## NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING October 10, 2018

On September 13, 2018, BEK Communications Cooperative (BEK) filed an Application for designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) as a non-incumbent local exchange carrier for the purpose of receiving Federal Communications Commission's Connect America Fund Phase II funding in Federal Communications Commission (FCC) specified census blocks in rural areas of North Dakota. The FCC requires that BEK be designated as an ETC by February 26, 2019.

The issues to be considered in this matter are:

1. Is the applicant qualified under the Telecommunications Act of 1996, Section 214(e) for designation as an ETC eligible to receive federal universal service funding?
2. What ETC universal service support area should be designated?
3. Is designation of the applicant as an ETC in the public interest?

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. Comments and requests for hearings must be received by November 21, 2018. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a formal hearing.

The Mandan Hidatsa Arikara Nation (The Tribe) will receive sealed statements of qualifications until **4:00 P.M. on Wednesday October 24th, 2018** for Construction Management Services to construct a new 7,000 square foot White Shield Elder Center, at which time and place the acceptance of proposals will be closed and all proposals then received will be opened, and the identity of the proposers recorded. The Tribe will not consider proposals received after closing. The content of the proposals submitted will remain confidential in nature until an award has been made to the selection firm.

The Tribe recognizes the need for a new facility for the Elders of the White Shield community. The Tribe understands that the Elders are a valuable resource and need a place to gather and socialize.
