

PUBLIC NOTICE

Edon Codified Ordinances Chapter 1307

It has been determined by the Council of the Village of Edon ("Village") that weeds or plant growth, including grass, growing at a height of six inches or higher after the fifteenth day of April of each year are a public nuisance. The owner, lessee, agent, tenant or other such person having charge or care of any land, parcel or lot within the Village within 200 feet of any residential or commercial building or any public street shall maintain the premises and exterior property free from weeds or plant growth, including grass, in excess of six inches in height. The Village may cause such weeds or plant growth, including grass, in excess of six inches in height to be cut and destroyed, with the costs charged to the owner, lessee, agent, tenant or other such person having charge or care of said parcel. Fees charged shall be at a rate of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per hour, billed in hourly increments so that any portion of an hour is billed for an entire hour of work. In addition to the fee charges for abatement, the Village shall include all costs of service of notice. All statements for fees described herein shall be paid to the Fiscal Officer within thirty (30) days. If fees are not paid when due, the Fiscal Officer may certify the fees to the County Auditor for assessment against the property or take other legal action to collect all such fees. Violators may also may have complaints filed against them under section 1307.99 of the Codified Ordinances.
