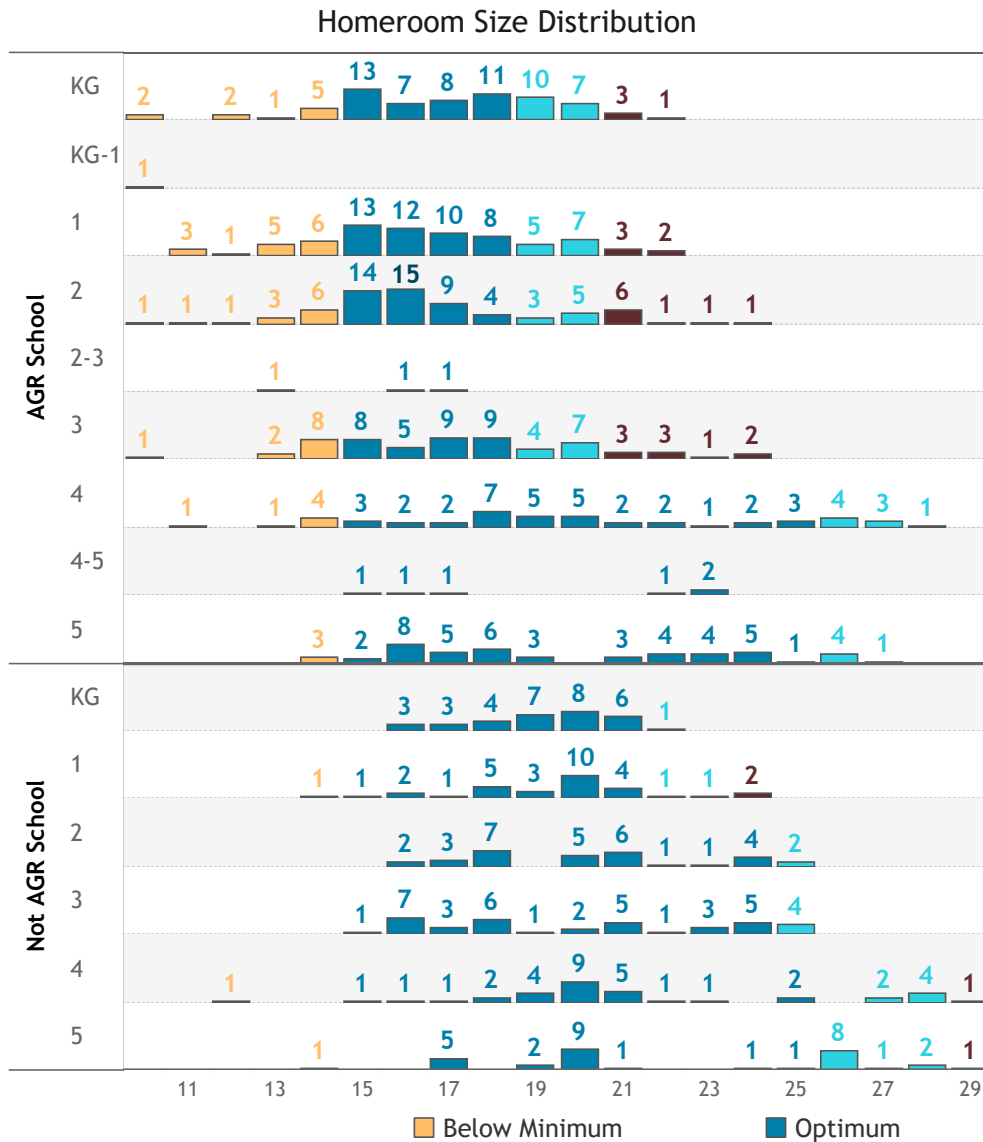


Elementary Homeroom Sizes November 2022

This report summarizes *in-person* class sizes, as of November 2022, in accordance with Board Policy 3450: Class Size. The graphic on the left shows the distribution of homeroom sizes, color coded by their compliance with general guidelines, outlined in Board Policy 3450. The graphic in the middle shows average homeroom class sizes. The table on the right shows the total number of sections meeting each guideline.

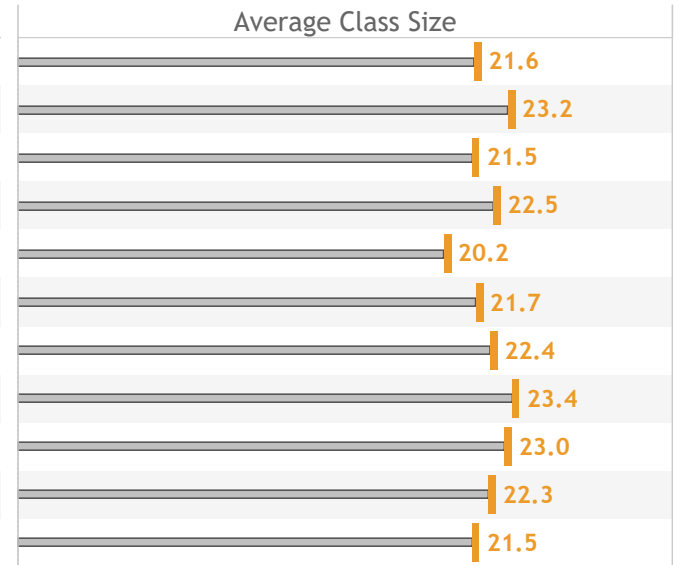
Middle/High Class Sizes
