

On August 17, 2026, the Council of the Village of Edon, Ohio passed the following legislation:

Ordinance No. 10-26: AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND OTHER VILLAGE OFFICIALS TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE TOLEDO-LUCAS COUNTY PORT AUTHORITY FOR THE ASSIGNMENT OF THE VILLAGE'S INTEREST UNDER AN OPTION TO PURCHASE REAL ESTATE, TO PERFORM ALL NECESSARY ACTS TO EFFECTUATE THE EXERCISE OF THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. This Ordinance authorizes and directs the Village Administrator and other officials to enter into and execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the Toledo-Lucas County Port Authority for the assignment of an option to purchase approximately 165 acres of real estate located in Florence Township, and declares an emergency. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately.
