





A lesson learned from a lakeside reptile

“You wanna see something cool?” Meagan Freeman asked me as we were talking on a dock one recent morning. “Look behind you.”

In that direction, submerged in shallow Logan Martin water, was a fine specimen of a turtle taking a leisurely walk along the lakebed. As he disappeared under the dock - after I’d agreed with Meagan that it was indeed something cool - I remembered an old story I once heard from a talented Native American raconteur named Robert Newman, who told the legends he’d learned from his grandfather, a Spanish-American War veteran who was of Cherokee and Apache descent.

This story told the origin of the turtle, which many, many years ago was a huge, bullying animal with the strength of 20 humans. One day while walking through the great outdoors, he crossed paths with a wolf that refused to get out of his way. A fight ensued, with the turtle prevailing because the wolf couldn’t bite through his shell.

The turtle severed the dead canine’s ears and proceeded on his way, eventually coming to an entire village of wolves, who decided that if they offered the hulking turtle food and accommodations, perhaps he wouldn’t hurt them. Their fear turned to shock and anger when the turtle began to consume the ears he’d removed from their fallen brother.

So when the turtle fell asleep, the wolves started planning.

When the turtle awoke, he was alone in the village. Soon after taking his leave, he was ambushed by the entire pack of wolves, which chased him to a ravine overlooking

a river. The turtle leapt across, clinging to the cliff on the other side, but the very thing that had protected him from the first wolf - his shell - was so heavy that he couldn’t keep his grip.

Plummeting to the water below, the turtle’s shell shattered against the rocks in the river, and his bones were broken. Eventually, he managed to reassemble his shell and knit his bones back together, but he wasn’t the same as before.

He was now smaller and not as strong, and all he had to do was look at the lines on his shell showing how it had once been smashed to smithereens to remember the ill consequences of being a bully and taking advantage of others. “And that is why,” Newman concluded, emphasizing the legend’s moral lesson, “to this day, the turtle is a slow-moving, non-aggressive animal.”

It’s the only legend you’ll find in this month’s issue, although we do have plenty of great stories related to the great outdoors. Fishing Condition: This is the overall rating for the whole day, based upon our formula:

Best Time: This column lists the best time of the day when, according to our formula, fish will be biting: MORNING; EVENING.

Cold water fishing

How important is retrieve speed in cold water? Some anglers may tell you they fish just as fast in winter as they do in spring. However, most successful cold-water anglers will tell you slowing down the presentation is the best.

Biologists and experienced anglers agree bass will not normally chase a lure in water much colder than 50 degrees. An exception to this would be when bass move up to shallower water after a few warm days, and after a warm rain. As a rule of thumb, it is best to slow down your presentation during the winter months.

A grub can be one of the most effective bass lures for cold water. A 4-inch curly tail grub on a 1/4-ounce jig head can be all that is needed to catch your share of bass. Target steep, chunk-rock banks with as much as a 45-degree slope. Bass prefer these areas because they can make extreme depth changes by moving up and down the water column to feed without using much energy.

Cast to the shallow edge of the steep bank and then allow the grub to sink, raising the rod tip as the bait reaches the bottom to lift the grub up into the water column. Anglers often find success when repeating this technique until the grub is back to the boat. Bass often bite when the grub is on the fall, so be ready to set the hook.



'No doubt, he is a miracle'

David Foote overcomes cancer to return to his art

A year and a half ago, David Foote was at the top of his artistic career when he was diagnosed with cancer. His unshakable faith, his love for his craft and his tenacious girlfriend are helping him to recover and find the strength to continue wood carving.

The Pell City artist's carved birds can be found in museums, galleries and private collections in 11 countries. He is self-taught and has been carving for more than 30 years. He uses bass wood - a soft grain wood that is easy to carve and paint - to create his realistic birds. "Everything I do is by hand. I only use a knife or gouge. I still carve the way they did it a hundred years ago."

But in April of 2015, he developed a sore throat that did not respond to antibiotics. His doctor found and biopsied a tumor on his tonsil, and he was diagnosed with Stage 3 squamous cell carcinoma.

"He started chemotherapy on May 4," recalled Melodie Cox, Foote's girlfriend of three years. "He had two rounds of chemo, and on June 3, which was a Wednesday, he was so sick, I took him to the emergency room. They admitted him to the hospital, and he continued to decline. By Saturday, he was on a ventilator and in the intensive care unit. He stayed in ICU until June 29. He literally almost died."

"I had lost my white blood cell count and my body had no defense mechanism," Foote said. "My red cell count had bottomed out, so my body had quit producing blood, and my



organs started to shut down. They came in and said we probably needed to get the family together, that I probably wasn't going to make it."

"We had everybody praying for him, and no doubt, he is a miracle. God healed him," Cox said.

"I've had doctors and nurses look at me and say, 'We can't believe you are alive.' They thought I would die in the hospital," Foote said.

When he left the ICU, he talked his doctors into letting him come home to recover. "When I got home, I was so weak, I couldn't climb the stairs to my bedroom. I had to sleep on the couch," he said. Eventually he could walk with a walker inside the house, then he could walk with a cane.

"When I finally got on the cane, I could walk around in the back yard a little, but I couldn't make it up and down the hill." His shop is at the bottom of the hill in his back yard.

"Then one day I made it to the shop, and when I walked in here, I walked over to my bench. It was cluttered with things I had been working on, and I said to myself, 'I'll never be able to

do that again.' I just walked out on the porch and said, 'Lord I want to thank you for every bird I've ever carved, every place I've got to go because of my artwork, and I just want to thank you.' The Lord knows the desires of our hearts, and this fall, I was able to start back carving."

And once he started carving again, the demand for his work grew. "To be in this position again is so humbling. I am here in this shop for two reasons: the grace of God, and that woman right there," he said pointing to Cox. "She is the one who kept me alive."

Cox would go to his house every morning before work, rush over on her lunch break and return again after she finished work. "He was so groggy from pain medication, there were some things he couldn't do," she said. "I just did what he needed done, because he could not do it for himself," she said.

Foote also needed speech and swallow therapy. "I took so much radiation to my throat, and I was practically in a coma for a month," he said. "I wasn't using those muscles, and I almost lost the ability to swallow. I couldn't even swallow water. I still

have trouble swallowing. I have no saliva, and I have no ability to taste.

“But I’m doing great. I’m back carving. I still have some hurdles to get over. I still have some weight to gain, and I need some dental work.”

Foote lost 40 pounds from his tall, slender frame, and the radiation wreaked havoc on his teeth. “But because of what I’ve been through, I have a whole new perspective about carving. I feel like I have a different eye and a different vision, and a greater appreciation and understanding of what I do. I am meant to do this. I am cancer-free, and I am free to continue what God has gifted me to do.”

Lakeside artist’s work garners national, international recognition

In 2002, David Foote had the honor of representing the state of Alabama at the White House. “First Lady Laura Bush chose the theme ‘All Creatures Great and Small’ for Christmas at the White House,” he said. “She wanted all 50 state birds represented. I received a phone call from the State Arts Council, and they asked me to make an ornament for the White House Christmas tree. I got to go to the White House and view my ornament on the tree. I went to a reception, and I got to meet all the other artists and the dignitaries, so that was definitely a highlight of my art career.”

Later, his bird ornament was displayed in the Smithsonian Institute. “That was pretty cool, too.”

In 2007, he was commissioned by the state of Alabama to carve a Yellowhammer for then-Gov. Bob Riley. “It was displayed in the foyer where you go into his office. It was there when he was in office, and I got to present it to him,” Foote said. He has been commissioned by Honda and Mercedes to carve pieces to be presented as gifts to foreign executives who visit the Alabama auto production plants, and he was the resident wood carver at Homestead Hollow in Springville for many years.

“I am honored to have my work displayed in these places, but I consider my claim to fame to be the piece I carved for the National Audubon Society’s headquarters in Manhattan,” he said. Every two years, the Audubon Society commissions two artists from around the world to produce renditions of birds (usually those that have been brought back from the endangered species list) to put on display in its museum.

“That year, they picked a well-known artist from Germany who did small, sculpted porcelain figures. They also picked me, so I have a piece in the National Audubon collection in New York, and to me, that’s my claim to fame, for them to think enough of my work to display it there,” Foote said. He chose to carve the Virginia Rail, a wading bird that was dying out because of polluted waters. “The bird was almost extinct in the Sixties and Seventies because of industrial pollution running off in their habitat, but they have come back because of tighter governmental regulations.”



Logan Martin Lake residents are avid in their love for hunting, fishing and other outdoors sports, and so is Lucas Hoge.

"Your lake is a beautiful place," the Nashville-based country singer said. "I'd love to be there in Alabama fishing for bass right now."

He'd just arrived back in Music City, not long off a plane after returning from some show dates in Florida.

A rising star in the country music scene, Hoge has spent most of the past year on tour, promoting his new album and its breakout single, "Boom Boom." The upbeat love song's music video spent seven weeks in the top spot on CMT's 12-Pack Countdown.

“I’VE BEEN DOING A LOT OF DEEP SEA FISHING LATELY, ALTHOUGH I LOVE FRESHWATER FISHING,” HOGE SAID.

“It’s a fun twist on a love song,” he said. “Ben Glover wrote it, and when I heard it, I knew it was one of those songs that was too good to pass up. Everyone is always trying to find new ways to say ‘I love you,’ and this song does that. It’s just really cool and has such a good vibe to it.”

This month, Hoge is setting sail on a country music cruise to Mexico, then he’ll be in Las Vegas for a performance at Mandalay Bay. “It’s hard to say when we’ll get down there to Alabama, but I hope we’ll be playing the South and the Gulf Coast a lot (this) year.”

Although he’s not a native Southerner, he has an affinity for many aspects of Southern culture, including hunting and fishing. “I grew up in Hubbel, Nebraska, a small, small little town of 44 people right on the Kansas line, out in the middle of nowhere,” he said. “You had to drive 50 miles of dirt roads to get to our driveway. I was always working on the farm or out playing in the trees or fishing on Rose Creek. I think that’s why even now the outdoors brings a sense of home to me. As long as trees are there for me to see and fish swimming in the ponds, I’m happy. When I’m touring, I’ll stop and throw a line in every now and then if we see a good spot.”

Hoge traces his beginnings in music back to attending church in Hubbel. “I’m from a family of six, and in a small country church, we were pretty much the entire choir.” He was playing drums by age 6, “but as I got older, I realized a guitar is a heck of a lot easier to haul around.”

Earning a degree in architecture and starting his own construction company to “support my music habit,” Hoge at one time fronted three bands at the same time: the worship band Extreme Devotion, the Southern rock group Southern Cross and the country band Borderline. “I loved it so much, but I decided to move to Nashville because I didn’t want to have that ‘what if?’ factor in the back of my head my whole life. I told myself, ‘I gotta go try this, so I just loaded up my truck and left.’”



Three albums and two music awards later, he’s opened for George Jones at the Ryman Auditorium, shared the stage with Rascal Flatts, Rodney Atkins and Hank Williams Jr., written a jingle for a national commercial and had his music featured on television soundtracks.

Despite the success he’s achieved, Hoge said he believes it’s important for him to remain grounded and connected to the outdoors and fellow outdoors enthusiasts.

“I 100 percent believe that. You go to any of my shows, and you’ll see guys in camo hats and jackets and girls in boots and jeans. They want entertainers they can relate to on stage and off stage. People who love the outdoors are real, and you can’t put anything past them. You’re on stage signing about the country lifestyle but you live in a highrise apartment and have never shot a bow in your life, they’re going to know it.”



Hunting Works for Alabama - and Logan Martin

Hunting and shooting sports impact Alabama's economy by more than \$1 billion annually, according to the local co-chairman of a new partnership called Hunting Works for Alabama.

"Too many people just don't know how integral hunting and the shooting sports are to the economy," said Grant Lynch, chairman of the Talladega Superspeedway and one of four chairs of the coalition of conservation and economic organizations. "I was thrilled to join this partnership because I want people to know that hunters are responsible for thousands of jobs and thousands of acres of wildlife habitat."

As many as 535,000 sportsmen hunt in Alabama each year, Grant told an audience of state wildlife officials and business leaders during a conference at CMP Talladega Marksmanship Park. Annually, they spend as much as \$405 million on expenses related to hunting trips, based on information provided by the Congressional Sportsmen's Foundation.

According to Tim Goddard, executive director of the Alabama Wildlife Federation, CMP's presence in Talladega is a significant means through which the lakeside area contributes to those numbers.

“If you live around the lake or are visiting the lake and looking for outdoor things to do, CMP is a world-class facility, the kind of place used by people locally and from far off,” he said. “Shooting enthusiasts come in and spend time and money here, so it’s a great asset to this lakeside community.”



Lynch, an avid outdoorsman who has hunted mule deer in Montana and impala and cape buffalo in Tanzania, agreed that Logan Martin Lake and its surrounding communities offer plenty of options for hunters and shooting enthusiasts.

“There’s duck hunting and ample deer and game all around the lake,” he said. “Besides CMP, there’s Selwood, Orvis Shooting Grounds at Pursell Farms and other gun clubs. If you don’t hunt, the lake area offers golf, fishing, camping and any other activity you can enjoy doing in the outdoors.”



But according to Lynch, those who do not hunt usually don’t realize how much that particular activity impacts local and state economics.

“Hunting specifically supports thousands of jobs, both rural and urban, across the state, and our goal is to provide a unified voice for all these stakeholders,” he said. “Hunting Works for Alabama will monitor public policy decisions and weigh in on hunting-related issues that impact Alabama jobs.”

The newly-formed partnership has more than 65 members and is seeking more to help the initiative “explain the role hunting and shooting sports play in both the heritage and economic health of Alabama,”

according to Rob Sexton, Hunting Works for Alabama's coordinator.



"When we talk about hunting, it's often about heritage and family traditions, and that's fine," he said. "But economics should also be front and center. Each hunter spends an average of \$1,700 a year in Alabama, and hunter spending translates into nearly \$613 million in salaries and wages that support nearly 27,000 Alabama jobs. Hunters also pay \$104 million in state and local taxes."

Such numbers, according to Tim Wood, general manager of Central Alabama Farmer's Cooperative and another of the group's co-chairs, are often overlooked.

"Hunting and shooting sports are huge drivers of our state

economy, but I feel they don't get the credit they deserve," he said. "Much of their spending goes to local business owners and entrepreneurs. In fact, hunters spend a great deal of money at stores like Bass Pro and Cabela's, but they also shop at locally-owned sporting goods stores, hardware stores, gas stations, restaurants, hotels and cafes all across Alabama."

Lynch said Hunting Works for Alabama and its partners will be active this year at events throughout the state in its efforts to educate non-hunters and elected officials about hunting's economic impact. elsewhere. They're available in various lengths and can be equipped with whatever you want, including GPS systems, trolling motors and accessories."

All boats sold at Rodney's Marine are equipped by Suzuki motors, of which the center is an exclusive dealer. "They come with a six-year warranty, and they were the first engine to come out with four-stroke overboards. They're very quiet and fuel-efficient. We're seeing a lot of repowering with Suzuki motors, with people putting new ones on their older boats."


For Humphries, opening the marine center three and a half





in this state that Alabama doesn’t get credit for. The nice beaches and beautiful lakes – it’s a great place to live.”

The Nicholoses found their perfect lake home situated on two lots in the Grandview subdivision. “We went through the house from one end to the other, and it was set up beautifully,” Gary said. “The layout of the main floor is perfect. That’s where we spend 85 percent of our time – on the main floor and out in the gazebo.”

Their living room – with its 20-foot ceilings and full-length windows – offers “a phenomenal view of the lake,” he said. “Looking across it, you can see for at least a mile. 




