SBA Disaster Assistance Available for Utah Businesses and Private Nonprofits

The U.S. Small Business Administration announced the availability of low-interest federal disaster loans for eligible small businesses and private nonprofit organizations in Utah impacted by drought occurring May 1 and continuing.

Eligible Counties

Utah: Cache, Morgan, Rich, Summit, and Weber

Idaho: Bear Lake and Franklin

Wyoming: Lincoln and Uinta

Who Can Apply

- Small businesses
- Private nonprofits & faith-based organizations
- Small agricultural cooperatives & nurseries
- Small aquaculture enterprises

Loan Assistance Available

- Economic Injury Disaster Loans: Working capital assistance for operational expenses caused by the disaster

Key Loan Details

- Up to \$2 million in loan funding
- Interest rates as low as 4% for small businesses and 3.625% for private nonprofit organizations
- Loan terms of up to 30 years
- No interest or required payments are due for the first 12 months following disbursement
