PERSONHOOD RESOLUTION OF UPLOAD STUDENT SCHOOL

A resolution recognizing personhood belongs exclusively to a human being, a partnership, or a corporation with rights and responsibilities under the law.

WHEREAS, the Constitutions of the United States of America and the State of Idaho recognize and protect a person's inalienable rights to life, liberty, and pursuit of happiness.

WHEREAS, the Merriam-Webster dictionary defines "personhood" as a human being, a partnership, or a corporation that is recognized by law as having rights and duties.

WHEREAS, "person" is referenced in the Idaho State Constitution 82 times. People are the only things that should have rights and responsibilities, such as property ownership.

WHEREAS, "person" is referenced in Idaho State Statutes 1,407 times. For example, section 67-3004 of Idaho Code references a person's fingerprints, which animals, the environment, nor artificial intelligence have.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the UPLOAD Students publicly declare their affirmation for a person to hold their rights and responsibilities and political participation in defense of their life, liberty, and pursuit of happiness for their own past, present, and future; and

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, UPLOAD students believe that people's rights should be protected from environmental elements, artificial intelligence, an animal, or an inanimate object, which should not have greater or equal rights than a person.
