What Are My Rights in a Child Protective Services Investigation?

- You have the right to know the details of the allegation made against you
- You have the right to speak with an attorney before speaking with CPS
- You have the right to refuse CPS entrance to your home without a court order
- You have the right to keep your immigration status private
- You have the right to an interpreter if one is needed
- You have the right to refuse mental health or drug test evaluation without a court order
- You have the right to refuse to have CPS question your children without a court order
- You have the right to refuse services recommended by CPS
