To **Kenneth A. Schelhorn** and to all persons claiming to be the father or mother of minor person(s) named **Korra Lynn Schelhorn** (DOB: 06-20-2016).

By order of this court, you are hereby cited and advised that you may appear before the Judicial Officer Presiding in **Department S-52** of the above-entitled court located at: **Superior Court of California, County of San Bernardino, Central District, 351 N. Arrowhead Ave., San Bernardino, CA 92415 on May 18, 2026 at 1:30 p.m.** of that day, then, and there to show cause. If you have, why said person should not be declared free from the control of (his/her) (their) parents according to the petition on file herein. For failure to attend you may be deemed guilty of contempt in court.

The court finds that the respondent cannot be served in any other manner specified in the California Code of Civil Procedure. The court orders that the documentations be served by publication at least once per week for four (4) successive weeks in the following newspaper: Chino Valley Champion Newspaper, 13617 12th St., Ste. B, Chino, CA 91710.

If the court finds that the interest of the minor(s) requires his or her protection, the court shall appoint counsel to represent the minor(s). Such counsel shall be appointed whether or not the minor(s) is able to afford counsel. If you appear without counsel and are unable to afford counsel, the court shall appoint counsel for you if you request appointed counsel.

The purpose of this action, to free the minor(s) from custody of (his/her) (their) parent(s), is to permit the adoption of said minor(s) to a suitable adopting parent(s).

The Court may continue these proceedings, not to exceed thirty (30) days, as necessary to appoint counsel and enable counsel to become familiar with these proceedings.

IT IS FUTHER ORDERED that a copy of said summons or citation and of said complaint or petition in this action be forthwith deposited in the United States Post Office, post-paid, directed to said defendant, respondent, or citee if his address is ascertained before expiration of the time prescribed for the publication of this summons or citation and a declaration of this mailing or of the fact that the address was not ascertained be filed at the expiration of the time prescribed for the publication.
