## South Jersey Gas Pipeline - Documents Obtained through the Open Public Records Act from the Pinelands Commission

The documents were obtained by PPA from the Pinelands Commission under the Open Public Records Act (OPRA). Because the Pinelands Commission refused to produce these documents, we were compelled to file a lawsuit in Superior Court to compel production. That lawsuit led the Commission to produce the documents we provide here for public review. Note that the Commission redacted most of the content of communications with the Governor's office. There are a lot of documents here, so we may have made mistakes in the way they are titled or ordered. Please let us know if you see any errors.

We have tried to organize the documents into categories and to list them in chronological order.

### Emails Between the Pinelands Commission Senior Staff and South Jersey Gas Representatives re Editing the Intergovernmental Memorandum of Agreement (MOA):

These documents show that the Pinelands Commission staff allowed South Jersey Gas representatives to edit the MOA on multiple occasions, as early as March 2013, and that it appears South Jersey Gas may have even drafted the MOA in the first place.
