

Hearing loss affects more than you think or unique characteristics of sound and hearing.

Sound is measured by intensity and pitch. Intensity is the loudness of sound measured in decibels, whereas pitch is measured in frequency of sound vibrations per second. In the early stages of hearing loss, higher frequencies are typically the first to be impacted. Due to this, difficulty hearing the high-pitched voices of women and children is one of the first noticeable symptoms. Hearing is one of the most important social senses. Your hearing is how you connect with the most important people in your life. Experiencing sound voids can cause you to miss out on important relationships and shared experiences.

Gradual hearing loss and the perception of sound voids are common conditions that often

result from years of chronic exposure to loud noise. Hearing is a critical part of your personal safety and early warning system. Your hearing is unique in that it can process sound in the background without you concentrating on the source that produces it. If you are experiencing the perception of sound voids, you may be missing important signs of danger or opportunity.

Hearing also enhances the performance of your other senses. Anyone experiencing the perception of sound voids may also have issues with their other senses not working as well as they should. Lastly, hearing is an important part of your personal learning system. It provides critical supplemental

information and aids retention. Those experiencing sound voids may not be learning new things as quickly, easily, or completely. In the United States, approximately one-third of individuals over 60 years of age, and one-half of those over 85, have some degree of hearing loss.
