You are further directed not to take any steps to impede this investigation or to cause such steps to be taken on your behalf. You are reminded to avoid any type of harassment of, or retaliation toward, any person whom you may believe to be a complainant, witness, or otherwise participating in the investigation.

The decision to place you on a paid leave is not disciplinary, and shall not be characterized as discipline, by the District in any manner. It is being done for the protection of all concerned and to ensure the ability to conduct an appropriate investigation. Human Resources has been consulted and supports the decision to place you on administrative leave at this time.

Please be advised - failure to conduct yourself in accordance with the terms and conditions of your administrative leave may result in disciplinary action, up to and including possible dismissal from employment.
