

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT RECLAMATION ACTIVITIES

PLEASE take notice that BNI Coal Ltd., 2360 35th Avenue SW, Center, North Dakota 58530-9499 has submitted applications to the North Dakota Public Service Commission for Permit Renewal No. 7 to BNCR-8106 to engage in surface coal mining and reclamation operations. The area for which a permit renewal is sought includes approximately 1,169.71 acres in portions of Sections 23, 25, 35 and 36, T142N R84W and Sections 31 and 32, T142N R83W. This area is in Oliver County, North Dakota and is shown on the accompanying newspaper map and is described below. The next five-year permit term will be from July 18, 2018 to July 18, 2023.

Any person whose interests are or may be adversely affected by the proposed action has the right to file written comments, objections or request an informal conference with the North Dakota Public Service Commission. Written comments, objections, and requests for informal conferences should be filed with the Public Service Commission, Dept. 408, 600 East Boulevard, Bismarck, ND 58505-0480 within 30 days after the last publication of this notice. 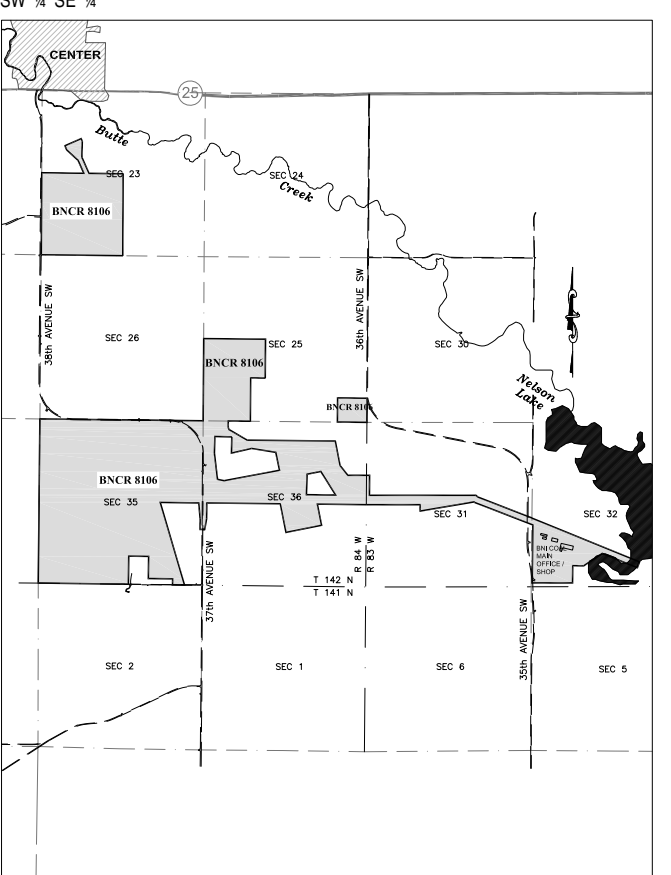
