#### PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS

Plaintiff Madison Teachers Inc. ("MTI") by its attorneys, Pines Bach LLP, complains against Defendant Madison Metropolitan School District ("MMSD" or the "District") as follows under the Wisconsin Public Records Law, Wis. Stat. § 19.31 *et seq.* ("Public Records Law"):

## **Parties**

1. Madison Teachers Inc. ("MTI") is a labor organization that represents over 4,000 employees in the Madison Metropolitan School District ("MMSD"), the Defendant in this matter. MTI does this through collective bargaining, through meet and confer discussions with MMSD administration about a wide variety of issues affecting its members' working conditions, and through other collective actions with its members. MTI members include teachers, educational professionals and paraprofessionals,

substitute teachers, clerical/technical employees, educational assistants, and school security assistants. Having submitted Public Records requests to the Defendant, MTI is a "requester" within the definition of the Public Records Law, Wis. Stat. § 19.32(3).

2. Defendant Madison Metropolitan School District is a school district as that term is used in Chapters 115 through 121 of the Wisconsin Statutes. MMSD is the second-largest primary and secondary school system in the state. Its administrative office and principal place of business is located at 545 West Dayton Street, Madison, Wisconsin 53703. MMSD is an "authority" as that term is defined in Wis. Stat. § 19.32(1).

## <u>Jurisdiction and Venue</u>

- 3. The Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this dispute pursuant to Article VII, Section 8 of the Wisconsin Constitution and Wis. Stat. § 753.03.
  - 4. Venue is proper under Wis. Stat. §§ 19.37(1) and 801.50(2).

#### **Facts**

- 5. On November 3, 2021, MTI requested the following records (collectively, the "Records") from MMSD for insurance carriers Group Health Cooperative-SouthCentral Wisconsin (both HMO and point-of-service plans), Dean Health Plan, Delta Dental of Wisconsin (both HMO and point-of-service plans), and EyeMed:
  - A. Copies of the past three vendor contracts between the MMSD and the insurance carriers, ending with the most recent contract;
  - B. Copies of the current plan certificate (i.e., certificate of insurance) for each insurance carrier; and

C. Copies of all records that reflect the administrative fees paid by the MMSD to each insurance carrier for 2019, 2020, and 2021.

A copy of the November 3, 2021, public records request sent by email to the MMSD is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

- 6. On November 3, 2021, MMSD confirmed receipt of MTI's public records request by email, which is attached hereto as Exhibit B.
- 7. On December 6, 2021, MTI sent a follow-up letter by email to MMSD inquiring as to when it could expect to receive the Records. A copy of the December 6, 2021 letter is attached hereto as Exhibit C.
- 8. On December 13, 2021, the MMSD confirmed receipt of MTI's follow-up letter by email, which is attached hereto as Exhibit D.
- 9. On January 31, 2022, MTI received an email from MMSD stating that some of the records requested are maintained in hard copy only and required a prepayment of \$359.58 for the location fee. A copy of MMSD's January 31, 2022 email is attached hereto as Exhibit E.
- 10. The next day, February 1, 2022, MTI paid the prepayment request in full. A copy of the February 1, 2022 letter enclosing payment is attached hereto as Exhibit F.
- 11. More than six months have passed since MTI's November 3, 2021 request and MMSD has not provided any Records responsive to the request.

# <u>CAUSE OF ACTION:</u> Defendant Has Violated the Wisconsin Public Records Law

- 12. Plaintiff incorporates by reference all allegations set forth in the preceding paragraphs.
- 13. Under Wis. Stat. § 19.31, it is the declared public policy of this State that every citizen is entitled to the greatest possible information regarding the affairs of government and the official acts of government officers and employees. Wis. Stat. § 19.31 thus provides that the Public Records law "shall be construed in every instance with a presumption of complete public access, consistent with the conduct of governmental business," and further, that "[t]he denial of public access generally is contrary to the public interest, and only in an exceptional case may access be denied."
- 14. The Public Records Law provides that a requester has the right to inspect any record except as otherwise provided by law. Wis. Stat. § 19.35(1)(a).
- 15. MTI is a "requester" as defined by the Public Records Law. *See* Wis. Stat. § 19.32(3).
- 16. The Records requested by MTI on November 3, 2021, were "records" subject to disclosure under the Public Records Law. *See* Wis. Stat. § 19.32(2).
- 17. The Public Records Law requires a public authority, including MMSD, to fulfill a public records request "as soon as practicable and without delay." Wis. Stat. §§ 19.32(1), 19.35(4).
- 18. MMSD has violated the Public Records Law by improperly withholding and delaying access to the Records requested by MTI on November 3, 2021.

19. MMSD's actions have caused and will continue to cause injury to MTI by depriving MTI and the public of their rights under the Public Records Law.

## RELIEF REQUESTED

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully requests that the Court grant the following relief pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 19.31 et seq.:

- 1. An order declaring that Defendant violated Wisconsin's Public Records Law, Wis. Stat. §§ 19.31 et seq.;
- A mandamus order directing Defendant to produce for the Plaintiff a copy 2. of the requested records without further delay, Wis. Stat. § 19.37(1)(a);
- 3. An award to Plaintiff for its reasonable attorneys' fees, damages of not less than \$100, Plaintiff's other actual costs, and punitive damages if the Court finds the Defendant arbitrarily and capriciously denied or delayed response to Plaintiff's requests, Wis. Stat. § 19.37(2), (3); and
- 4. Such other relief as the Court deems just and equitable.

Thank you for your patience with the processing delay of your public records request due to the COVID-19 pandemic, staffing constraints, and an increase in public records requests the District has received to-date.

After a preliminary search, a number of items you requested (specifically the vendor contracts and current plan certificates) are not maintained electronically and require in-person search efforts from District staff as the documents are maintained in hard-copy. The remaining item in your request (paid administrative fees) is maintained electronically, but requires search efforts from a separate department.
