



FACT SHEET: President Donald J. Trump Ends Indoctrination in America's Schools

"On day one, I will sign a new executive order to cut federal funding for any school pushing Critical Race Theory, transgender insanity, and other inappropriate racial, sexual, or political content on our children."

PUTTING AN END TO IDEOLOGICAL INSANITY: Today, President Donald J. Trump signed an Executive Order Ending Radical Indoctrination in K-12 Schooling.

- This Executive Order prohibits federal funding of the indoctrination of children which includes radical gender ideology and critical race theory in the classroom.
- President Trump's administration will enforce civil rights laws in education, including Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title IX of the Educational Amendments of 1972, the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, and the Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment.
- Within 90 days of the executive order's signing, the Secretary of Education (and the Secretary of Defense for DOD-run schools) will provide a strategy to the President for how to end indoctrination in K-12 education.
- The executive order reinstates Executive Order 13958, reintroducing the 1776 Commission and calling on executive agencies to prioritize the advancement of patriotic education.
- The Attorney General will work with state attorneys general and local district attorneys to file actions against teachers and school officials who sexually exploit minors or practice medicine without a license through "social transition" practices.

REFOCUSING EDUCATION ON EXCELLENCE AND PATRIOTISM, NOT INDOCTRINATION: American education should focus on cultivating patriotic citizens ready for the workforce, not political activists.

- Widespread indoctrination of gender ideology is a gross violation of parental rights.
 - Harrisonburg City Public Schools in Virginia implemented a policy forcing teachers to "always use a student's preferred names and pronouns" while using different ones with their parents.
 - Madison Metropolitan School District in Wisconsin adopted a policy for schools to "disrupt the gender binary" by teaching students to adopt identities without regard for their biological sex without informing their parents or obtaining their consent.
- Critical Race Theory is an inherently racist policy that teaches students are to be judged on their racial or ethnic background, rather than as an individual.
 - Albemarle County School District in Virginia has enacted an "anti-racism" policy based on critical race theory. This policy resulted in a student being taught that her



achievement was based on her race, rather than her individual merit. This directly contradicted her parents' teachings as small-businessowners who are immigrants from Panama.
