

**PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

The City of Chino Community Services Parks & Recreation Commission will hold a public hearing to discuss the 2026-2027 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. The hearing is scheduled for Monday, January 26, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. and will be held in the Chino City Council Chambers, located at 13220 Central Avenue, Chino. The purpose of this meeting is to hear presentations from applicants seeking funding for the 2026-2027 CDBG program and review needs and past performance. The City expects to receive approximately \$540,000 in federal funds for the 2026-2027 program year, though the actual amount is yet to be determined. Award amounts are typically announced in April each year and may be available during the next public hearing.

The public meeting is an essential part of the CDBG program's citizen participation process, which is a requirement by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).
