Burnett County is a participant within the Northwest Regional Housing Program and has an adopted Fair Housing Ordinance which entitles everyone to an equal opportunity for housing regardless of the following:

- Age
- Sex
- Race
- Color
- National Origin
- Ancestry
- Disability
- Religion
- Sexual Orientation
- Marital Status
- Family Status
- Lawful Source of Income
- Status as a victim of domestic abuse, sexual abuse, or stalking

If you believe you have been treated unfairly while looking for housing, or are being discriminated against by your current landlord, please contact the County Clerk at 715-349-2173. You will be offered assistance in filing a complaint with the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development for enforcement of fair housing laws (all complaints will be handled in a confidential manner).
