AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

COMES NOW Detective Robert Vanuka, and being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

1. Your affiant is an officer with the Bozeman Police Department, Gallatin County, Montana.
2. On October 3rd, 2012, your affiant arrested the above-named Defendant and charged the Defendant with the crime of:

Robbery (f) 45-5-401 M.C.A.

3. The crime occurred on October 3rd, 2012.
4. The place of the crime was 1910 W. Main Street, Bozeman, Montana.
5. The facts relied upon to make the arrest and charge is as follows:

On the 3rd of October, 2012 at 0113hrs, your affiant was notified of a crime that occurred at the Loaf & Jug convenience store located 1910 W. Main Street. Your affiant was informed a male entered the store through the main doors dressed in black pants, grey jacket over a black hoodie sweatshirt, gloves and a mask. The male pointed a black handgun at the store clerk (JH) and demanded money. During the time the suspect was in the store another male entered and the suspect fled. JH called 911 and officers were dispatched to the scene. While enroute to 1910 W. Main officers observed a red SUV leaving the area through the alley at a high rate of speed. Officers attempted to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle (Montana registration 642254A) as it proceeded south through the trailer park at 2220 W. Main. The vehicle stopped adjacent to trailer #92, the driver exited the vehicle wearing a grey jacket over black hoodie and black pants. The driver ignored the officer's commands to stop and proceeded to run westbound on foot.

Responding officers pursued the suspect while other officers set up a perimeter. The male suspect was followed through the creek and into the trailer park at 2405 W. College. The suspect was taken into custody in the southeast corner of the trailer park. The suspect was identified as Shane L. Jaeger DOB: 04-11-88. Jaegers identity was later confirmed through a photograph from the Florida Department of Corrections.

K9 officers Ziegler and Moen conducted an article search along the suspect vehicles escape path from 1910 W. Main to the trailer #92 where the foot pursuit began. During this search a fingerless, knit glove was located in the alley just south of Olive. This glove matched a glove later recovered from the suspect vehicle. Officers also recovered a grey jacket near trailer #3 that matched the jacket the suspect was seen in the surveillance video from the Loaf and Jug as well as the suspect was wearing when he exited the vehicle.

Your affiant responded to the Gallatin County Detention Center to interview Jaeger. Jaeger was read his rights per Miranda and gave both written and verbal waiver to speak with me without an attorney present. Jaeger denied any involvement in the robbery, stating instead he was fishing.

A consent to search was obtained from the owner of the suspect vehicle. A black backpack, fingerless knit glove, black hat and shell casings were in plain view and recovered from the front passenger seat and center console area.

A search warrant was prepared, granted and executed on the backpack. The back pack contained a black Intratec 9MM semi automatic assault type pistol with a round chambered.

A records check revealed the suspect is an absconder from formal supervision for felony convictions from Hernando County Florida.

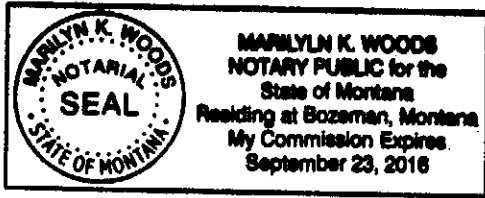
Jaeger was held at the Gallatin County Detention Center without bond for the charge of robbery because in the course of committing a theft the suspect threatened to inflict bodily injury upon a person or purposely or knowingly put a person in fear of immediate bodily injury through the use of a firearm.
