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Editor's Note

A quarter century of renewing Alabama's rivers

One of the most significant annual events for the state's waterways kicks off this month for the 25th year in a row.

The Renew Our Rivers cleanup campaign is back, with more than 30 events slated across the state in 2024. This year's campaign is scheduled to kick off on March 2 on Valley Creek near Birmingham, and it will come to Logan Martin Lake and the Coosa River two weeks later.

Additional cleanups are scheduled on the Coosa River at Lay Lake, Lake Mitchell, Neely Henry Lake, and Lake Jordan and on reservoirs of the Chattahoochee, Mobile, Tallapoosa, and Dog rivers.

"For a quarter-century, our team at Alabama Power and volunteers from across the state have joined together to make a difference in helping preserve Alabama's natural beauty," said Susan Comensky, vice president of Environmental Affairs. "Renew Our Rivers, one of the nation's largest cleanup efforts, helps protect water quality along some of our state's most vital rivers, lakes and streams."

Since the first cleanup along the Coosa River in Gadsden in 2000, nearly 98,000 Renew Our Rivers volunteers have removed more than 13 million pounds of trash from Alabama waterways. The campaign quickly grew and spread to neighboring states. Combined



with Alabama, more than 120,000 volunteers have participated in Renew Our Rivers cleanups, removing more than 16 million pounds of trash from Southeastern waterways.

It's always encouraging to see how this event brings the Logan Martin community together in a spirit of cooperation and shared purpose as local volunteers take care of their shoreline. "Through your efforts and contributions, our lake is cleaner and safer with the continued success of our lake cleanup program," said Bud Kitchin, president of the Logan Martin Lake Protection Association.

The LMLPA has taken the lead in the effort over the years and will do

so again from March 16-23, when the initiative returns to local waters. For information about volunteering, you can call Kitchin at 256-239-0242.

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WHAT'S THE BEST BAIT TO USE FOR MARCH BASS FISHING?

The chatter bait – a relatively new bait to the bass fishing world – has dominated bass fishing tournaments during the past 10 years. It's actually been around for decades, and like other lures, when it caught steam, it moved forward with full force.

Known for its versatility, the chatter bait can be used in many applications and settings. My favorite time to use it is early March, a pre-spawn time for largemouth and spotted bass. Use a chatter bait, and you'll catch big bass.

In early March, I target places where bass are congregating close to spawning areas. On river systems such as the Coosa, bass will feed heavily in current areas close to spawning grounds. These areas will be typical current breaks for the spotted bass and large expansive flats for the largemouth. Don't be fooled – you can catch both species in each of these areas.

The chatter bait is effective because it can slowly be retrieved in these areas. The bright flash of the blade will allow the bass to feel the thumping vibration and can result in some awesome strikes. The flats often host rock piles, lay-downs, and isolated targets, all of which are great for shallow pre-spawning largemouth. The current breaks on

the main river will provide slack water and feeding opportunities for aggressive spotted bass, also a great target for throwing the chatter bait.

My chatter bait of choice is a white or shad-colored Jackhammer in $\frac{3}{8}$ -ounce or $\frac{1}{2}$ -ounce. Pair this with any fluke or paddle style trailer. I opt for the paddle tail in murkier water and the fluke in cleaner water. Typically, the dirtier the water, the slower the retrieve. This presentation is also great for crawling the bait on the bottom, maintaining contact with targets such as rock and wood.

Don't shy on the reel-and-rod setup. I use a medium heavy rod with a good tip paired

with a good bait cast reel and 17-20-pound line. The heavier line will allow you to wrestle the big bass up and get them in the net.

If you'd like to give a chatter bait a try, ask for it at Logan Martin and Coosa River area tackle retailers.

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It's time for The Great Grown-Up Spelling Bee!

Fun event addresses a
serious concern in
lakeside communities

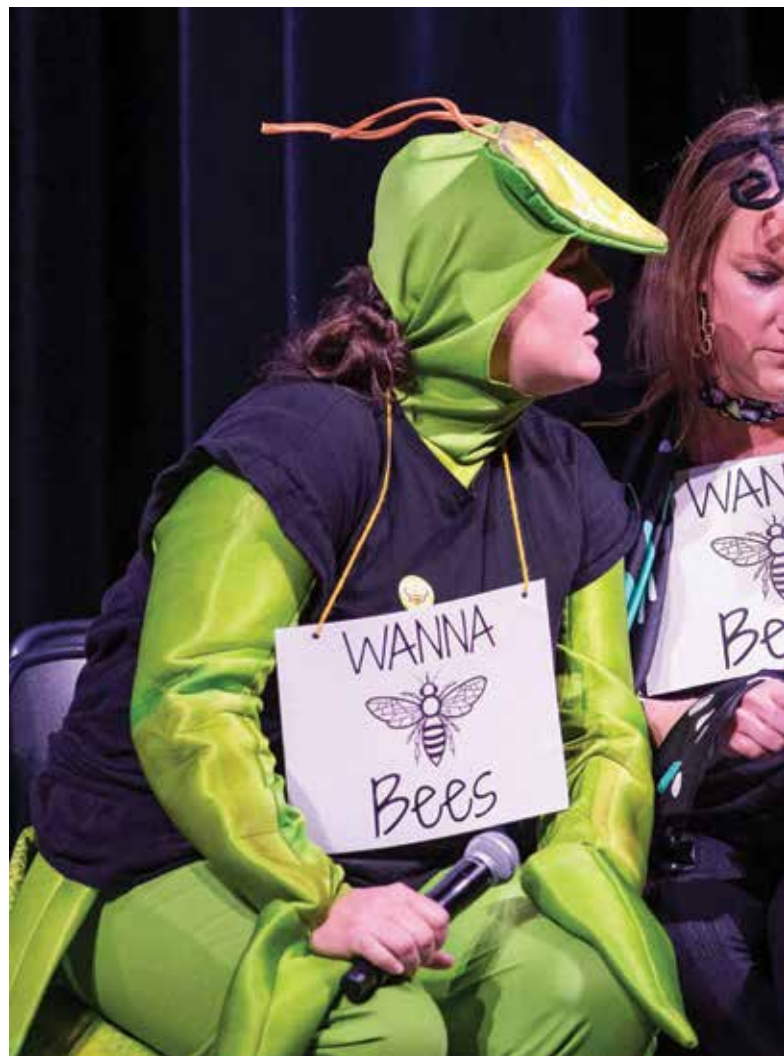

St. Clair County is abuzz as several adults prepare for the annual tradition of the St. Clair Literacy Council's Great Grown-up Spelling Bee. While the event may seem like a typical, fun community activity, the event has a much deeper meaning to those involved.

The literacy council is an organization dedicated to teaching adults who never moved past a first-grade reading level how to read and write. The spelling bee is the council's annual fundraiser, playing a significant role in accomplishing that mission. The 2024 Great Grown-up Spelling Bee starts at 7 p.m. on Tuesday, March 12 and is free to the public.

Ron DeThomas has been with the St. Clair County Literacy Council for five years now, and he praised the event and its participants in their support for the cause.

The spelling bee involves a maximum number of 15 three-member teams. The event is held at the CEPA (Center for Education and Performing Arts) Center in Pell City, and DeThomas said participation has grown considerably over the

years. Participants include medical professionals, lawyers, educators, and others who just want to take part in some fun and friendly competition, though according to DeThomas, teams take the spelling bee very seriously.

"When I first started, I thought about this as just a lighthearted thing where people get together and it's no big deal, but you don't even grin when you talk about the spelling bee around these people," he said, laughing. "It is serious with them, but they do enjoy the evening."

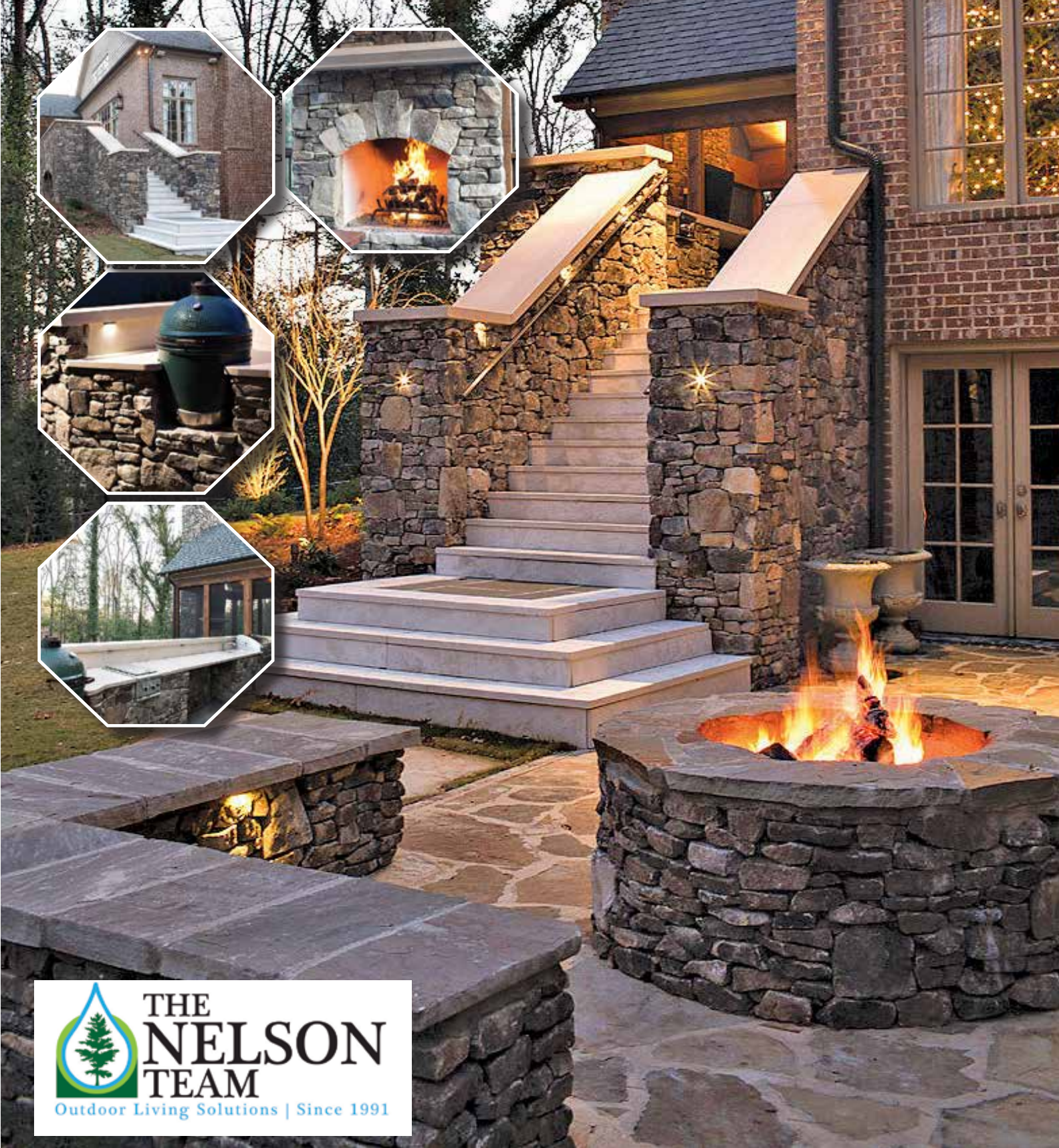
Words are chosen by the National Spelling Bee Foundation according to traditional spelling bee rules. St. Clair County educator Walter Kennedy is the designated Wordmaster who calls the words for the teams to spell, and DeThomas said nobody has access to the list of

words ahead of time, so preparation is not really possible.

"There's no list passed around so people know how to spell them ahead of time. They keep you on your toes. There's no error in this where people have foreknowledge of the words. It's a controlled thing."

While the event's mission is a serious, that doesn't mean the spelling bee participants don't have fun with it. Often teams have dressed up in costume, and there are door prizes given out throughout the evening, including a dinner for two from local restaurants and gift cards from local shops.

Local corporations donate \$500 or more to the fundraiser in special sponsorships. This is the first year Alabama Power has taken part in



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becoming a sponsor. DeThomas said the sponsorship has increased over the course of the past few years, which has helped aid the Literacy Council's mission. Last year, the fundraiser managed to raise more than \$7,000.

Lakeside Hospice's team, the Lakeside Bee-lievers, won in 2023 and back in 2019. Tracy Whitten is one of the Bee-lievers. Her fellow team members are Francis Garrett and Dr. James Tuck, Lakeside Hospice's medical director. Whitten said the Council does a phenomenal job putting the event on every year.

"We just love it," she said. "It's needed. It's a wonderful fundraiser. I'm very passionate about people who can't read and write, and I'm very passionate about that being carried through so they can get the help they need. It's fun to come together and take part in it every year."



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Whitten stressed the importance of events like the Great Grown-up Spelling Bee in furthering the progress of the council's mission to increase literacy.

"I think it is very much needed," she said. "If it wasn't for that event, I don't know if some people would be able to have what they need as far as resources to help them learn to read and write."

DeThomas said that St. Clair County alone has a rate of 22 percent of adults that read at a first grade level. Both DeThomas and Whitten are aware of the hindrances of illiteracy in everyday life.

"There are people who can't read a menu at a restaurant or read road signs – just things people take for granted but make such a huge difference," Whitten said. "Knowing that there are people out there that if they could learn to read, they could do stuff for themselves that they can't do without that skill. I love reading, and it's so sad to me there are people out there that can't. If it wasn't for the literacy council they wouldn't possibly be able to do that."

Whitten said she encourages anyone and everyone to help sponsor the event and the Council.

"I always say to put yourself in someone else's shoes," she said. "What if you couldn't read or had somebody in your family who couldn't read and you couldn't afford to have that taken care of? What if this was your parent or your child? It really does make a difference."

DeThomas echoed Whitten's encouragement for people to get involved. He said all donations are welcome, and any donation makes a tangible difference in someone's life.

"You're really having an input in society and doing something for people that can tangibly help them. It's just a real important thing that we need to get Alabama behind."

As I make my way through the pre-show dinner set up for Karen Knotts' one-woman show, "Tied Up In Knotts," I hear a question being asked at every table.

"What's your favorite episode?"

I'm part of a sold-out crowd at Hamilton Place at Pursell Farms waiting to hear Karen Knotts share a few behind-the-scene secrets to growing up as the daughter of the iconic Don Knotts, who played the forever memorable (and nervous) character of Barney Fife on "The Andy

Griffith Show."

The last time I visited Pursell Farms was in late summer, when I attended their annual Tomato Taste dinner and ate my weight in delicious tomatoes. Although you can stay overnight at Pursell Farms, it's not necessary to enjoy their exciting rotation of special events, concerts, and entertainment, which range from specialty dinners to clay shooting on their world-class ORVIS® shooting grounds. Located in south Talladega County near Logan Martin Lake and Coosa River communities, Pursell Farms is a hidden gem, making it an ideal place to escape.

On this Saturday evening, the escape is to Mayberry, to a simpler time, to enjoy the comedy and legacy of a bygone era.

Seating at the large round tables isn't assigned, which means everyone has to introduce themselves and get to know their dinner neighbors. Conversation and laughter echo to the rafters, and I can't help but feel like the citizens of Mayberry would be proud of this friendly environment where no one is a stranger for long.

Seated at one of the few remaining tables, I discover that the couple to my right is from Auburn, celebrating their wedding anniversary, while the couple to my left is from Hoover. In between mouthfuls of fried chicken and catfish paired with smoky pintos, fried green tomatoes, collard greens, and cornbread, we swap stories while behind-the-scenes footage of "The Andy Griffith Show" plays on the stage's big screen.

Once the introductions are over, it doesn't take long for the conversation to turn to the inevitable question: "So what's your favorite episode?"

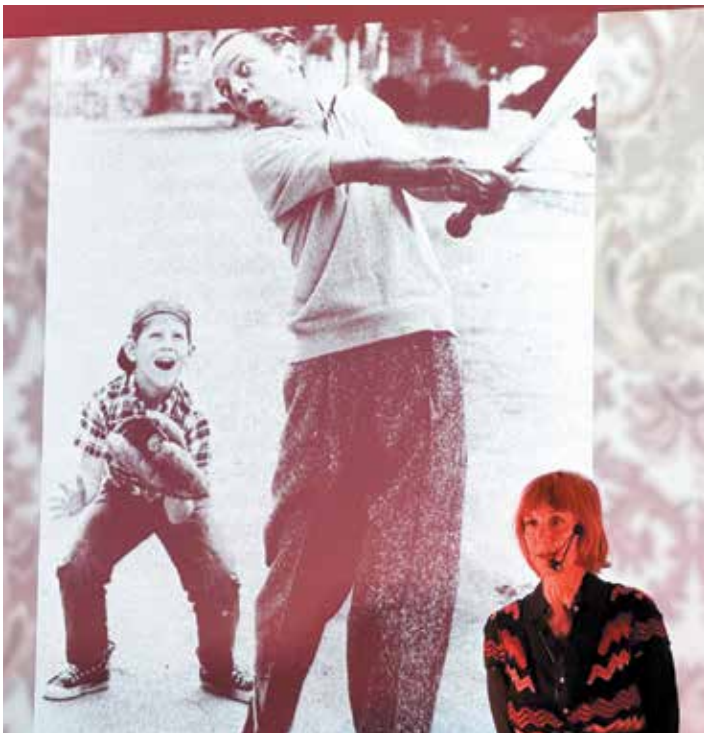

The couple to my left share that their favorite is the one where Barney and Floyd get held hostage by three desperate female escaped convicts. Barney eventually devises a plan to tango with the gang's leader Maude out the front door into Andy's waiting handcuffs.

I share my favorite, the one where Barney and Gomer get spooked while trying to retrieve Opie's baseball from the old Rimshaw house. The ramshackle house with floating axes and portraits with eyes that follow you around the room is later revealed to be a coverup operation for a still and bootlegging operation. Somehow, there was always a hidden still in Mayberry that needed Barney and



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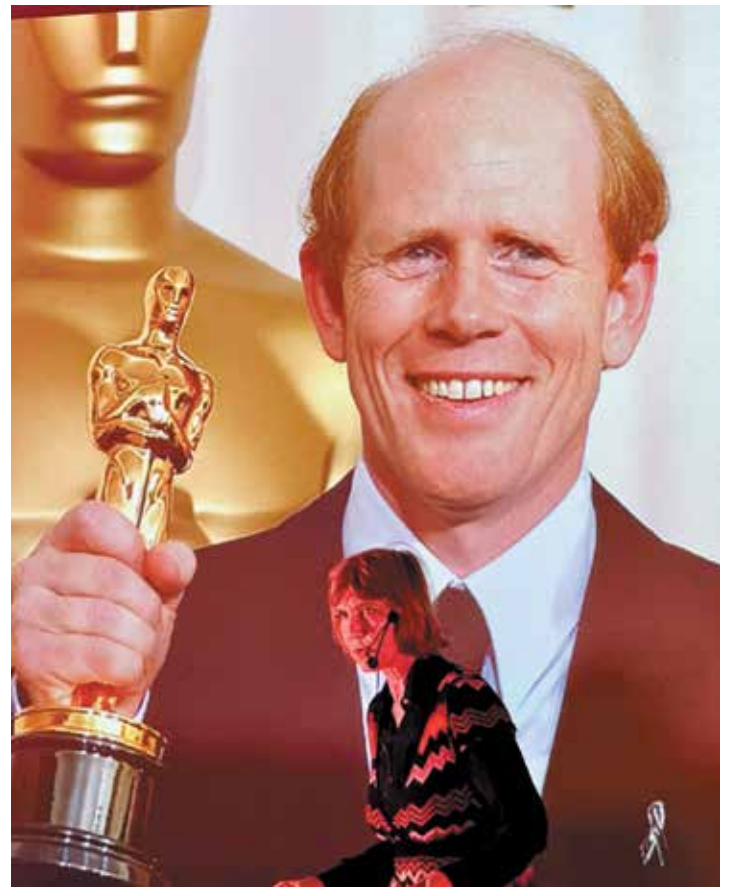
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Andy to take an axe and go “pow, pow, pow.”

As the stories continue around the table, one theme I notice these favorite episodes all share is an appreciation for the comedic talents of Don Knotts. There’s not an episode brought up that doesn’t have Barney Fife at its center. While Mayberry and “The Andy Griffith Show” continued on many years after Knotts left the show to pursue his film career, with hits like *The Ghost and Mr. Chicken*, *The Shakiest Gun in the West*, and *The Apple Dumpling Gang*, we all agreed that Mayberry was never quite the same without him.

Full after stuffing in a few bites of Grandma Willy’s Pound Cake Trifle for dessert, we take our places in the chairs set up in front of the stage for the performance, eager to listen to the anecdotes and stories that Karen Knotts has to share about her famous father.

The historical Birmingham Boat Show is the perfect one-stop shop for all your lake life necessities, and it offers something for the entire family to enjoy.

Despite frigid temperatures, the 2024 Birmingham Boat Show drew crowds and vendors from across the entire southeast during its recent

three-day expo at the BJCC.

Held since 1972, the annual show features an array of boats, vendors, and all-age attractions. Although it's deemed an Alabama tradition, I must admit it was my first time attending. My boyfriend Corey decided to tag along. He told me he went several times as a child and always enjoyed it.

As we discussed the event during our drive there, I had a feeling my favorite attraction



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would be the trout pond. Upon arriving at the BJCC and on our way to the exhibit hall, we struck up a conversation with Jim Eberleine, originally from Mobile. He now lives in Birmingham and says it's great to be closer to the show. "I come each year and meet up with my friends," he told us. "I try not to miss it if I can help it."

Once inside, I was astounded by how many boats and watercrafts were on display – hundreds of them, taking up two floors. "This is a lot bigger than I expected," I said to Corey. The expo displayed every type of boat a lake lover would want: fishing, sport, leisure, and jet skis.

I must also confess that my boat knowledge is at novice level, to say the least, and my visit was not with the intention of purchasing any type of watercraft. Despite not intending to buy anything, Corey and I enjoyed browsing the inventory and learning more about the boats on hand.

After making a few rounds across the exhibit hall, I spotted the famous trout pond attraction. I couldn't leave without giving it a try.

As I approached the pond, I met Dwight Emerson with Crystal Lake Fisheries.

Emerson said he and his family have been involved with the Birmingham Boat Show since its inception. "My family's farm goes several generations back. We travel all the way from Boone Township, Missouri."

Emerson said it took his family several days to make the trip from the Ozark Mountains to Birmingham for the show, bringing thousands of freshwater fish with them.

"It's a family tradition, but also a labor of love. We spawn, hatch, and raise the rainbow trout on our farm." Emerson continues to come back to the Birmingham Boat Show not only because of his family connection but to meet the people. "It's exciting to hear someone say it's their first time ever catching a fish. This is why we do what we do."

Emerson then gave me a baited fishing pole and explained the process. As I dipped my pole into the pond, the hungry rainbow trout swam in circles. One immediately took






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the bait.

Feeling the fish take the bait on my pole instantly put a smile on my face and reminded me of the many fishing trips I took with my dad. Emerson said guests are allowed to take home what they catch. "Many people tell me they are going to have them for dinner that night." A tempting offer, but I declined.

While I was fishing at the trout pond, I met and spoke with Bryson Mullins from Cullman. "I'm on my school's fishing team," he said. "The trout pond is my favorite part of the show for sure. It's really fun."

Several professional wakeboarders and boat racers were on hand to meet guests. I was most impressed by World Wake Association National and World Champion Kane Ward. Not yet a teenager, Kane has already made a name for himself in the sport.

"I learned how to wakeboard at about two or three years old," he said. "I love it and learning new tricks." A Cullman native,

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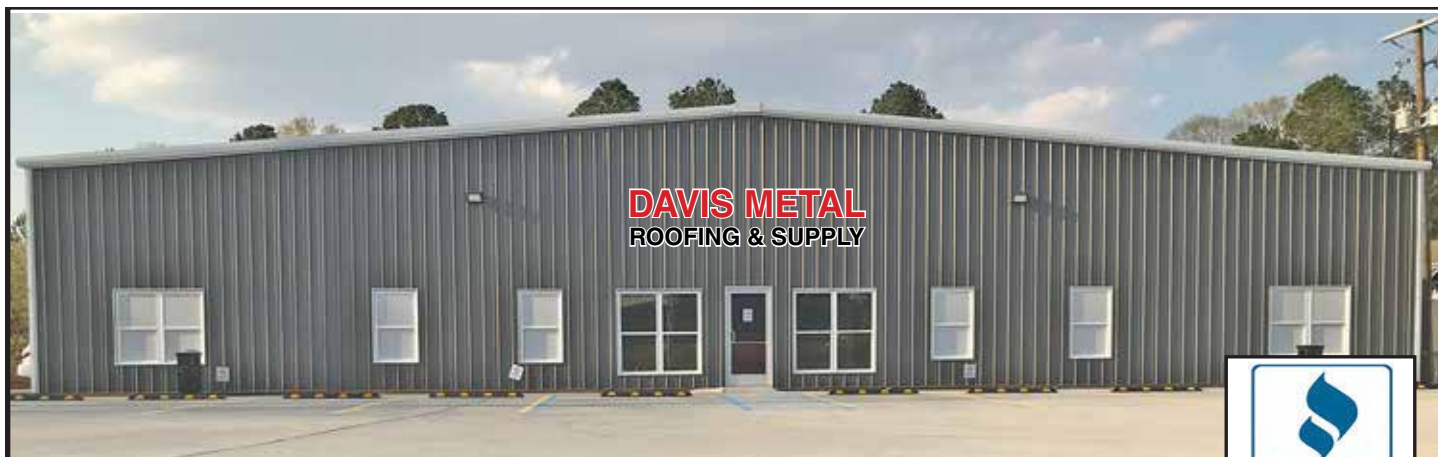
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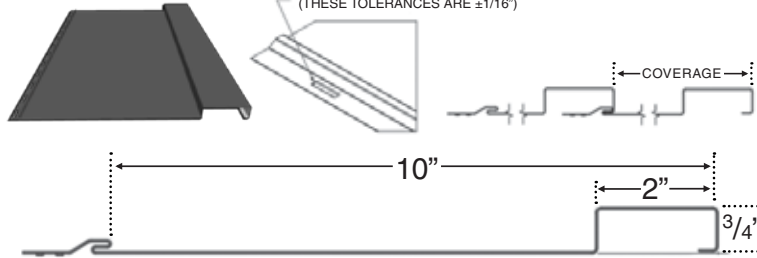




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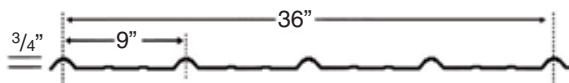

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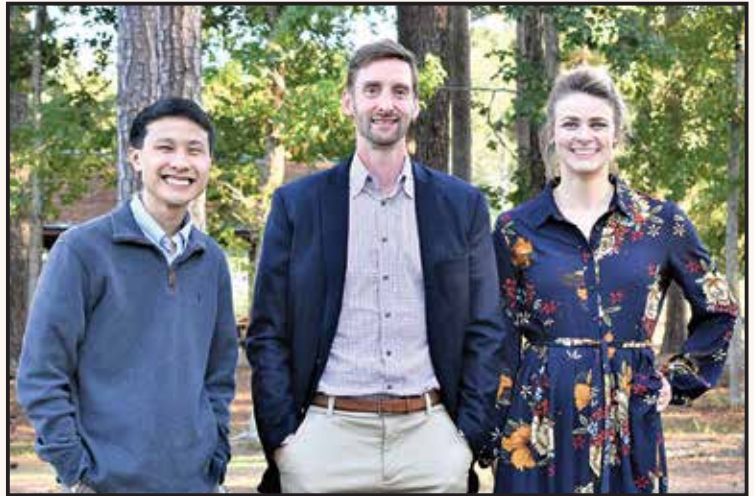
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Letting the good times roll to benefit Talladega's Ritz Theatre

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Lakeside Flora & Fauna

Dissolving into rest like an American White Pelican

Pelecanus erythrorhynchos means red-billed pelican.

After looking it up on my phone, I am learning the Latin scientific name of the bird. A pod of pelicans with pristine white plumage swims in the shallow waters of the lake. I gaze across and observe their long, heavy reddish-orange bills that pull back their necks into graceful curves. The bony protrusion (called the flattened horn or caruncle) on the end of

its bill only enhances its distinctive beauty. It serves to attract an ideal breeding mate. More intriguing than the caruncle being a display of fertility is how these pelicans collaborate and yet steal from each other in their foraging habits.

To satisfy their piscivorous diet, these birds dabble and upend in the water: they eat rough fish, crustaceans, and salamanders. This oversized duck-like behavior that corrals the fish instills a sense of collaboration among these large thick-bodied waterfowl. Considering their food-thieving finesse, these pelicans still engage in

kleptoparasitism, a behavior where they steal prey from other birds.

Unlike their brown cousins who dive to catch prey, the American White Pelicans dip their bills into the water. They scoop up their prey. In the swoop of their movements, they tilt their heads to squish their lower bills that have distensible gular pouches. These pouches can hold up to three gallons. They squeeze the water out through the sides of the bill against their breasts. Then, the aquatic bird gulps its catch into its gullet.

The motion of squeezing the water from its gular pouch has inspired the

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belief about the American White Pelican. It is said that it pierces its own breast with its bill and feeds its young of its blood, thus paralleling the sacrifice of Christ. This and the glorious whiteness of its plumage convey a message of purity. I ponder the feeding habits of this rough-billed waterbird, especially how squeezing the water out reminds me of cleansing rituals that involve water.

The sounds of flapping pull my eyes back. I see the graceful soaring of the white flock, which has black trailing edges on its wings: similar to, but not like, those of the wood storks. The squadron of American White Pelicans, among the largest and longest birds that have a nine-foot wingspan, glide into the V formation as they soar over my head. They ponderously wheel and circle against the sky, their heavy, long distinctive-beaked profiles starkly prehistoric. The Psalmic words of "I am like a pelican of the wilderness" come to mind as I feel, rather than watch, the slow, methodical flapping of the wings. I listen to their flat croaks and quacks.

I tip my head back and look at the V formation flying away. The cumulus clouds, shaped like white cotton balls, gradually absorb the golden sunset hues: pinks, lavenders, and oranges. Something feels freeing as its quietness envelopes me. The stress from the past weeks melts away like cotton candy in water, and the tension leaves my shoulders.

Before turning away from the view of the lake, I spot more whiteness. It still bespeckles the communal foraging spot of the American White Pelicans. Those who choose to remain behind seem to tuck away even more of themselves. They stand on their feet at only four feet tall. Their caruncled bills slide down to the side of their thick bodies. These large soaring birds fall asleep.

I walk across the wooden planks of the deck with a smile on my lips. I let myself inside and forage for some items: shrimp and cocktail sauce, a glass of white, and a book. Then, I settle in for the night.

Prior to moving to Lake Logan Martin, the Yoders



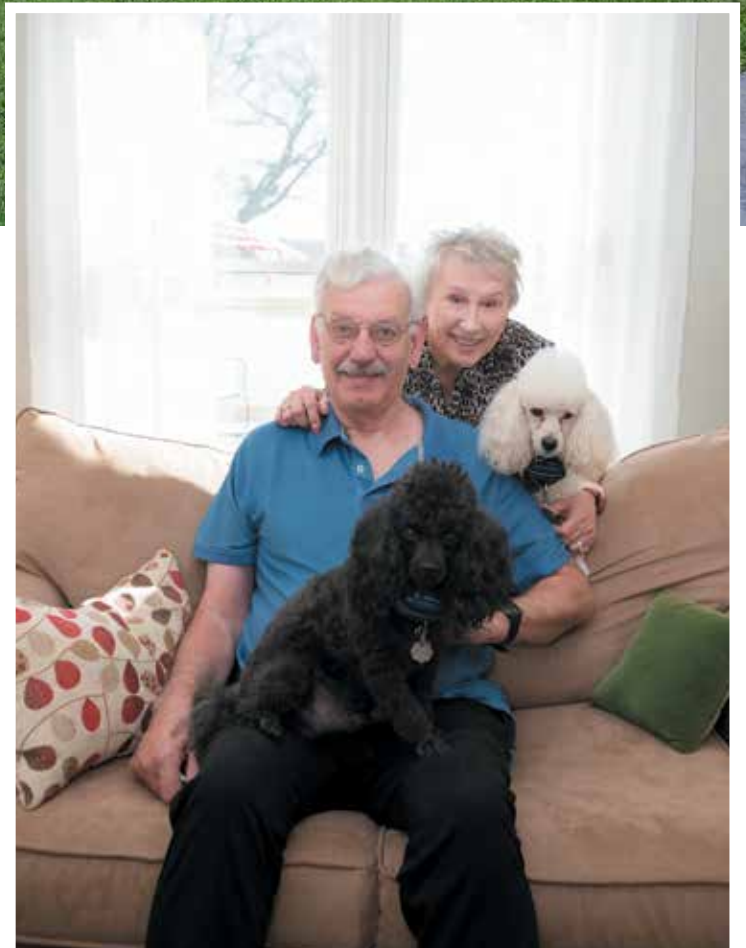

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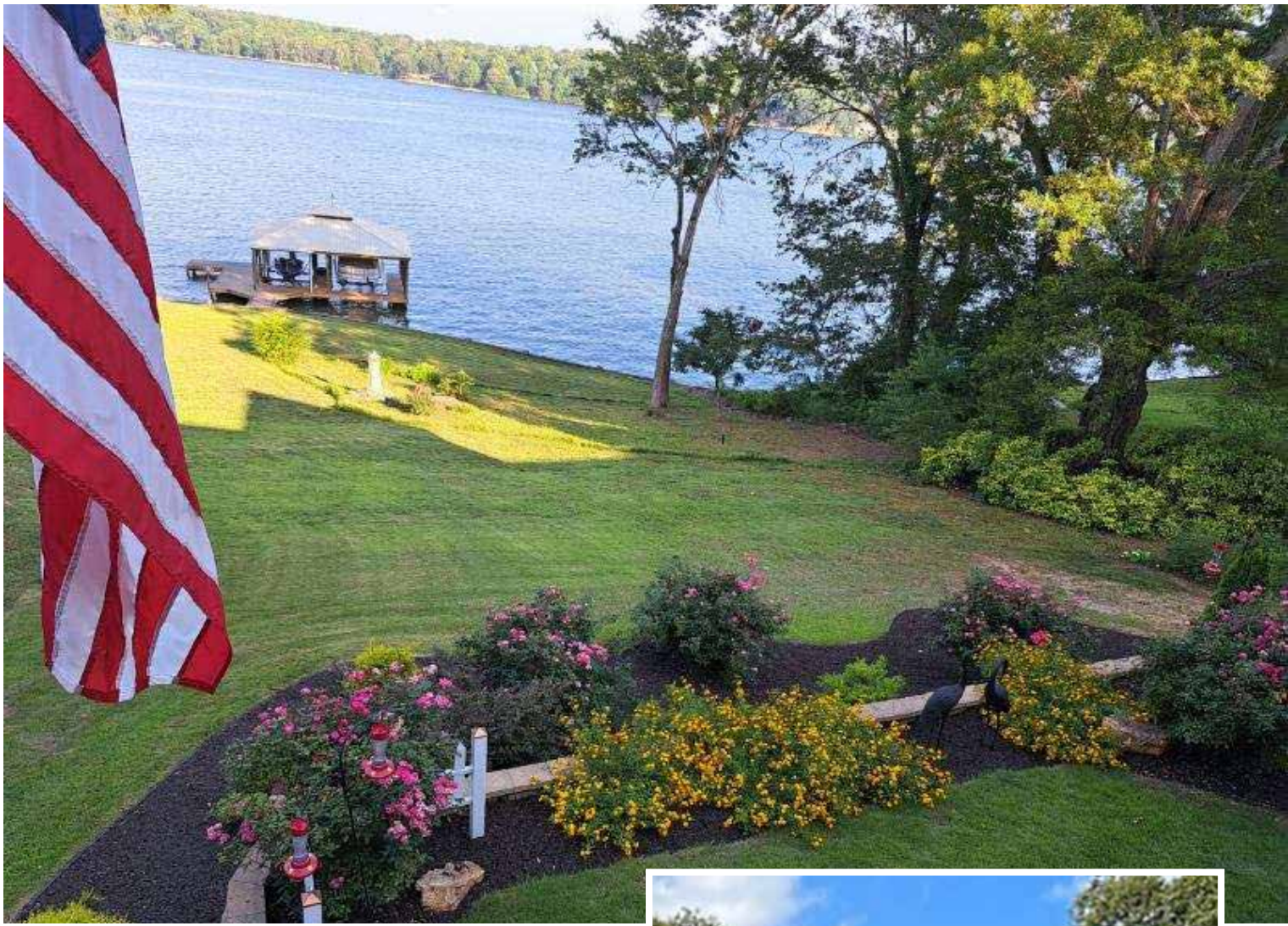
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the house.

"We both love to do yard work. We have about an acre and a half here," said Yoder, "A couple of years ago, we built a little arbor with some



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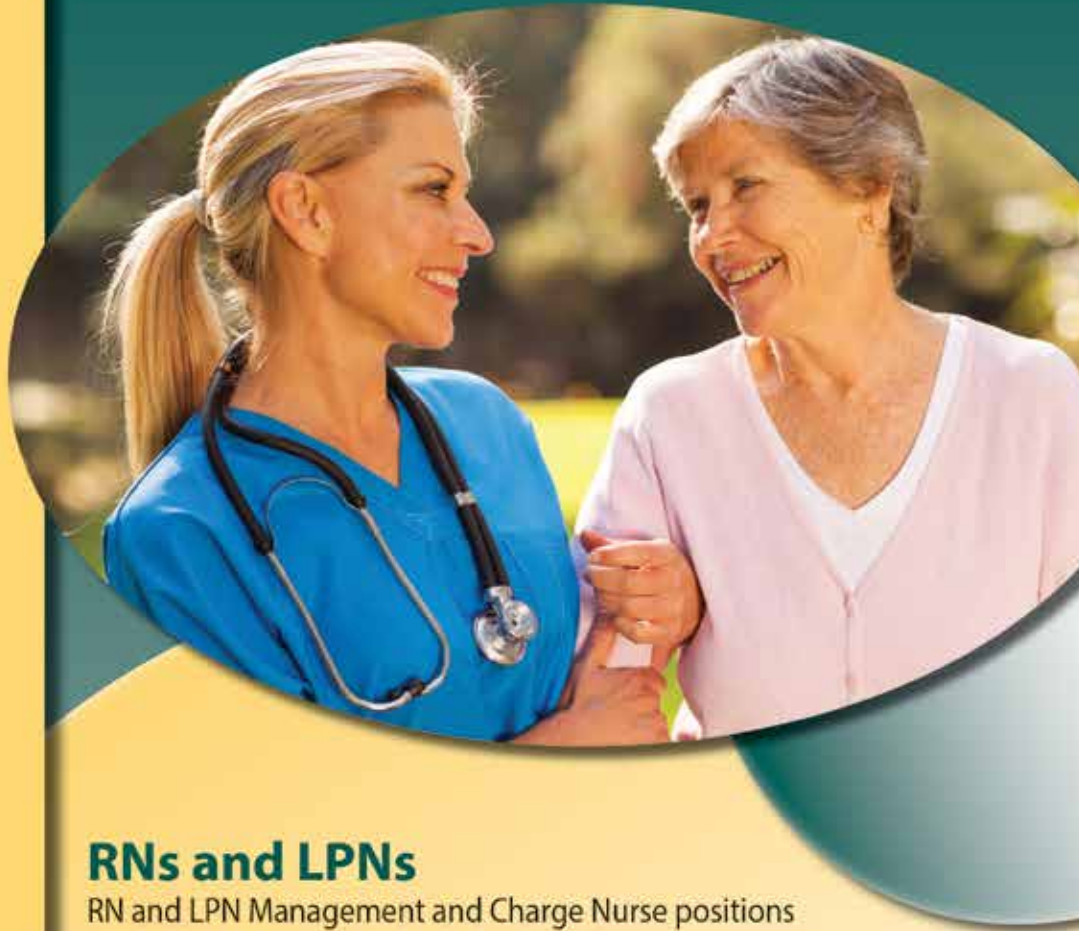


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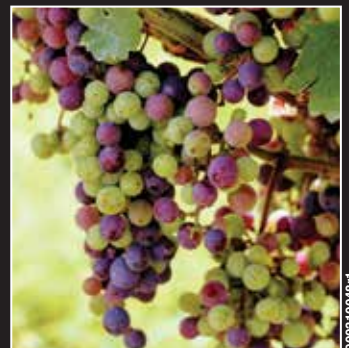

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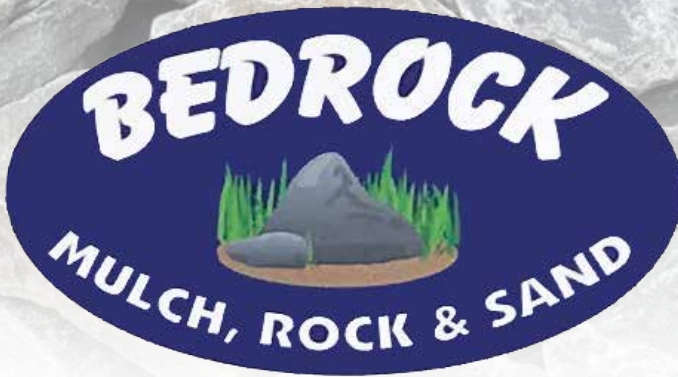
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plantings around it over part of our driveway. There are some blue birds up there. The arbor is near the flowers and blueberry bushes, so they like that."

If you see the Yoders out in their golf cart, give them a wave, but this don't ask about buying their home. This time, they're really not selling.

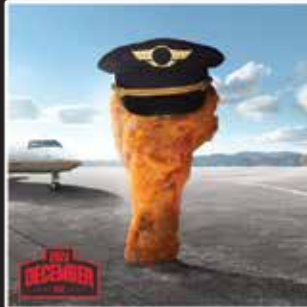
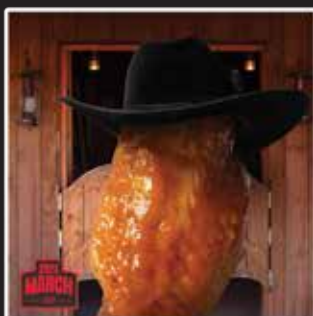

Adam Bain discovered his calling early in his life. "I have always had interest in real estate as a career," he said. "I was influenced by the late former mayor and real estate agent Lawrence Fields, who passed away about a year ago.
