopes to the water. Dr. Hickman said both her mom and her husband's mom are in wheelchairs, but are able to reach the pier and enjoy fishing and the lake.

Yvette said the arts—playing the flute, bird watching, sketching and writing—help her deal with the life-and-death situations that come with being a doctor.

"Most of my first book, 'Fountain in the Valley,' was written here," she said. "I can clear my thoughts here and there are no distractions. I can clear my mind and thoughts and hear my Father (God) here."

Yvette said "Fountain in the Valley" was inspired by a dream. The book is about the breaking and transformation process of humans, God's earthen vessels, into the beautiful

bride of Christ, including the spiritual journey to the humility and brokenness required to be fit for the Master's service.


"Fountain in the Valley" also includes original poetry inspired by the lake.


There is a point along the shoreline that provided Yvette with the inspiration for her poem "Shoreline."







Breathtaking views highlight this Eastland Shores home

Prospective homeowners who are fans of a 180-degree panoramic view of Logan Martin Lake and a deep lot boasting a variety of outdoor amenities can find what they're seeking in this beautiful Eastland Shores property.

This two-story home, priced at \$579,900 and located at 190 Albert Road in Lincoln, didn't originally offer the expansive view its heavily-windowed "Florida room" now provides.

"When I bought this house, you couldn't see the lake for about 30-something trees, and all of the back of the house was vinyl siding," said Sylvia Bentley, a sales executive for ERA King Real Estate Co., Inc. "If you're going to live on the lake, why wouldn't you want to see the water? So now, when you walk in, you've got a view of the water."

Bentley called the room one of her favorites within the home.

"This room is kind of a fun room for me, because this is what I like," Bentley said. "I sit here and watch TV. I sit out here, so I can see the water and have my morning coffee or whatever. I can see the pool from here."

Though the Florida Room may be breathtaking, there are plenty of gorgeous rooms to cause the eye to wander from the domineering lakefront view.

The main entrance opens up into a two-story foyer with a vaulted ceiling and a staircase to the left lined with wooden bannisters and wrought iron railing.

Entrances to each downstairs room are adorned with open archways, a look Bentley favored much better.

"We put a lot of angles and a lot of curves and a lot of archway to give the house some character," Bentley said. "There again, I was trying to get the concept of where you

walk through the front door - what a view!"

Walking straight through the foyer leads into the great room, the second area of the home that showcases a vaulted ceiling.

In the great room, a stone fireplace creeps up the left side of the wall, and on the mantle, a huge flat-screen TV stands out from the rock.

Now, working in real estate, Howard gets the same pleasure – especially when working with younger clients – in helping them pick the right home.




