Welcome from the Race Director

"Ding!" There it was- the Facebook notification sound that I've grown accustomed to hearing periodically throughout my day. Over the next several months, the four of us spent a lot of time responding to a flood of emails, organizing volunteers, making contacts, ordering supplies, and so much more. I realized all of our hard work and dedication had been worth it when we were able to hand over more than \$10,000 to local charities including the East Central Alabama United Cerebral Palsy and the ARC Special Olympics. Kidstock1 Mile Run/Walk for Kids 14 & Under

The Kidstock 1 Mile Run/Walk will start at 8:30a.m. All participants will receive their finisher medals at the finish line. Parents are welcomed to run with their children. No Race Day Registration! Only 14-year olds and younger are eligible for Kidstock awards, we will be using DTag Timing. The following overall trophies will be awarded:1st, 2nd, 3rd Place Overall Male/Female Kidstock trophies will be given to the top three finishers, male and female, in each age category: 5-under; 6-8; 9-11; 12-14.

Kid's Corral: Registration required.

\$5.00 per child. Don't let your kids keep you from running the 5K! The Kid's Corral is available - sign in your child to our childcare volunteers before 7:15 a.m. and pick them up when you finish the 5K race! Then let them run the Kidstock 1 Mile Run/Walk! The Kid's Corral activities will be inside the high school gym. You must check the box on the entry form to let us know you need space. The number is limited to 40 kids.

Timing/Results: Woodstock 5K and Kidstock 1 Mile

We are committed to providing the highest level of professional timing in the quickest and most accurate manner by using DTag Timing. Best Times will be managing timing and results for both the Woodstock 5K and Kidstock 1 mile. YOU MUST WEAR your timing device and race number, and cross the timing mats to be scored! Please remove your tag once you finish the 5k.

Race Shirts: Awesome, lightweight technical shirts! Unique Design!

Please plan to register early to ensure you receive a shirt. Participants waiting until after July 15th to register run the risk of not getting the desired shirt size, or maybe not getting a shirt at all as we are limiting our order to 1,400. We will do our best to accommodate all runners, but if we run out of shirts, we will not be reordering more, nor will we offer a discounted race entry fee since proceeds from our race go to charity. If you pre-register, and are unable to attend the event, please arrange for pickup as we will not be mailing shirts/race packets.

Food, Door Prizes, and Post-Race Party!

Woodstock is known for a fantastic post-race party! Join us for great music and plenty of food to enjoy after the race. Woodstock 5K Awards

Results/awards are based on Chip Time (not Gun Time). Overall winners will not be eligible for Age-Group awards. Team participants will still be eligible for Overall, Age-Group, and/or Clydesdale/Athena awards. If you sign up for the Clydesdale or Athena division, you will be eligible for Overall awards, but not eligible for Age-Group awards.

Clydesdale and Athena Divisions

Medals will be given to the top three finishers in these divisions, but runners must check the appropriate box during registration to be entered in these divisions. Weigh in may be required at finish of the race at the discretion of the Race Director.

If you register for the Clydesdale or Athena division, you will be eligible for Overall and/or Team awards, but you will NOT be eligible for Age-Group awards. *Clydesdale division- Male 225+ pounds Athena division- Female 160+ pounds*

Team Challenges and Awards

TEAM WITH THE MOST PARTICIPANTS (NON-CORPORATE)

Non corporate teams are defined as teams where the entry fee/registration fee of each team member is paid for by the individual team member. These teams will be eligible for the \$750 cash prize!

TEAM WITH THE MOST PARTICIPANTS (CORPORATE)

A corporate team is defined as a team where the entry fee/registration fee of each team member is paid for by the team's employer and/or corporate sponsor. If one of more team member's registration fee is paid for by a employer and/or sponsor, the entire team will be considered a corporate team.

Corporate teams will NOT be eligible for the \$750 cash prize. However, the corporate team with the most participants will receive team trophy.

THE HISTORY OF SUNNY KING AUTOMOTIVE

The Sunny King dealerships began in Anniston in 1922 when E. D. King acquired the Ford franchise known today as Sunny King Ford.
