

On June 15, 2026, the Council of the Village of Edon, Ohio passed the following legislation:

Ordinance No. 07-26: AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A CYBERSECURITY POLICY FOR THE VILLAGE OF EDON, OHIO; AUTHORIZING RELATED ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES; AND SUPERSEDING PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES, RESOLUTIONS, AND POLICIES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. This Ordinance adopts the Cybersecurity Policy for the Village, directs the Fiscal Officer to continue to ensure organizational compliance with the Policy and to promulgate administrative procedures, standards, and guidelines necessary to further implement the Policy, confirms the Policy supersedes any prior ordinances, resolutions, rules, or policies of the Village to the extent they are inconsistent with the Policy, and declares an emergency. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately.

Resolution No. 04-26: A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NECESSITY FOR AN ADDITIONAL LEVY FOR THE EDON UNION CEMETERY, REQUESTING THE WILLIAMS COUNTY AUDITOR TO CERTIFY THE TOTAL CURRENT TAX VALUATION OF THE SUBDIVISION AND THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUE TO BE GENERATED PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 5705.03(B) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. This Resolution declares the necessity for an additional levy for the Edon Union Cemetery, requests the Auditor to certify to the Council the revenue which will be produced by a one half (1/2) mill additional tax levy for purposes of maintenance and operation of Edon Union Cemetery and declares an emergency. This Resolution shall be effective immediately.
