Albertina Goulart was born on February 10, 1957 in Porto Judeu, Terceira, Azores, Portugal to Alberto and Maria Soares.

Albertina was a prominent figure in our Portuguese communities. She was the first woman president of Chino DES and

encouraged more women to pursue a committee position. She also was instrumental in founding the Corona Green Acres Festa, which celebrated Portuguese traditions for more than twenty years.

In addition to her cultural leadership, Albertina worked as a notary public and certified loan signing agent, while also guiding and supporting countless immigrants—from achieving citizenship to finding employment and accessing legal assistance. Her generosity, compassion and unwavering commitment to others left a lasting impact on many lives.

Albertina was a devoted wife to surviving husband, Jorge Goulart, and together they shared a deep pride in their cultural traditions and community service.

She passed away June 1, 2025. Her loss is felt deeply, not only within the Portuguese community but by all that had the blessing of knowing her. She will be remembered for her love of heritage, her selflessness and her dedication to help others.
