Charges are being placed against the Respondent for a violation(s) of 10 NYCRR 2.60, Erie County Executive Emergency Order effective November 23, 2021 and Erie County Commissioner of Health's Order effective November 23, 2021, relating to COVID-19, regarding mask/face covering usage by staff, patrons and the general public. Enclosed is a stipulation that you may use if you wish to waive your right to a hearing and plead liable to the charges.

Please read the attached stipulation carefully. If you agree to the stipulation, you must sign the documents before a Notary Public, and send one (1) copy of the stipulation and the penalty to:

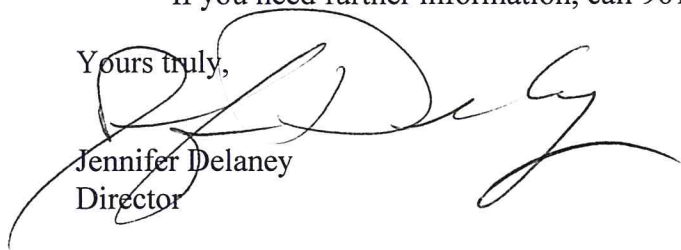

The completed stipulation and penalty must be received by this office by February 05, 2022. The Commissioner of Health is imposing this penalty with the understanding that it is approved for the stipulation only and the stipulation will be withdrawn if it is not received by this Department by the above specified date.

If you do not agree to the stipulation, you must appear at a hearing which will be scheduled in the near future. Please be advised that if found liable, penalties could be as much as \$1000.00 for each violation.

WHEREAS, the Respondent is charged with violating 10 NYCRR 2.60, Erie County Executive Emergency Order effective November 23, 2021 and Erie County Commissioner of Health's Order effective November 23, 2021, relating to COVID-19, regarding mask/face covering usage by staff, patrons and the general public when in your facility.

On January 10, 2022, an Investigating Public Health Sanitarian of the Erie County Department of Health witnessed wilful violation of the mask laws/orders at the Village Board meeting.

WHEREAS, the Respondent understands that he/she has a right to a hearing before an impartial hearing officer on these charges.

NOW, therefore, the Respondent hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That the Respondent waives his/her right to a hearing.
2. That the Respondent pleads liable to the charges as stated in the stipulation.
3. That the Respondent agrees that they have reviewed 10 NYCRR 2.60, Erie County Executive Emergency Order effective November 23, 2021 and Erie County Commissioner of Health's Order effective November 23, 2021, relating to COVID-19, regarding mask/face covering usage by staff, patrons and the general public when in your facility.
4. That the Respondent pays a penalty of Three Hundred (\$300) Dollars by February 05, 2022.
