What Are My Rights in a Child Protective Services Investigation?

You have the right to:

- Know the details of the allegation made against you
- Speak with an attorney before speaking with CPS
- Refuse CPS entrance to your home without a court order
- Keep your immigration status private
- An interpreter if one is needed
- Refuse mental health or drug test evaluation without a court order
- Refuse to have CPS question your children without a court order
- Refuse services recommended by CPS
