### **INDICTMENT**

SEXUAL ABUSE (Counts 1-2) Title 18 U.S.C. §§ 1153(a) and 2242(2)(B) (Penalty: Life imprisonment, \$250,000 fine, and at least five years of supervised release)

ATTEMPTED SEXUAL ABUSE (Count 3)
Title 18 U.S.C. §§ 1153(a) and 2242(2)(B)

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

## COUNT 1

That in or about December of 2013, at or near Lame Deer, in Rosebud County, in the State and District of Montana and within the exterior boundaries of the Northern Cheyenne Indian Reservation, being Indian Country, the defendant, DEAN ALLEN WALLOWING BULL, knowingly engaged in a sexual act with John Doe 1, knowing at the time John Doe 1 was physically incapable of declining participation in, or communicating willingness to engage in, the sexual act, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1153 and 2242(2)(B).

# **COUNT 2**

That in or about January of 2021, at or near Lame Deer, in Rosebud County, in the State and District of Montana and within the exterior boundaries of the Northern Cheyenne Indian Reservation, being Indian Country, the defendant, DEAN ALLEN WALLOWING BULL, knowingly engaged in a sexual act with John Doe 2, knowing at the time John Doe 2 was physically incapable of declining participation in, or communicating willingness to engage in, the sexual act, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1153 and 2242(2)(B).

### COUNT 3

That in or about 2008 or 2009, at or near Lame Deer, in Rosebud County, in the State and District of Montana and within the exterior boundaries of the Northern Cheyenne Indian Reservation, being Indian Country, the defendant,

DEAN ALLEN WALLOWING BULL, knowingly attempted to engage in a sexual act with John Doe 3, knowing at the time John Doe 3 was physically incapable of declining participation in, or communicating willingness to engage in, the sexual act, and took a substantial step toward the completion of that offense, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1153 and 2242(2)(B).
