

**Williams County
Notice of CDBG Public Hearing**

Williams County intends to apply to the Ohio Department of Development, Office of Community Infrastructure for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Community Development Program, a federally funded program administered by the state.

On January 13, 2026 the first public hearing was conducted to inform the citizens about programs administered by the Ohio Department of Development. Based on citizens input and an assessment of need by local officials, the County is considering the following CDBG activities for Program Year 2026 for the Residential Public Infrastructure Grant:
