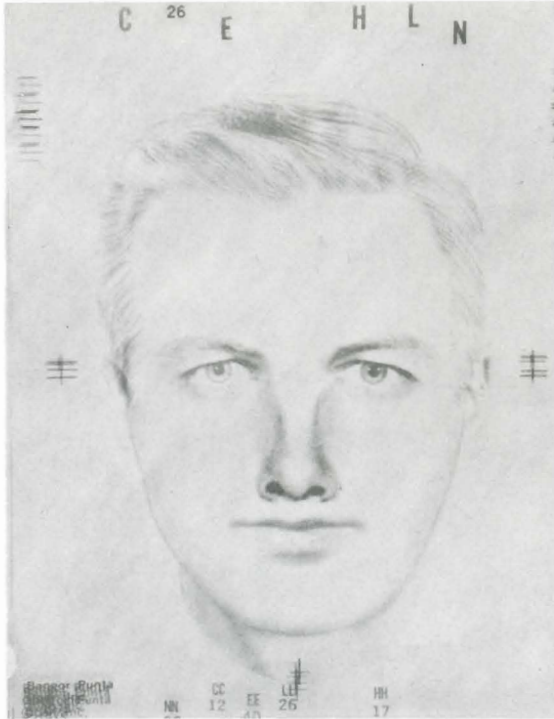


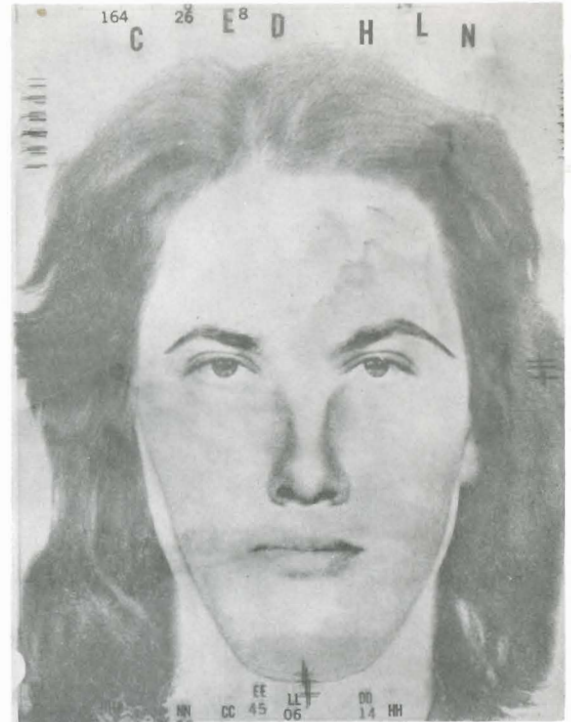

Suspect #1 - WMA, 25-35, 5'10", sandy brown hair, blue or green eyes, wearing a fatigue jacket, ruddy-reddish facial complexion.



Suspect #2 - WFA, 25-30, 5'9", 120, brown hair, olive complexion, dark eyes, slender, moderately attractive.

DOUBLE HOMICIDE:

At 1100 hours, 1-22-77, a double homicide occurred at Powell Memorial at the Grand Canyon, Grand Canyon, Arizona. The victims, Michael and Charlotte Sherman, Captain U.S.A.F., were traveling from Virginia to California. Both were shot twice in the head with a .22 caliber weapon. Robbery appeared to be the motive.

MURDER WEAPON:

A .22 caliber weapon, calculated as having the following rifling characteristics: 6 lands, and grooves, right hand twist, land with approximately 2/3 the groove width. Weapons known to have these characteristics are: Iver Johnson handguns, Ruger handguns, Harrington & Richardson handguns, Winchester rifles and Charter Arms handguns. Three of the four bullets recovered from the victims are suitable for comparison with suspect weapons.

SUSPECT VEHICLE:

A light tan, creme or off-white station wagon. Possibly a 1969 Ford Fairlane or Galaxie, a 1970 Rambler or 1963 Chevy Impala. A bungee cord type luggage rack or ski rack.
