Real-World Impact for Patients: Higher Bills, Disrupted Cancer Care

This change doesn't just affect contracts. It affects people. Patients will face dramatically higher out-of-pocket costs — often hundreds or even thousands of dollars more each month. For many seniors living on fixed incomes, that increase makes continued care at Roswell Park financially impossible. It may force them to leave the doctors who they trust and who will provide the best outcome in the middle of treatment — a disruption no one battling cancer should ever face.

High-Quality Care Costs Less

Cancer care is not a commodity. Measuring value by the price of each doctor visit or scan ignores what truly matters — the total cost of care over the full course of treatment. At Roswell Park:

Diagnoses are more accurate,

reducing delays, misdiagnoses and repeat testing.

Scans and pathology are rarely duplicated

because quality eliminates waste.

Integrated care teams coordinate all necessary specialties

to prevent complications, hospitalizations and emergency visits.

Our outcomes consistently exceed regional and national averages,

meaning more survivors, fewer side effects and lower long-term costs.

When cancer care is done right the first time, total costs decline — for patients, payers and the healthcare system.

A True Partner in Value-Based Care

Roswell Park is a leader in value-based oncology, actively collaborating with insurers and policymakers to make cancer care both high-quality and cost-responsible. We participate in advanced data-sharing, implement evidence-based pathways and measure performance by outcomes — not volume.

Tiering out Roswell Park sends the wrong signal. It penalizes the very kind of high-quality, evidence-driven, coordinated care that value-based medicine is meant to reward.

Protecting Access for Vulnerable Western New Yorkers

Nearly 55% of our patients are Medicare beneficiaries — our parents, grandparents, children and neighbors. Many live on fixed incomes and can't simply change insurance plans mid-year.

Roswell Park remains in-network with other Medicare Advantage and supplemental plans, and our team is helping patients find affordable options that preserve access. But our broader message is simple: No one should lose access to expert cancer care because they can't afford it.
